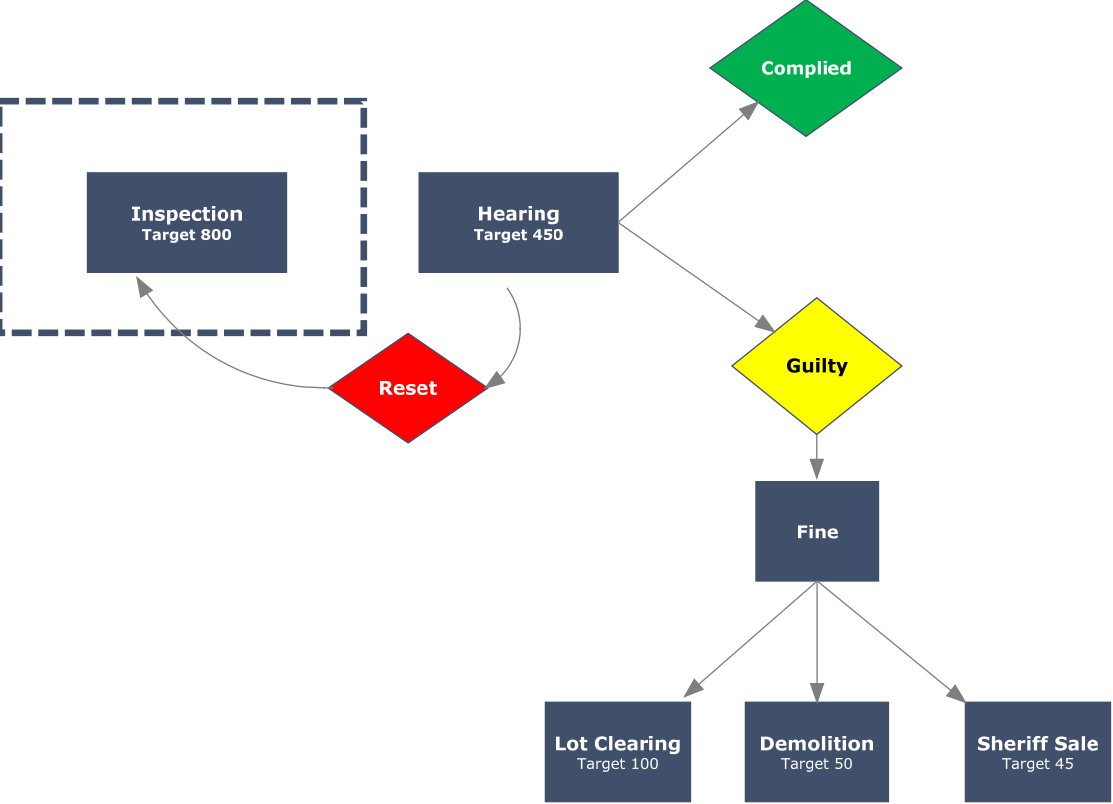

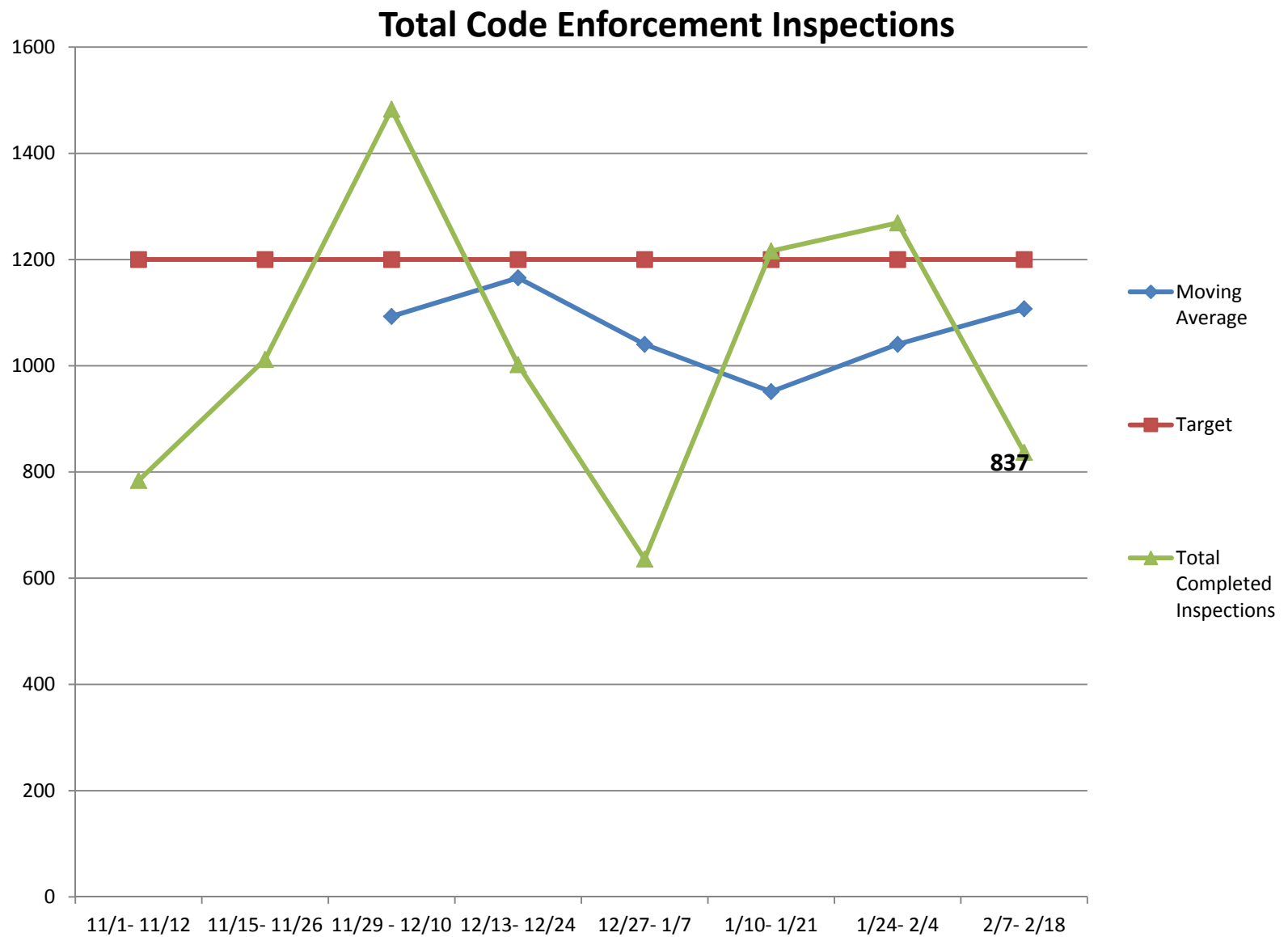

