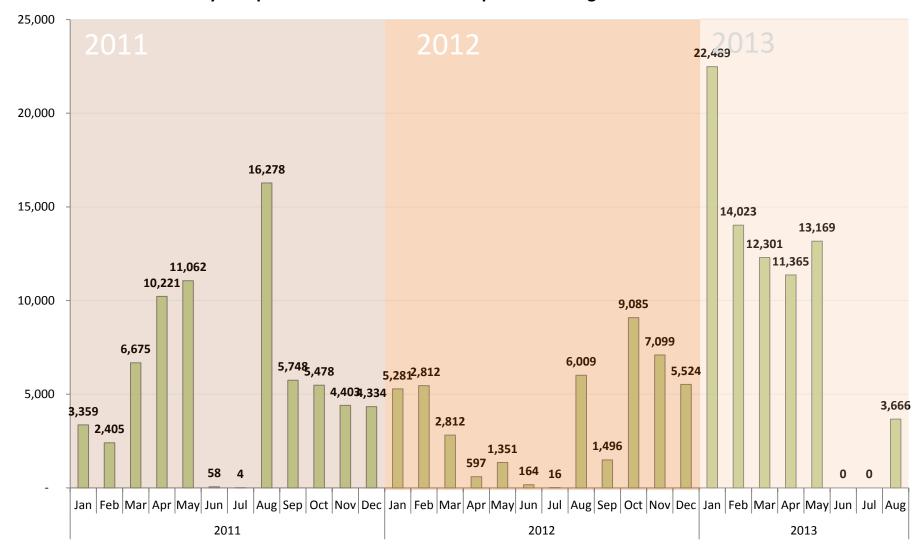

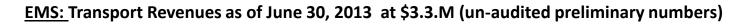

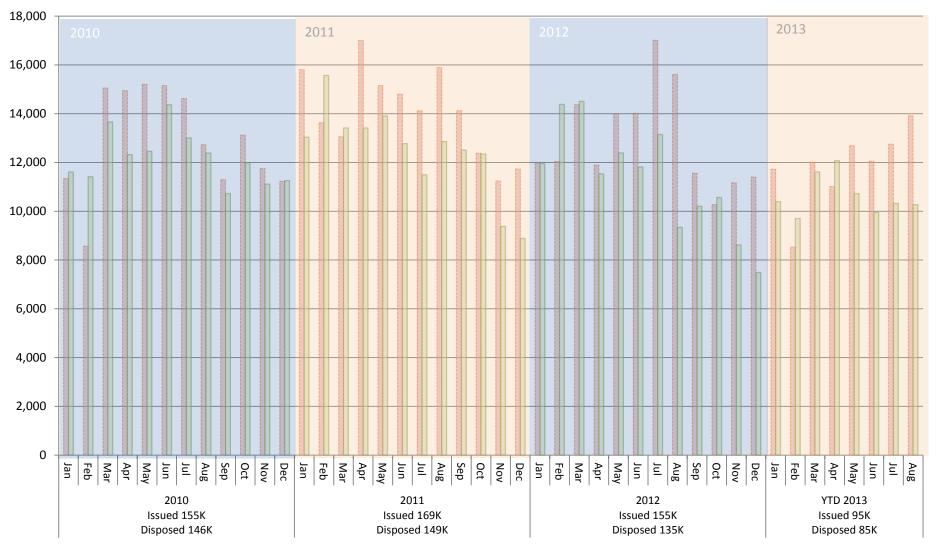




#### **Trend of Traffic Citations