**AGREEMENT** 

NOW COME the parties herein, Officer Santos Aviles, and the New Orleans Police

Department (NOPD), through undersigned counsel, who represent that an agreement has been

reached resolving the above captioned matter under PIB No. 2020-0334-P, prior to and in lieu of

proceeding with the hearing set on October 12, 2021. Specifically, the NOPD will reduce the

discipline of a one-day suspension to a letter of reprimand (LOR), for violation of NOPD Chapter

82.1 relative to report preparation, reimburse Officer Aviles for the one-day of suspension served,

and correct his disciplinary record to note reduction in discipline. NOPD also agrees to rescind

the one-day suspension issued to Officer Aviles related to his deactivation of his BWC, reimburse

him for the one-day suspension served, and correct his disciplinary record to reflect the rescission

of the one-day suspension related to use of the BWC. In response to the NOPD's offered terms of

resolution as stated herein, Officer Aviles, through his counsel, agrees to withdraw his Civil

Service appeal.

WHEREFORE, the parties confirm their agreement to these terms of resolution, as

confirmed by the signature of their respective counsel below, and request this be presented to the

Commission for acknowledgment at the next scheduled Commission meeting.
