AGREEMENT

NOW COME the parties – Appellant, Stephanie Gray, and the appointing authority, New Orleans Police Department ("NOPD") – through undersigned counsel, who represent that they have agreed to resolve the above captioned matter prior to and in lieu of proceeding with the hearing scheduled for February 23, 2023, pursuant to Civil Service Rule II, Section 6.7.

Specifically, NOPD agrees to rescind the following disciplinary actions taken under PIB #2021-0370-R:

- the one-day suspension for violation of NOPD's Rule 2, Moral Conduct, Paragraph 1, Adherence to Law to wit, MCS 17271 154-484, relative to blocking an Intersection/Roadway;
- the five-day suspension for violation of NOPD's Rule 4, Performance of Duty, Paragraph 4, Instructions from an Authoritative Source, to wit CAO Policy 89 (VII), Prohibited Substance Definitions/Categories (Subparagraph E);
- the letter of reprimand for violation of NOPD's Rule 4, Performance of Duty, Paragraph 4, Neglect of Duty, Subparagraph C-6, Failing to Comply with Instructions from an Authoritative Source, to wit NOPD Chapter 17.2.2(19) (Take Home Vehicles); and
- the one-day suspension for violation of NOPD's Rule 4, Performance of Duty, Paragraph 4, Neglect of Duty, Subparagraph C-6, Failing to Comply with Instructions from an Authoritative Source, to wit NOPD Chapter 17.2.2(34) (Take Home Vehicles).

Accordingly, the total suspension issued in connection with PIB #2021-0370-R will be reduced from eighty-seven (87) working days to eighty (80) working days. NOPD further agrees that the

two days of emergency suspension that Appellant has already served in connection with PIB #2021-0370-R shall be applied toward the final discipline in this matter, such that Appellant's remaining suspension to be served totals seventy-eight (78) days. NOPD further agrees that Officer Gray's personnel file and short form will be amended to reflect the withdrawal of discipline described in this Agreement.

In consideration of the foregoing agreements by the Appointing Authority, the Appellant agrees to and does hereby withdraw her appeal in the above-captioned matter.

WHEREFORE, the parties, through their respective undersigned counsel, request that this Agreement reached prior to the scheduled evidentiary hearing be entered into the record and be presented to the New Orleans Civil Service Commission for acknowledgment at its next scheduled meeting.