Issued & Disposed**

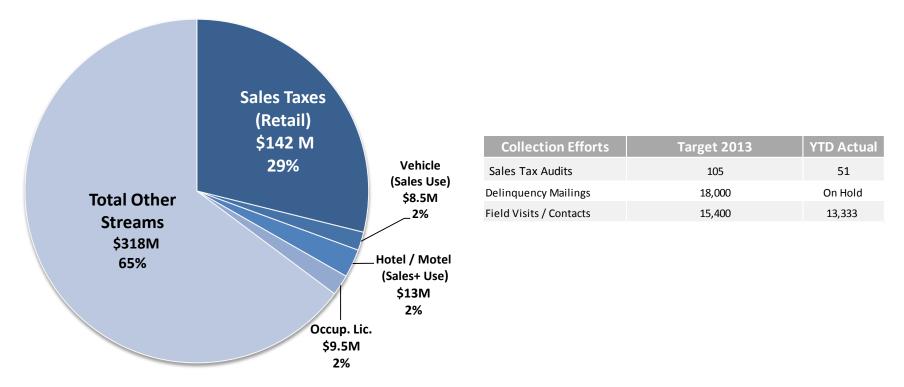
Monthly Traffic Violations Issued

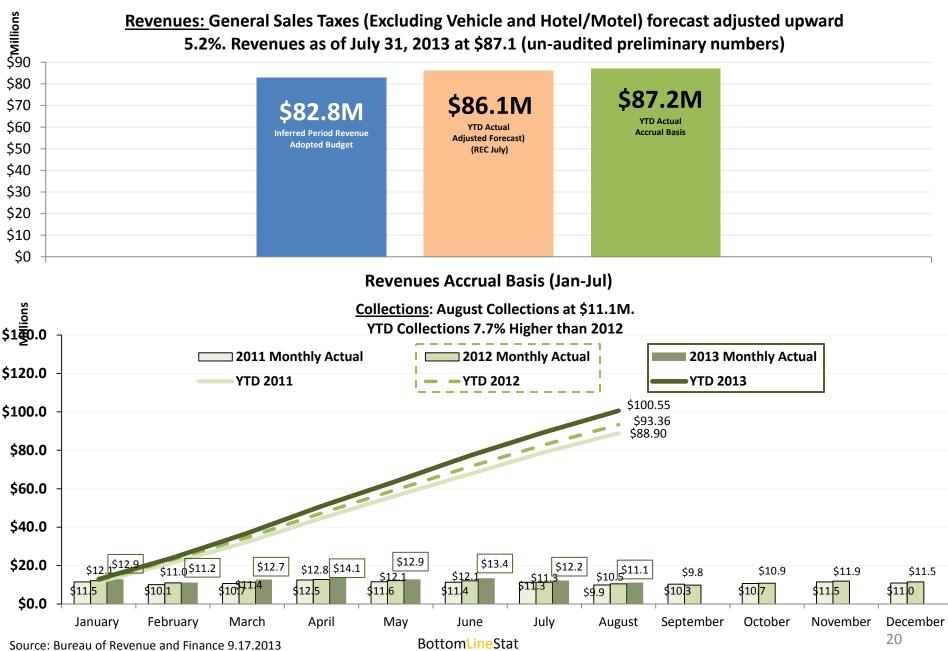

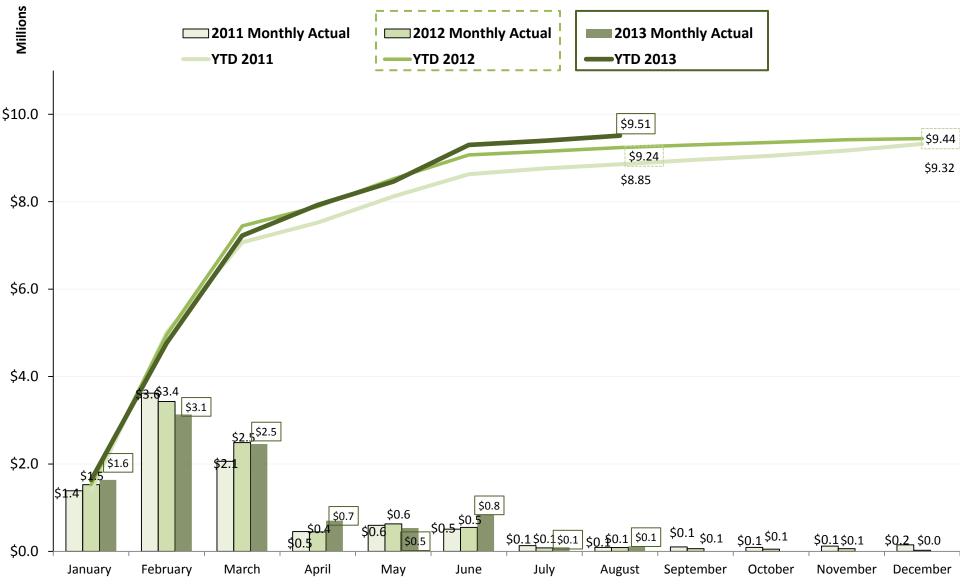


