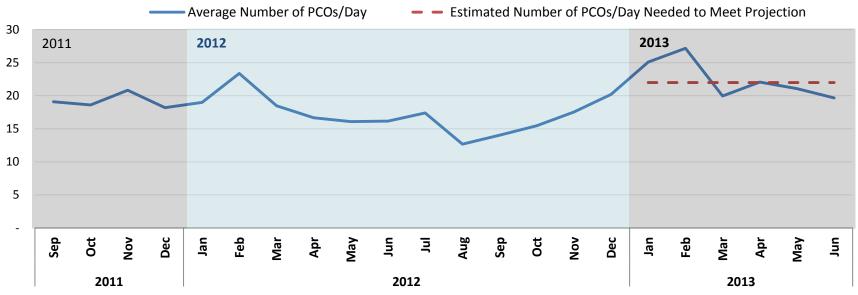
June Tickets Issued at 23.1K YTD Total is Meeting Projection

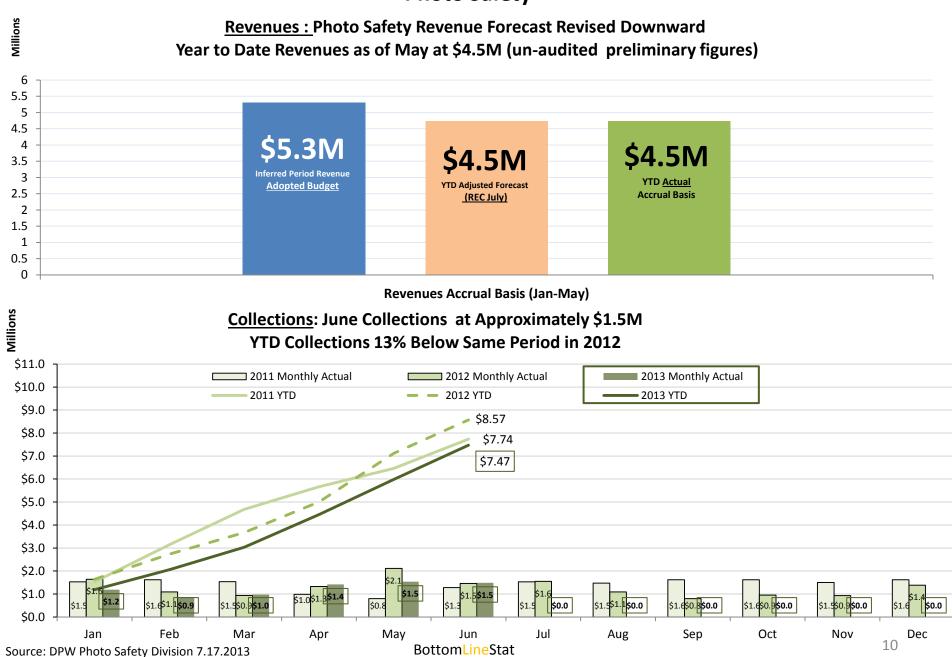

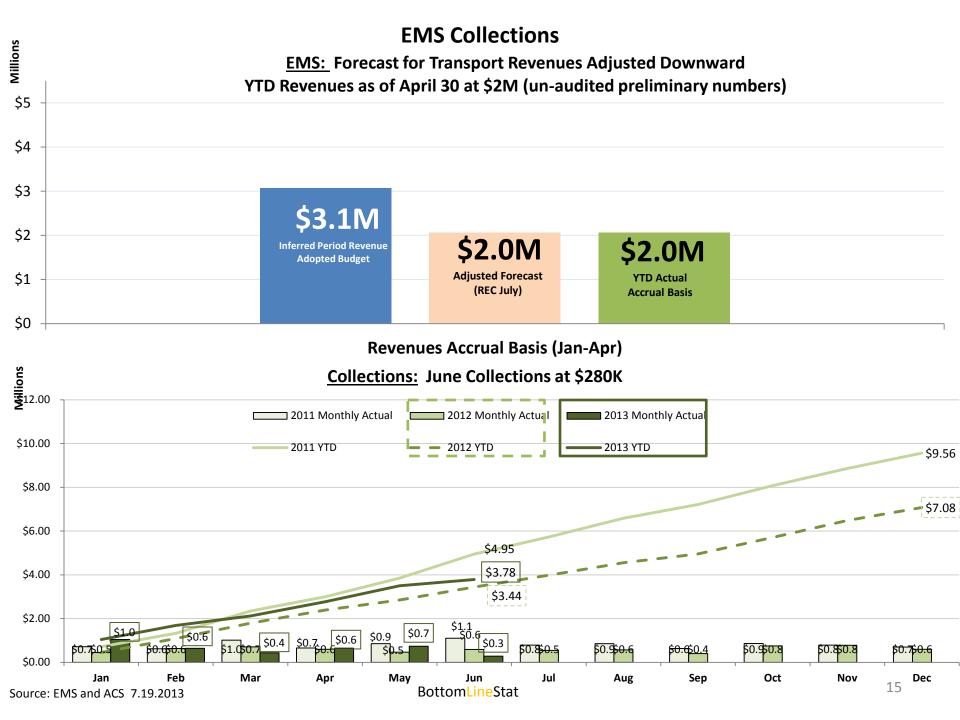
