709 Tchoupitoulas St: Renovation of existing 2-1/2 story commercial building including construction of new gallery and modifications to door openings on front facade.

741-47 St Charles Ave: Kirk Fabacher, applicant; 747 St Charles Ave Investments LLC, owner; Renovation and new storefront opening at two-story, commercial building.

The following items will be placed on the regular agenda:

1060 Magazine St: Demolition of existing two-story commercial building and conceptual approval of massing of ten-story hotel new construction.

1011 Canal St: Appeal of ARC deferral of the renovation of four commercial buildings (1001-1015 Canal) including new penthouse additions.

Demolition of buildings at:

1015 Canal St: Reconstruction of Rampart St. side wall, resulting in demolition of over 50% total exterior wall area.
