

Fight the Blight Day

September 24, 2011 Data Summary

- 237 bags of litter collected
 - 81 city blocks cleaned up
 - 20 dumped tires collected
 - 6 recycling boxes filled
 - 28 catch basins cleaned out
 - 41 catch basins stenciled ("no dumping")
 - 2 picnic tables built
 - 6 benches built and painted
 - 3 bleachers repaired
 - 6 benches repaired
 - 28 trees mulched
 - 14 trees trimmed
- 120 feet of fencing painted
 - 7 playground items painted
 - 4 basketball courts re-striped

538 volunteers

2,152 volunteer hours

\$40,264 impact

Coordinated City Services

- 32 potholes filled
- 11 street signs replaced
 - 3 abandoned vehicles towed
 - 9 blighted houses demolished
- 14 overgrown lots cleared







Inspections Backlog September 19- September 30, 2011






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Age of Inspections Backlog




Code Enforcement Completes 268 Hearings in Bi-Weekly Period









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Unscheduled Hearings Backlog: Aging Report





Strategic Demolition Process and Outcomes


















Trend in Illegal Dumping Sites Cleared




Trend of Tires Removed and Disposed





Sheriff's Sales Dispositions






Lien Foreclosures as of September 30, 2011









Road Home Inventory and NORA Property Dispositions as of September 30, 2011
