AGREEMENT

NOW COME the parties – Appellant, Kimberly Hunt, and the appointing authority, New Orleans Police Department ("NOPD") – through undersigned counsel, who represent that they have agreed to resolve the above captioned matter prior to and in lieu of proceeding with the hearing scheduled for October 10, 2023, pursuant to Civil Service Rule II, Section 6.7.

Specifically, NOPD agrees to rescind the disciplinary action, a suspension of two (2) working days, taken under PIB #2021-0413-R. NOPD further agrees that Appellant shall receive back pay and emoluments for all days of suspension served and that Appellant's personnel file and disciplinary history will be amended to reflect the result of this Agreement. In consideration of the foregoing agreements by the Appointing Authority, the Appellant agrees to and does hereby withdraw his appeal in the above-captioned matter.
