NORDC SUMMER CAMPS (Ages 4-17)

NORDC partners with organizations across all five city council districts to offer a wide array of academic, cultural and recreational summer activities for youth. Free breakfast and lunch are served daily at all summer camps to ages 18 and under. All summer camps will have free-of-charge field trips to Audubon Zoo, Aquarium of the Americas and NORDC pools for swimming lessons.

REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION:

1. Proof of Orleans Parish Residency (copy of driver's license or utility bill).
2. Proof of income for one full month with a 2014 date (pay stubs, SSI or food stamp award letters). If no income, a notarized statement to that effect. (Proof of income and proof of residency may be the same document — pay stubs and award letters.)
3. Copy of a 2013-2014 report card.
4. Registration fee (cash or money order please; no checks will be accepted).

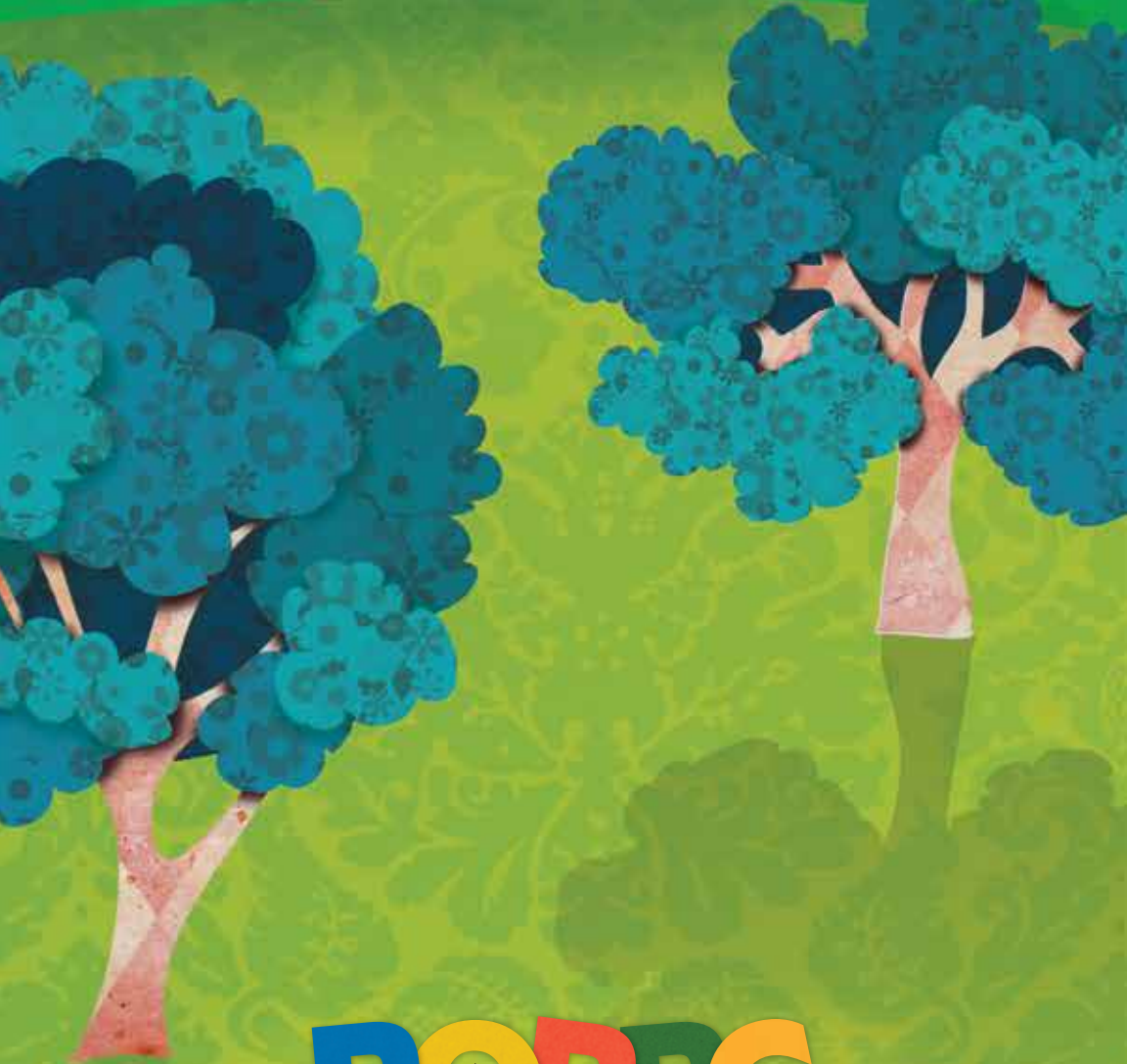