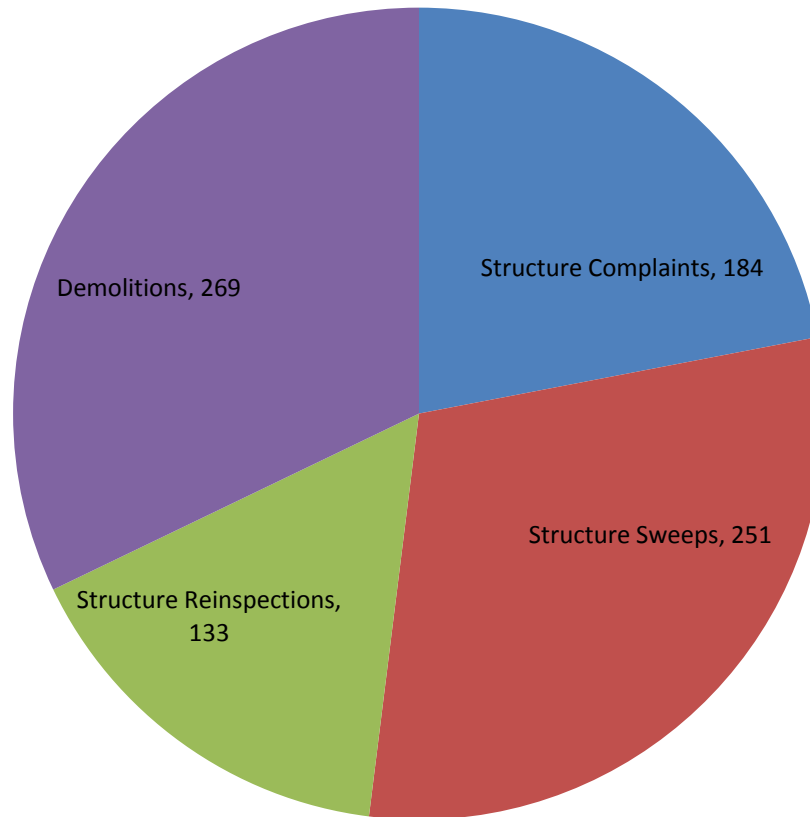
Code