#### **Vehicle Sales Taxes**



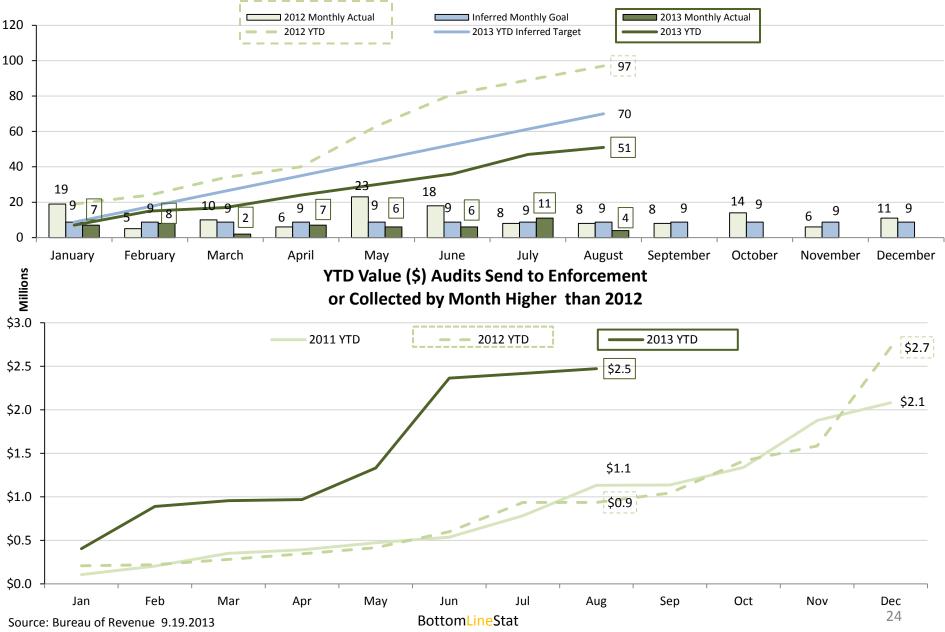

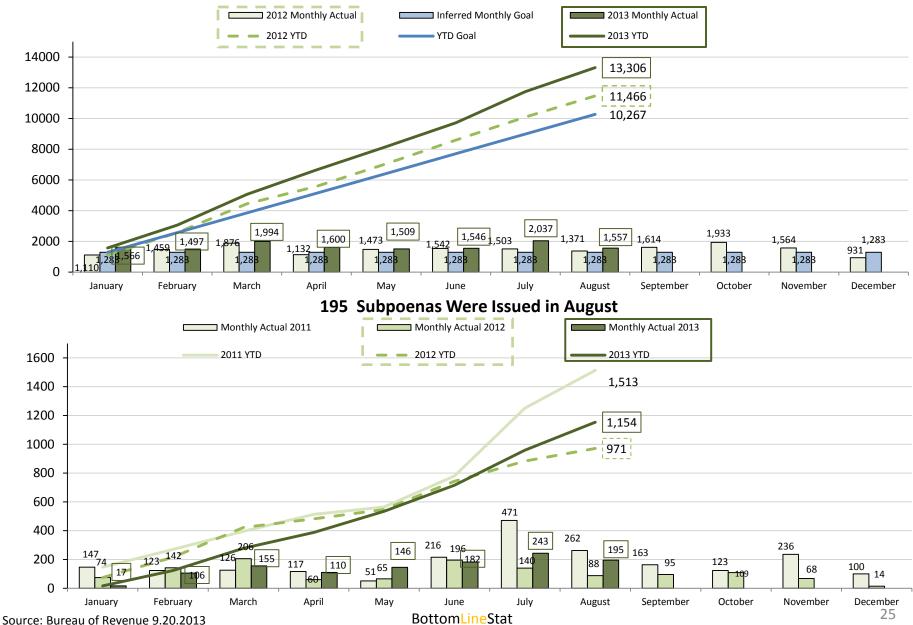

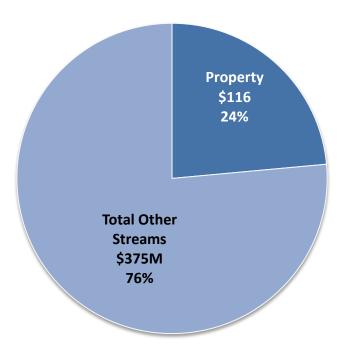

