**The following items will be placed on the consent agenda:**

- 1312 Governor Nicholls St: Reconstruction of four-family main residence and two-family secondary residence.
- 1316-1318 Governor Nicholls St: Reconstruction of two-family main residence and single-family secondary residence.
- 3141 Laurel St: Construct camelback addition on existing building.
- 500-506 Jackson Ave: Construct new, two-story, single-family residence with attached one-story, single-family rental residence on existing vacant lot.
- 2401 Rousseau St: Construct 768 sf accessory building and masonry fence.
- 1329 Jackson Ave: Replacement of existing window with new door and transom.
- 1582 Magazine St: Installation of decorative gate.