Enforcement Process Map
(bi-weekly targets)





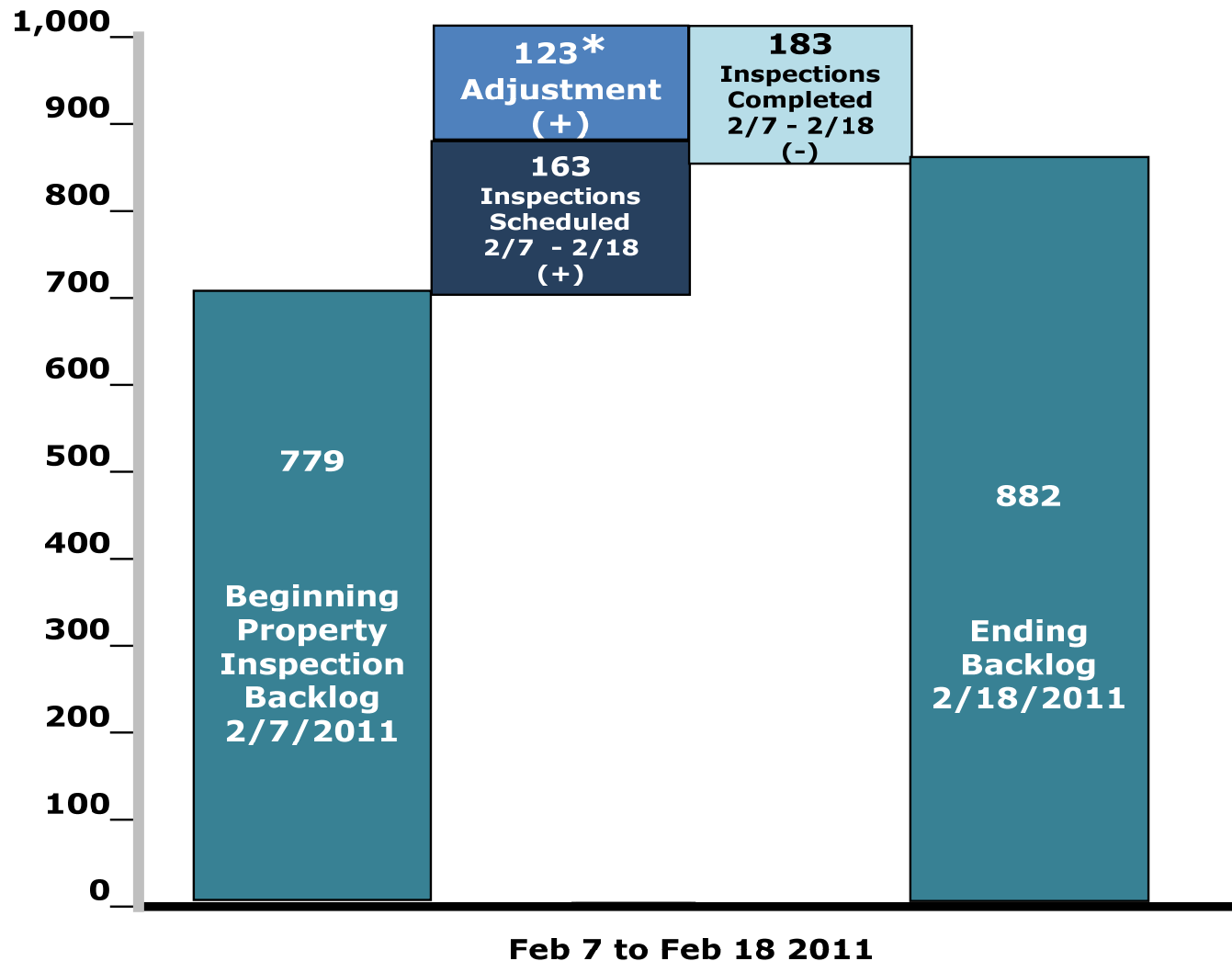