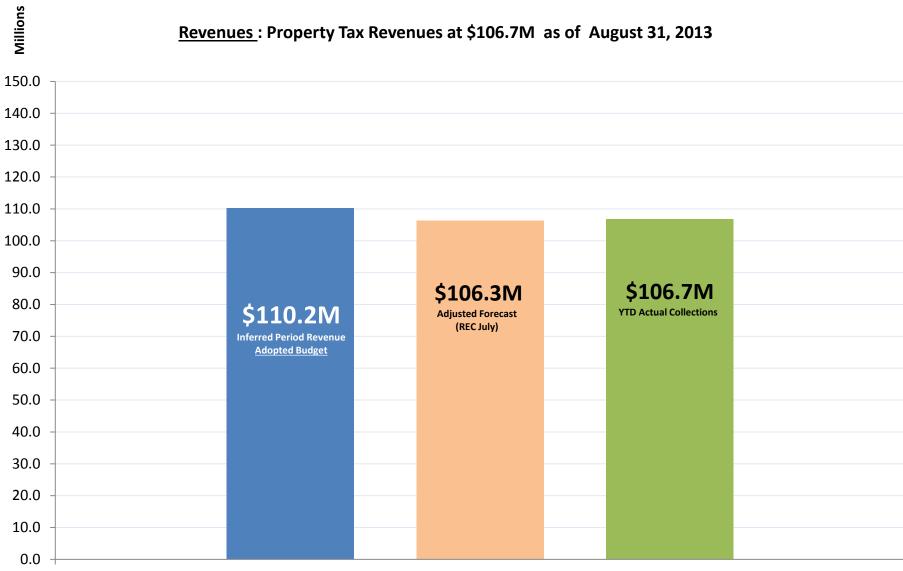

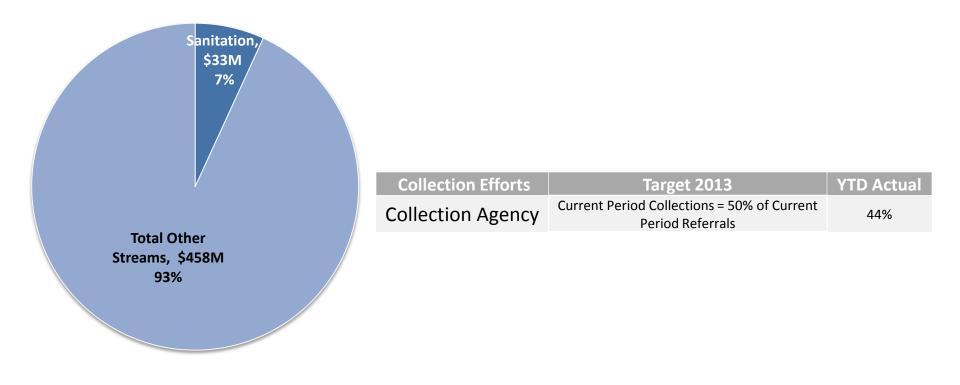

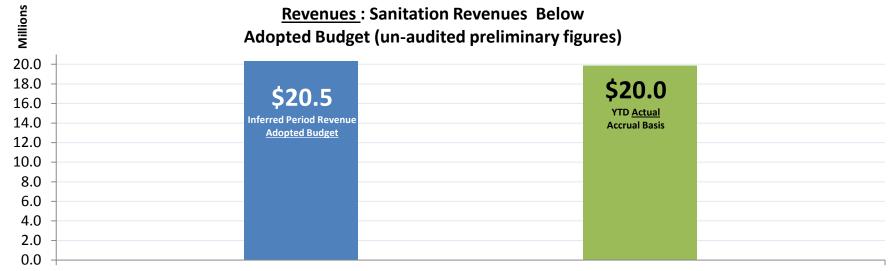
### **Sanitation Revenues**

