- Issue Remaining \$50M of General Obligation Bond Funds
- Expedite completion of remaining Facilities Projects
- Implement Goals of Resiliency Strategy by investing in innovative Water Management Projects
- Continue Closeout of FEMA Projects to ensure full reimbursement.

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Infrastructure Highlights

- Over \$2.4B worth of work in the next 8 years across the City
 - Most comprehensive infrastructure program our region has seen in a generation.
 - More than 200 individual projects every neighborhood will feel a positive impact.
 - Multiple Funding Sources: FEMA-funded road / waterline work, FEMA-funded Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) projects, HUD-funded National Disaster Resiliency Competition (NDRC) grant projects, SWB-funded Sewer System Evaluation and Rehabilitation Program (SSERP) (sewer consent decree) work and City-funded bond project work.
 - Aggressive project schedules coordinated to minimize construction-related impacts.
 - o On average, one construction bid opening per week beginning in 2018 thru 2020.
 - Work will create thousands of construction jobs across the city and maximize economic opportunity for the City's small and disadvantaged businesses.
- Will address long overdue repairs and make infrastructure improvements to roads, drainage, water, and sewer systems
 - Take a comprehensive and programmatic approach to the work.
 - Leverage and link multiple funding sources with the results from the Citywide Pavement Assessment to improve drainage system capacity and resilience using green infrastructure.
 - Meet all sewer system consent decree milestones.



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






