WHEREAS, Councilmember Head resigned her seat as the District B Councilmember on the New Orleans City Council, effective May 2, 2012;


WHEREAS, on May 2, 2012, a vacancy was created on the New Orleans City Council for the District B seat;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority given to the Mayor in Section 3-105(2)(b)(ii) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of New Orleans, the Mayor is empowered to appoint an interim Councilmember for the District B seat who will serve until such time as the vacancy is filled through a special election

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MITCHELL J. LANDRIEU, by the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of New Orleans by the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana and the Home Rule Charter and laws of the City of New Orleans, **HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. <u>Effective Date</u>: This Executive Order is effective upon the date of its issuance.
- 2. <u>Purpose</u>: The purpose of this Executive Order is to fill the vacant District B seat on the New Orleans City Council.
- 3. I hereby appoint Diana E. Bajoie as the New Orleans City Councilmember to represent District B.
