This internship will be focused on health promotion, community outreach, and educational policy and programming.

Ideal candidates should have background in public health and interest in reproductive and sexual health care and education. This opportunity will be hybrid with a commitment of 10 hours per week with occasional weekend hours as available.

- Create social media posts to share sexual health information and encourage services including STI testing.
- Assist with the development of sexual health presentations for youth in school-based settings and associated implementation and training plan for school staff.
