



Inspections Backlog July 11- July 22, 2011



Age of Inspections Backlog






Code Enforcement Process Map








Unscheduled Hearings Backlog: Aging Report




Code Enforcement Process Map




Total Demolition by Program





FEMA Demo Packet Process



Demolitions and Lot Clearings: July 11- July 22, 2011









Trend in Illegal Dumping Sites Cleared






Reasons for Rejecting Sheriff's Sales Files






Code Lien Foreclosures and Sheriff's Sales



Lien Foreclosures as of July 22, 2011




Sheriff's Sales Dispositions: July 14, 2011 Sale Date





NORA Inventory Backlog Reductions