EMS Revenues

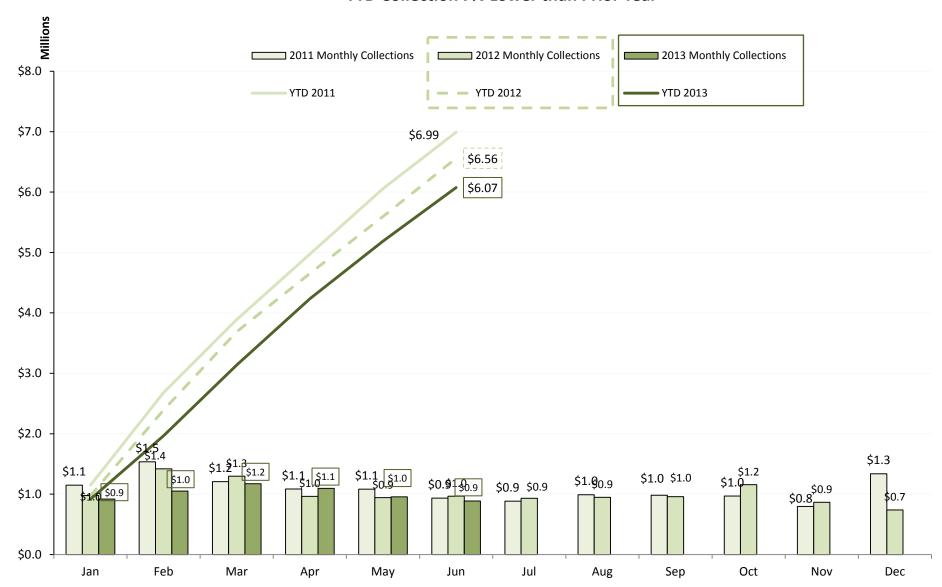

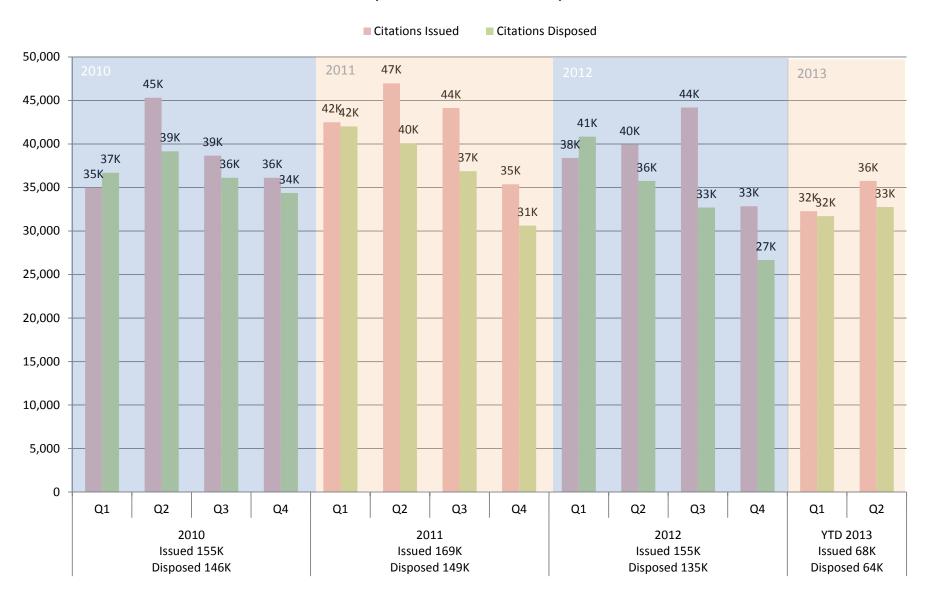

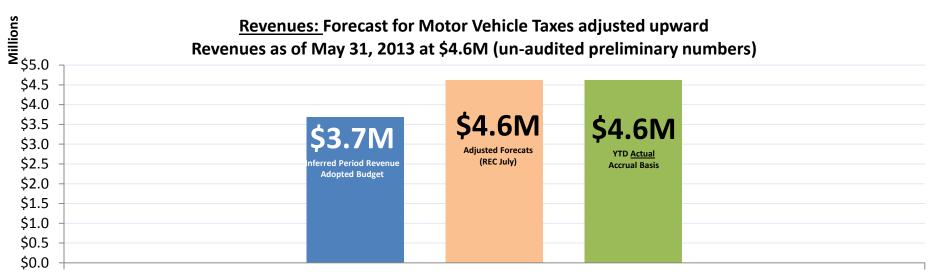
Hotel / Motel Sales Taxes