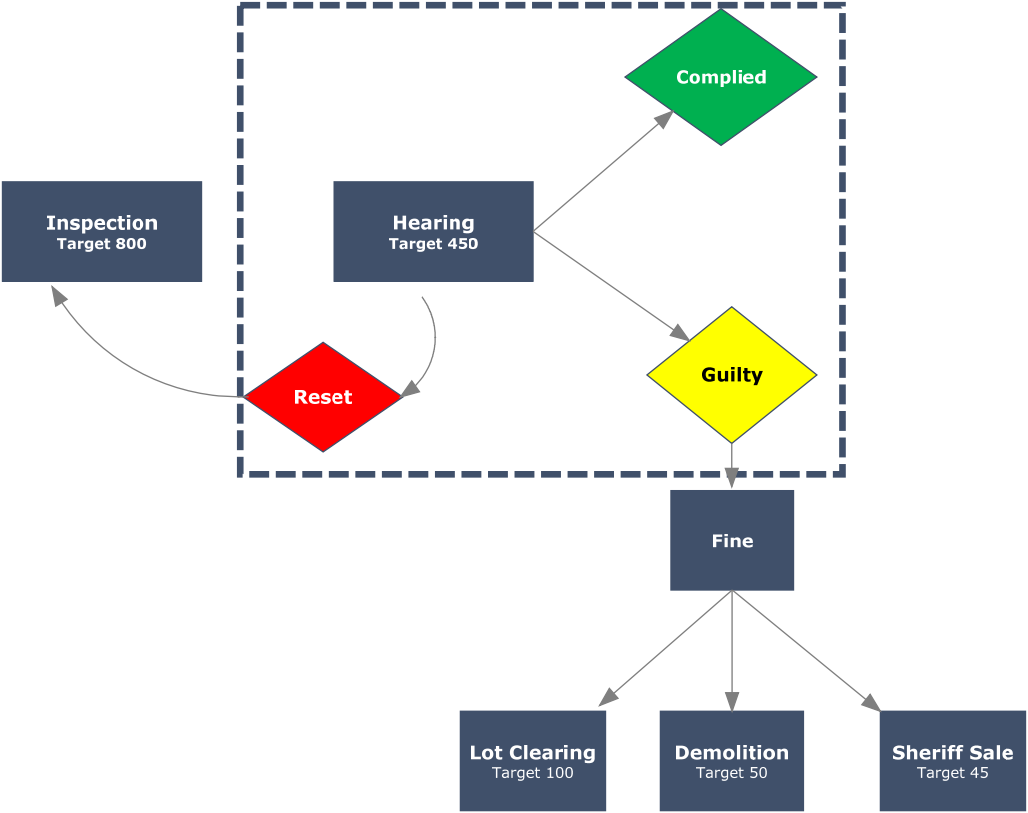
