

2014 Criminal Justice System Performance Measures

Performance Highlights

- In December, 2014 the Criminal Justice Council passed a resolution to establish an initial set of criminal justice system performance measures
- Police response time to high priority calls is close to meeting NOPD's target of 10 minutes
- Fewer than 50% of the grants allocated through the Criminal Justice Council have been to programs or projects that proposed outcome measures at the outset
- The CJCC Self-Evaluation Questionnaire will be administered to the Councilmembers in the coming months to establish a baseline score