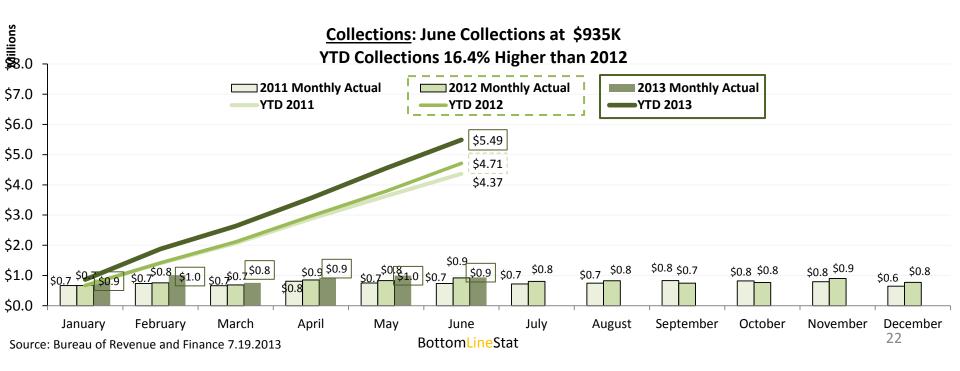

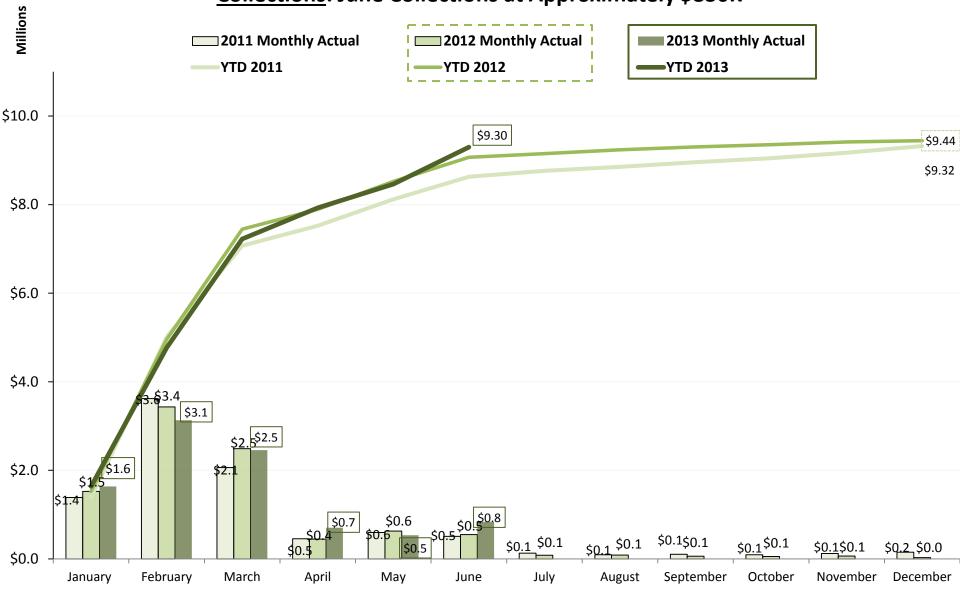
Vehicle Sales Taxes

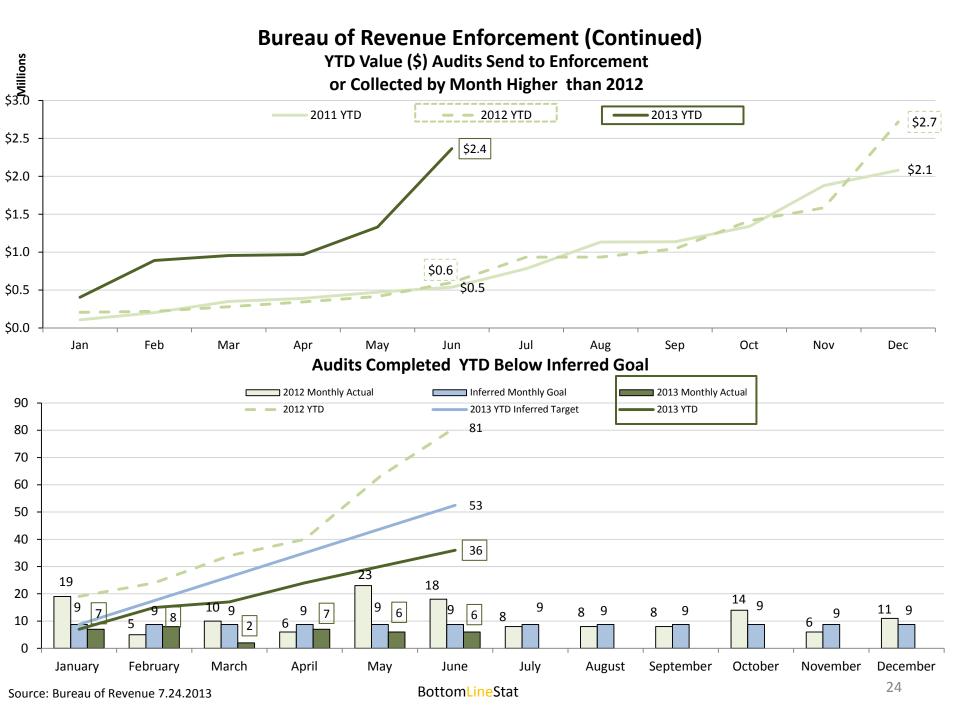

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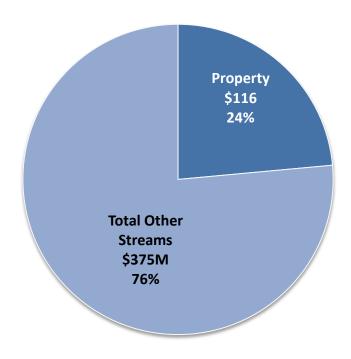

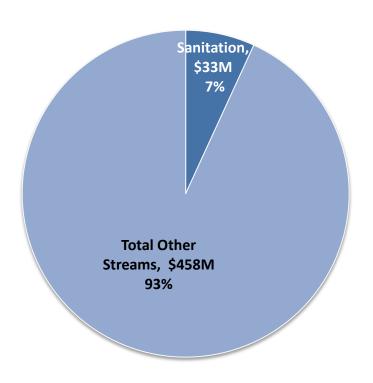


Revenues: Property Tax Revenue Forecast Adjusted Downward YTD Collections at \$104.7M



