Entering Non-RW PMC Visits

OHP has implemented a process to assist agencies to improve and track retention in care, as defined by 2 medical visits that are three months apart. In the RW Part A- New Orleans EMA system, CAREWare is also used for billing, as well as tracking health outcomes. The following is a step-by-step description on how to enter this information in CAREWare.