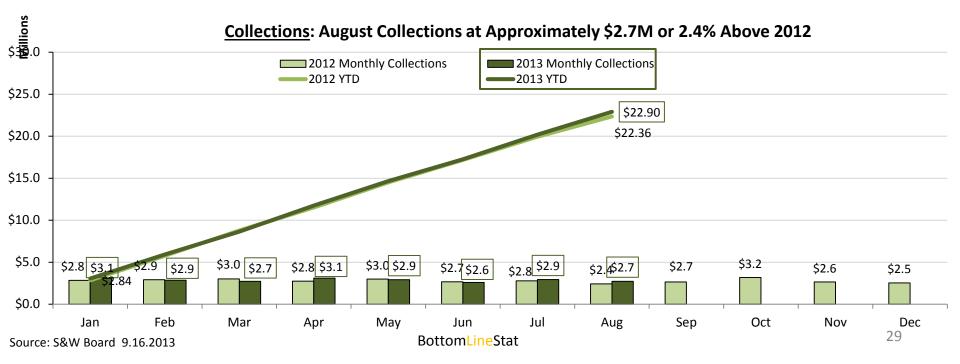

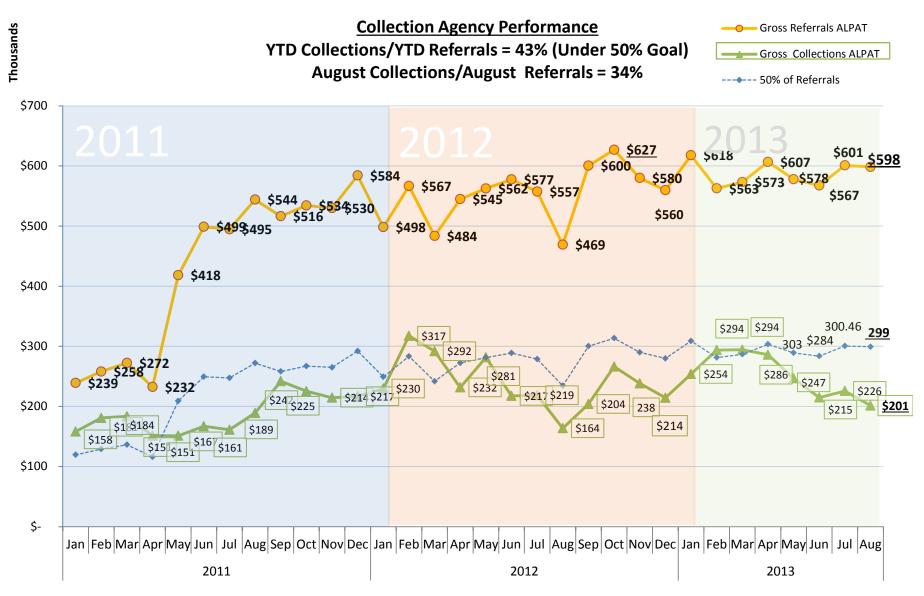
**Revenues : Sanitation Revenues Below** Adopted Budget (un-audited preliminary figures)

