



Code Enforcement Process Map



Total Code Enforcement Fall below Target




Code Enforcement Inspections by Type





Inspections Backlog June 13- June 24, 2011




Age of Inspections Backlog Reduction









Code Enforcement Process Map




Total Hearings Remain Below Target










Aging of Hearings Backlog




Code Enforcement Process Map




Total Demolition by Program













Total Lot Clearings, June 13- June 24, 2011




Trend in Illegal Dumping Sites Cleared




Trend of Tires Removed and Disposed

Lien Foreclosures as of June 24, 2011






Sheriff's Sale: Property scheduled for Auction




NORA Total Closings Above Target




NORA Phase II Auction Properties Awarded to Winning Bidders




NORA Inventory Backlog Reductions








Blight Program Performance Oct 2010- June 2011 VS. End of Year 2013 Target
