The following items will be placed on the consent agenda:

- 1476 Magazine St: Construction of a new multi-story, mixed use building.
- 2620 Royal St: Construction of camelback addition and side balcony.
- 1807 N Rampart St: Construction of two-story, single-family residence.
- 1809 N Rampart St: Construction of two-story, single-family residence.
- 1306 Magazine St: Restoration of existing 4-unit historic apartment.
- 2239 Laurel St: Camelback addition to existing corner store and alteration of door and window openings.
- 2301 Chippewa St: Construction of a one-story, single family residence on an existing vacant lot.

- 239 Vallette St: Retention of removal of historic wood windows and installation of surface mounted vinyl windows without a Certificate of Appropriateness.

deviation of Certificate of Appropriateness.

1049 Independence: Retention of an inappropriate metal security fence at a stoop.

512-514 Opelousas: Retention of installation of brown roof shingles, turbine roof vents, and modification of door and window openings without a Certificate of Appropriateness.
