AGREEMENT

NOW COME the parties – Appellant, Zachary Stevenson, and the Appointing Authority, New Orleans Police Department (NOPD) – through undersigned counsel, who represent that they have agreed to resolve the above-captioned matter prior to and in lieu of proceeding with the hearing originally scheduled for September 22, 2023, pursuant to Civil Service Rule II, Section 6.7.

Specifically, NOPD has agreed to reduce the disciplinary action taken under PIB #2021-0332-R of a one-day suspension for sustained violation of NOPD Chapter 41.5.11 Vehicle Pursuits to a Letter of Reprimand. NOPD further agrees to reimburse Officer Stevenson the one day of suspension served and all emoluments associated with the one-day reimbursement. Finally, Officer Stevenson's PIB history will be corrected to reflect modification of the suspension to a Letter of Reprimand.

In consideration of NOPD's terms of resolution as detailed herein, the Appellant agrees to withdraw his appeal in the above-captioned matter.

WHEREFORE, the parties, through their respective undersigned counsel, request that this Agreement, reached prior to the scheduled Civil Service hearing, be entered into the record and be presented to the New Orleans Civil Service Commission for acknowledgment at its next scheduled meeting.
