INFORMATION ON COMPLYING WITH
MILITARY SELECTIVE SERVICE ACT

The Congress of the United States of America has enacted a law requiring all males between the ages of 18 and 26 years old to register with the Selective Service System. Any male may complete a registration card at any United States Post Office branch. When completed, this card must be returned to the Post Office. Postal employees can answer your questions.

Registration is not voluntary. Males who fail to register by their twenty-sixth (26th) birthday are prohibited permanently from being employed with the Federal Government. Also, criminal prosecution may result if a male does not comply with the provisions of this Federal Act.

If in doubt about the registration procedures, please call any branch of the U.S. Post Office or the Selective Service System at 1-800-621-5388. It is better to find out what you have to do to comply with this law before it is too late.

The Council of the City of New Orleans has passed Ordinance No. 19,218, M.C.S. requiring that you verify registration before becoming employed with the City.

This notice is to inform you of the need to register if you are a male in this age bracket, and the Federal penalties that can result if you fail to register.