Inspections Backlog Feb 7 to Feb 18



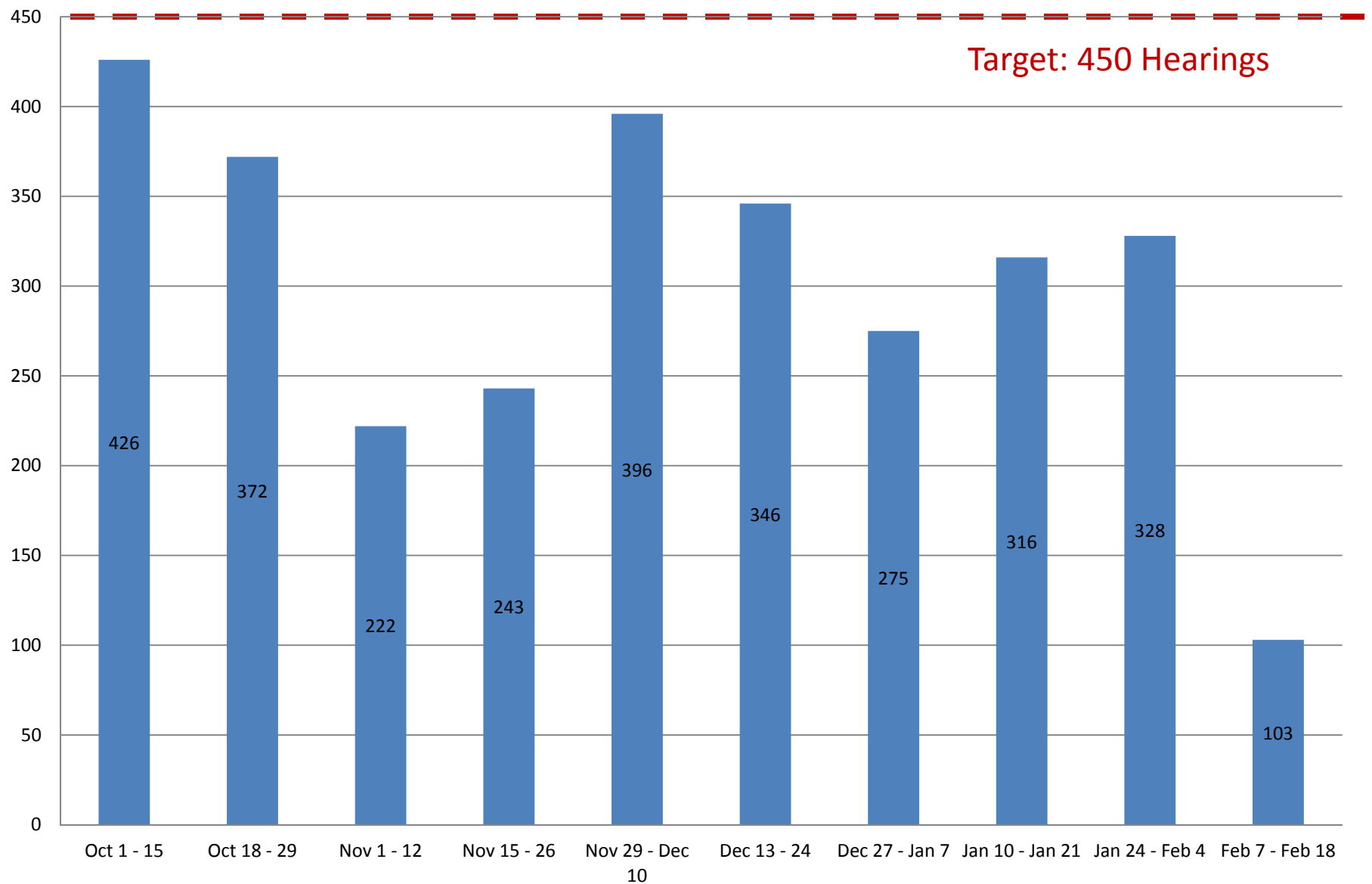