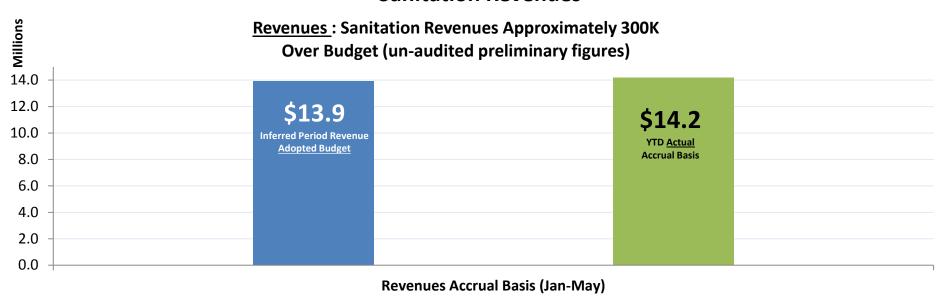

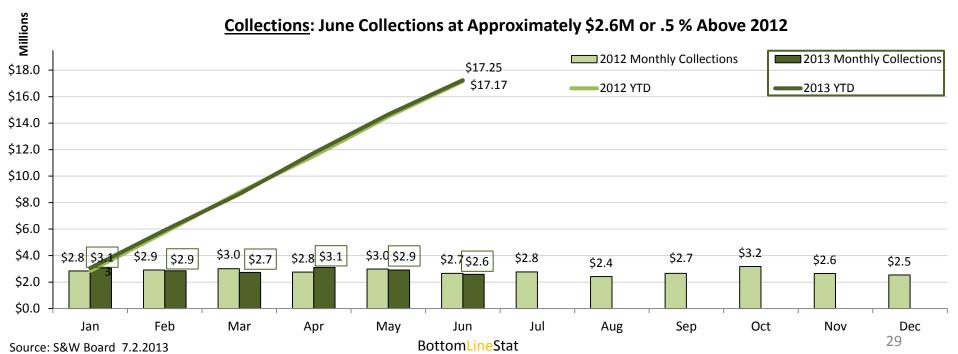

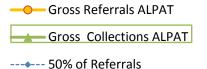


Sanitation Delinquency Collections

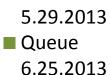

Health Benefits Contributions vs. Payments



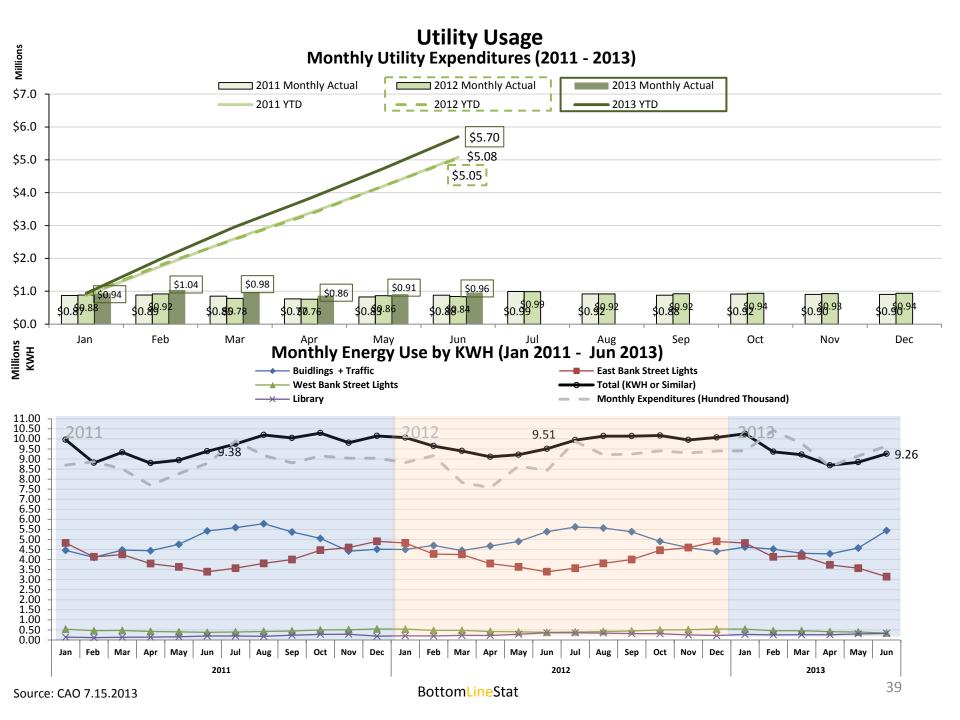

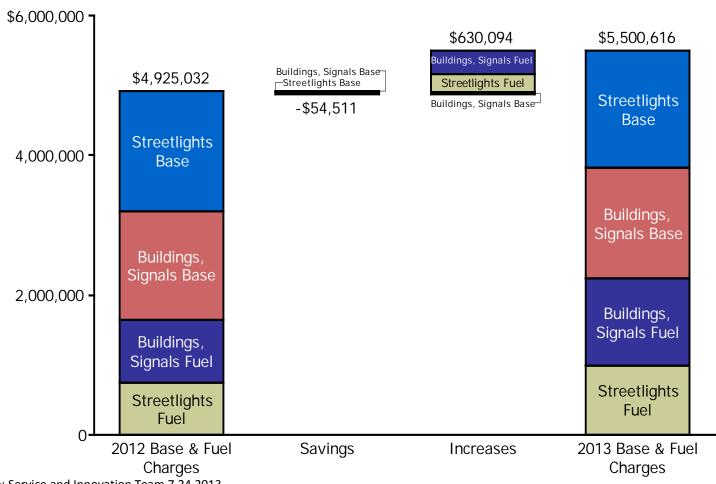
