The New Orleans Historic District Landmarks Commission's regularly scheduled meeting will take place on **Thursday, November 10, 2016, in Homeland Security Conference Room located on the 8th Floor of City Hall, 1300 Perdido Street at 1:00 PM.** At this meeting public hearings may be heard on the following applications:

The following items will be placed on the consent agenda:

- 1427 Esplanade Ave: New construction of six-unit, three-story residential building.
- 2820 St Claude Ave: New construction of sound barrier using shipping containers at rear yard.
- 6221-6223 Dauphine St: New construction of one-story, single-family residential building.
- 1006 Washington Ave: Renovation of designated landmark building and construction of porch addition to existing rear service wing.
- 2423 Decatur St: New construction of camelback addition to one-story single family residential building.
- 3015 N Rampart St: New construction of one-story, single-family residential building.
- 1330 Camp St: New construction of enclosed stair addition at the rear of existing raised, residential building.
- 3609 St Claude Ave: Renovation of existing one-story commercial building including addition of second floor.
- 1331-1333 St Philip St, 1012-1014 Marais St: Demolition of accessory structure in rear, renovation of existing two-story mixed use building to include two-and-half story addition.

The following items will be placed on the regular agenda:

- 1423 Esplanade Ave: New construction of three-story multi-family residential building.
- 915 Louisiana Ave: Retention of demolition of existing one story residential building in deviation of approved plans and new construction of two story, single family residential building.
- 2216 Magazine St: Appeal of ARC denial to enclose side gallery.
- 841 Independence St: Installation of solar panels on highly visible roof slope.
- 1216 Congress St: Replace existing slate roof with new asphalt shingle roof.
- 736 Fourth St: Remove existing pane over panel door and install inappropriate arched doors.
- 836 Desire St: Appeal of ARC denial to construct detached one-story accessory structure.
- 3143-3145 N Villere St: Retention of the removal of original wood windows and installation of inappropriate vinyl windows. Retention of inappropriate batten shutters and the removal of pane from pane in panel door and installation of solid panel. Retention of removal of the ridge tiles.
- 2045 Magazine St: Install inappropriate plastic, internally illuminated, hanging sign.
- 938 Congress St: Retention of inappropriate security doors installed without a CofA.
- 3260 St Thomas St: Retention of inappropriate wood railings and decorative light fixtures installed without a CofA.
- 1227 Bartholomew St: Retention of removal of original wood windows and installation of inappropriate vinyl windows without a CofA.
- 1236 Alvar St: Retention of installation of inappropriate railings and lattice between piers and painting of

previously unpainted masonry at front porch without a CofA.

Demolition of buildings at:

935 N Broad St: Demolition to grade of existing one-story commercial building.
