## ORDER

The Juvenile Justice Intervention Center (JJIC) has moved for summary disposition of Ms. Flowers' appeal of her termination of employment on the basis that Ms. Flowers has no right of appeal as a probationary employee. The Commission heard oral argument on this motion at its May 18, 2023, regular meeting. The Commission grants JJIC's Motion for Summary Disposition, as Ms. Flowers was a probationary employee who did not assert a discrimination or whistleblower appeal. Ms. Flowers' one-year probationary period began on September 4, 2022, and she was terminated on February 8, 2023. Therefore, Ms. Flowers has no right of appeal under Rule II, § 4.1.