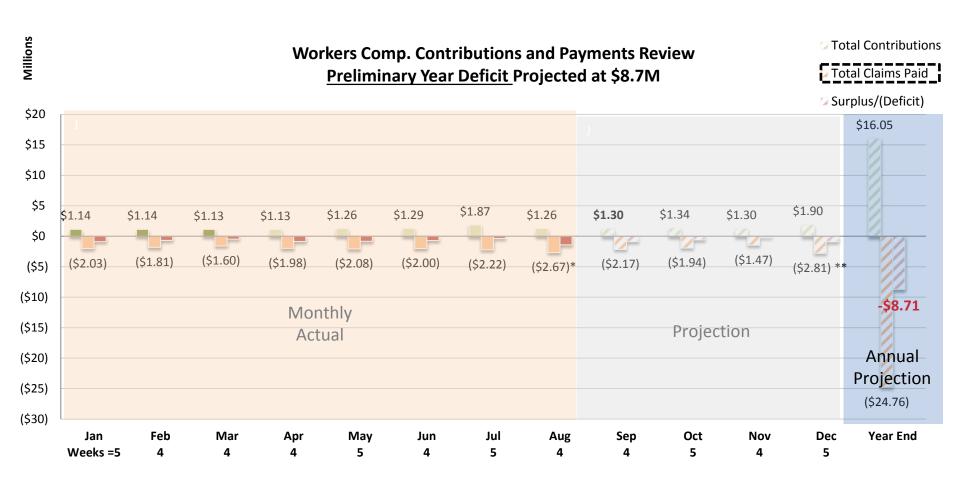

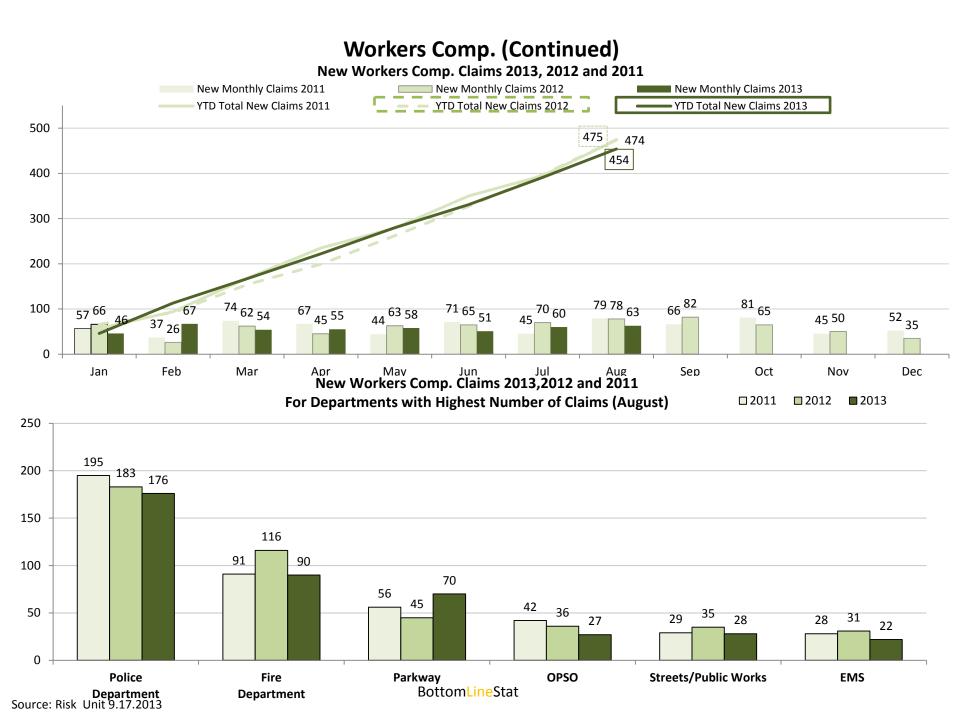

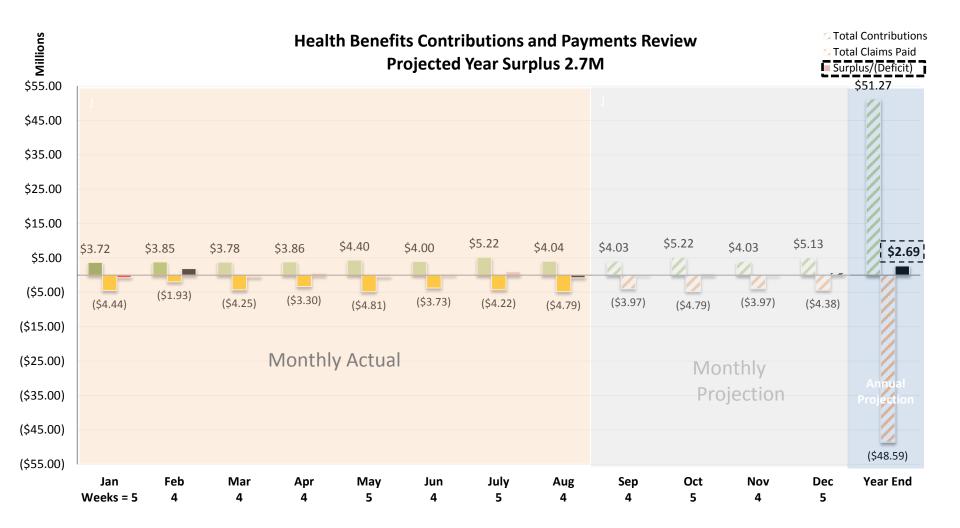
#### Workers Comp. Contributions vs. Payments

