NEW ORLEANS EMA*

*Eligible Metropolitan Areas (EMAs) receive Ryan White Program Part A funds based on population size and reported AIDS cases. These 8 parishes make up the New Orleans EMA: Orleans, Jefferson, St. Bernard, Plaquemines, St. Charles, St. James, St. John the Baptist, and St. Tammany.



**A single person (i.e. household size of one) making less than \$5000 per month meets the income requirement.

Having an undetectable viral load is the goal of treatment. Individuals who are undetectable are less likely to spread HIV.
