



### **Inspections Backlog June 27- July 8, 2011**




# **Age of Inspections Backlog**









# Code Enforcement Process Map




#### **Total Hearings Remain Below Target**












#### **Total Demolition by Program**



**Code Enforcement Demolitions Program** 




#### **Strategic Demolition Process and Outcomes**











## **Trend in Illegal Dumping Sites Cleared**



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
#### **Code Lien Foreclosures**

# Lien Foreclosures as of July 8, 2011






#### **Sheriff's Sale: Property scheduled for Auction**