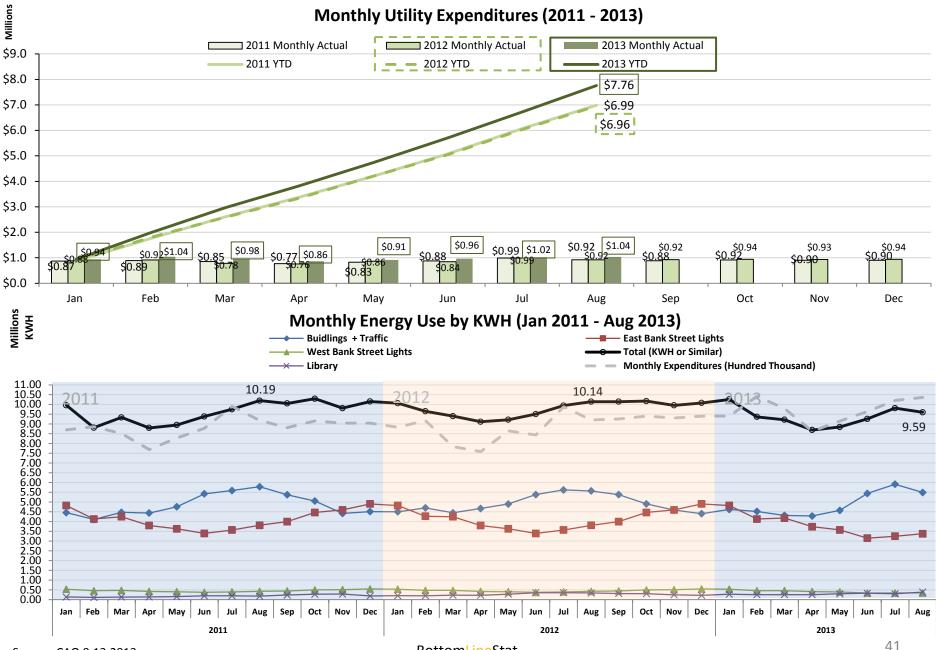

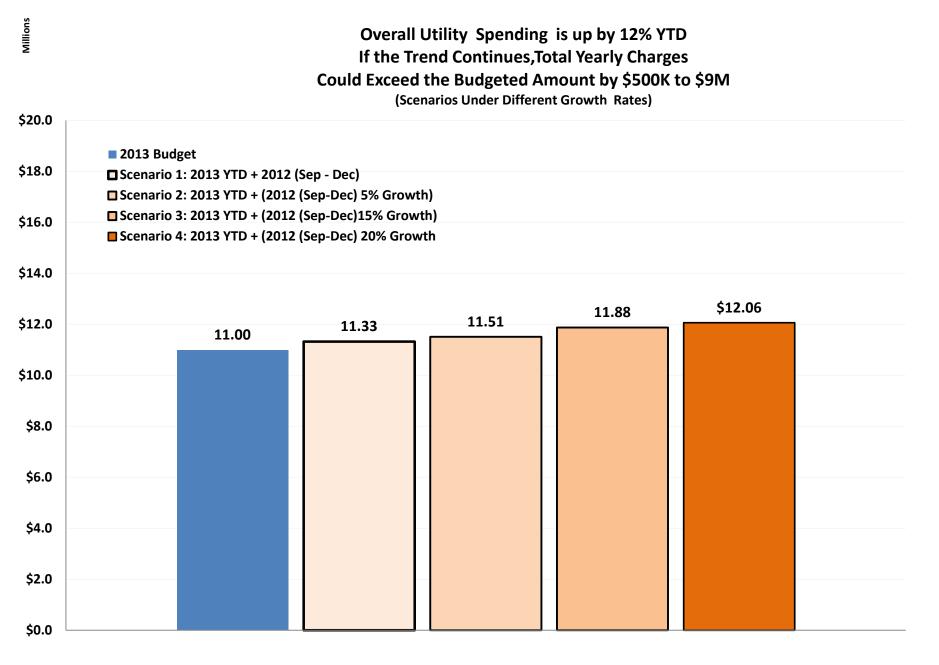
