Civic Leadership Academy (CLA) is an engaging 8 week program that provides residents with an in-depth look at City government. The program includes tours, hands-on demonstrations and presentations that give participants an insider view of how the City of New Orleans operates. With this knowledge, participants will be better equipped to lead collective action towards the advancement of neighborhoods and residents' quality of life.

*Participants must live or work in New Orleans and be 18 years of age or older. Priority is given to those who are actively involved in a neighborhood or business association.

Goals

- Build capacity of leaders to become effective neighborhood advocates
- Construct a source of leadership from communities
- Encourage collaboration and partnership between a wide range of community organizations
