## **AGREEMENT**

NOW COME the parties herein, through undersigned counsel, who represent that an agreement has been reached resolving the above-captioned Civil Service ("CS") appeal, prior to and in lieu of proceeding with the CS hearing scheduled on Wednesday, May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

The New Orleans Police Department ("NOPD"), agrees to modification of the discipline issued to Sergeant Debra Pruitt ("Sgt. Pruitt") under PIB #2022-0249-R as follows: (1) the five (5) day suspension issued for violation of Rule 4; Performance of Duty, Paragraph 2; Instructions from an Authoritative Source, to wit NOPD Policy 344.1.1, is reduced to a three (3) day suspension; (2) the finding for Rule 4 Performance of Duty; Paragraph 2, Instructions from an Authoritative Source; to wit NOPD Chapter 1.2.4.2 on search warrants, is changed from UNFOUNDED to EXONERATED; and (3) the finding for Rule 6 Official Information; Paragraph 2, False or Inaccurate Reports, to wit: NOPD Chapter 1.2.4.2 on search warrants, is changed from UNFOUNDED to EXONERATED. Officer Pruitt's PIB history (a.k.a. a short form), will be corrected to reflect the change in findings to Exonerated and the reduction in the suspension from five (5) days to three (3) days; with Officer Pruitt being reimbursed for the last two days of suspension already served; March 16-17, 2023, and all emoluments associated with that two day reimbursement.

In response to NOPD's modification of the discipline issued under PIB #2022-0249, as detailed above, and the reimbursement of two days pay and all emoluments associated with that reimbursement, Sgt. Pruitt agrees to withdraw her appeal of this matter.

Counsel for the parties document their agreement to the terms stated herein as confirmed by their signatures below. The parties further request that this Agreement be presented to the