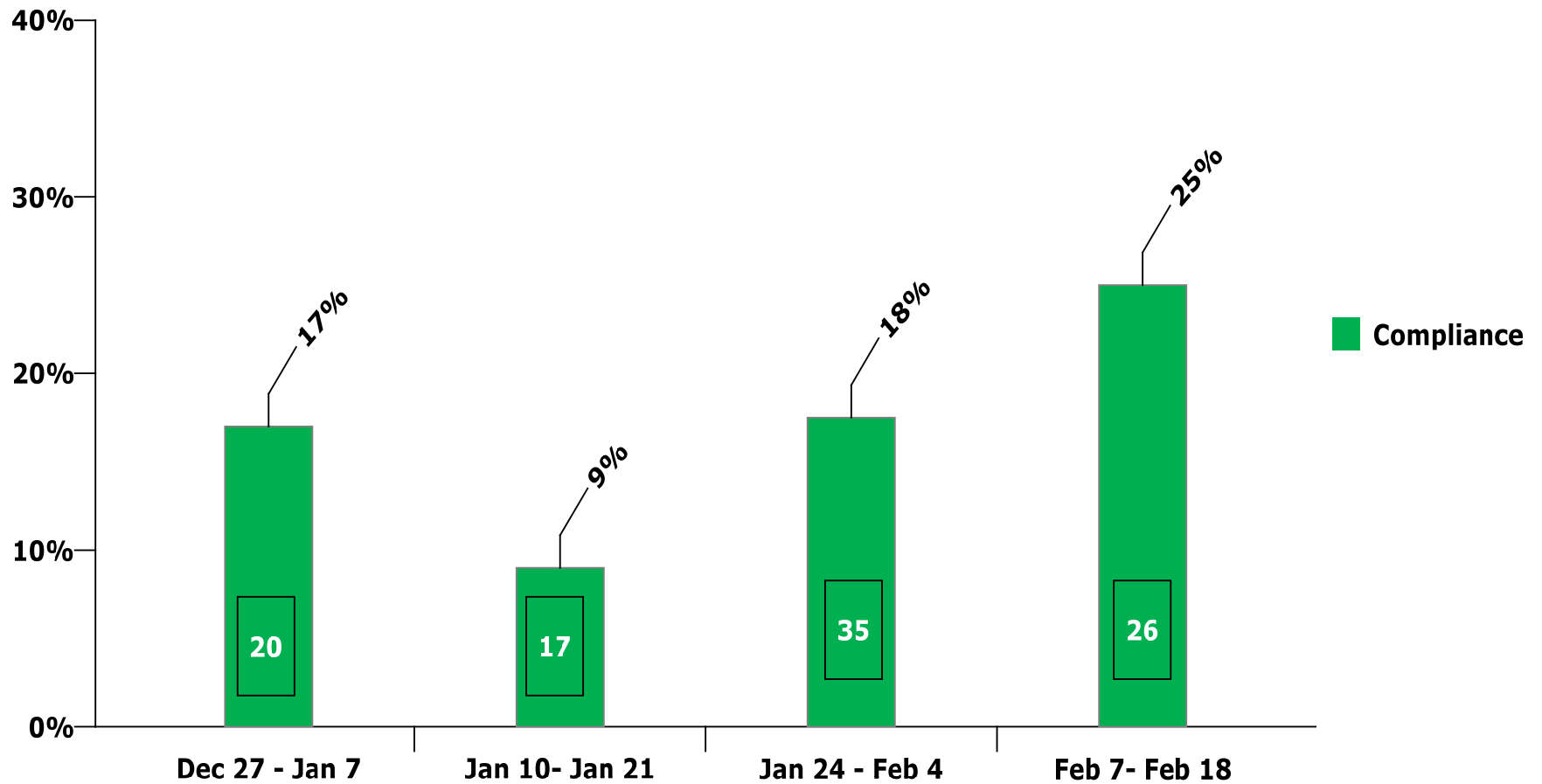
Code Enforcement Process Map

