AGREEMENT

NOW COME the parties herein, through undersigned counsel, who represent that an agreement has been reached resolving the above captioned Civil Service (CS) appeal, prior to and in lieu of proceeding with the CS hearing scheduled on November 11, 2021. The New Orleans Police Department ("NOPD") has agreed to reduce the discipline from four days of suspension to two days.

Specifically, the one day of suspension issued under PIB 2020-0548-P for violation of Rule 4, Paragraph 4(c)(1) failing to take appropriate and necessary police action, and the one day of suspension issued for violation of Rule 4, Paragraph 4(c)(6) hazardous materials; will be rescinded, and Officer Parker will be reimbursed for two days of suspension served the week of October 10, 2021. However, the one-day suspension for violation of Rule 4, Paragraph 4(c)(6) on report preparation, and the one-day suspension for violation of Rule 4, Paragraph 4(c)(8) collection, preservation and identification of evidence, shall remain.

In response to NOPD's agreement to reduce a four working day suspension to two working days, as detailed herein, Appellant, Jonathan Parker, agrees to withdraw his appeal in this matter. The parties agree to the terms stated herein as confirmed by the signature of their counsel. The

parties further request that this Agreement be presented to the Commission at its next scheduled meeting.
