



### Code Enforcement Cases In-process and final outcomes













## FEMA & SDER demolitions taper, Hurricane Isaac creates surge in IDC cases

Cumulative Demolitions since Oct 1, 2010











## NORA Inventory Movement









#### **NSP2 Housing Units Completed**