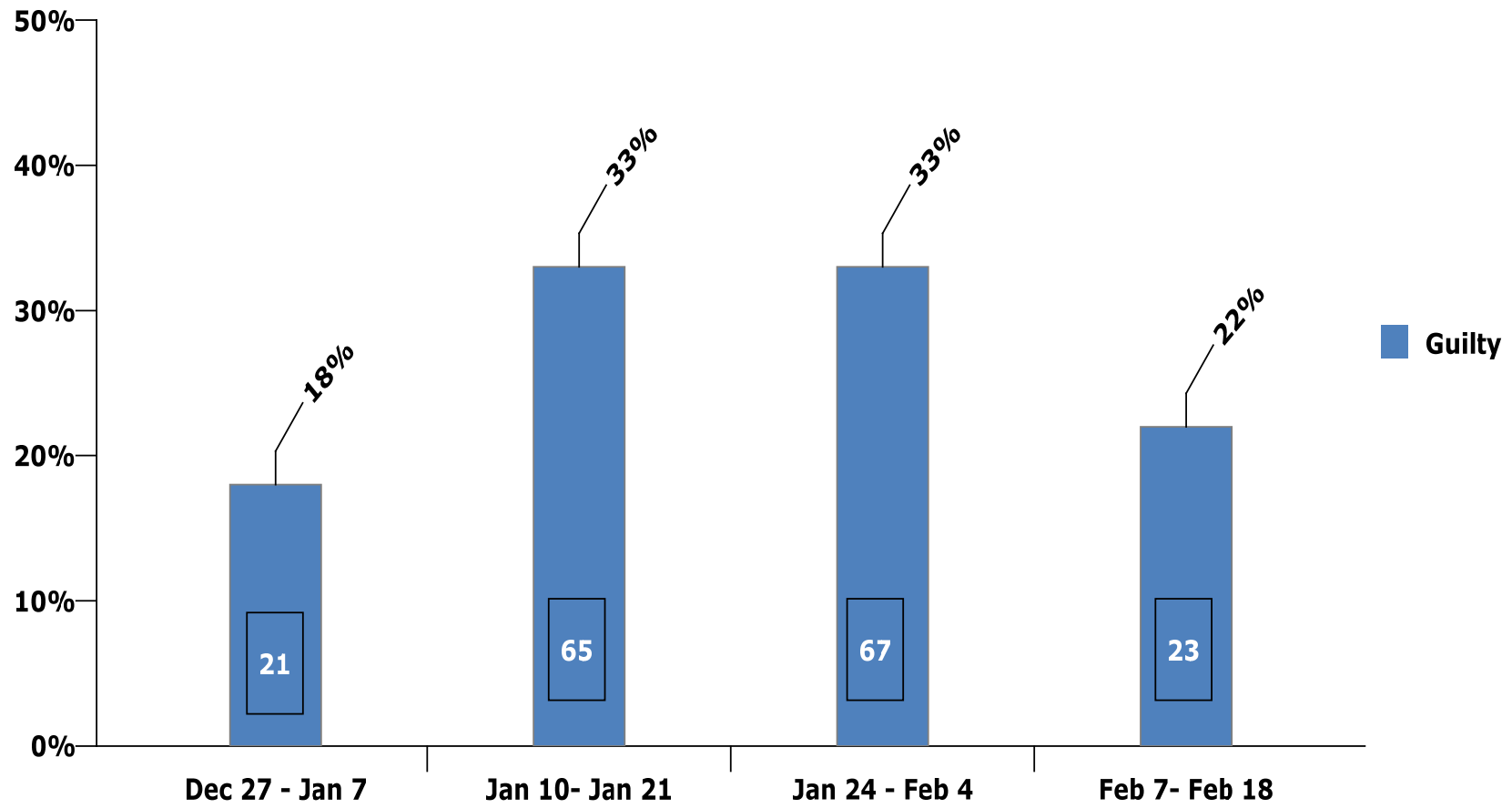
Total Hearings



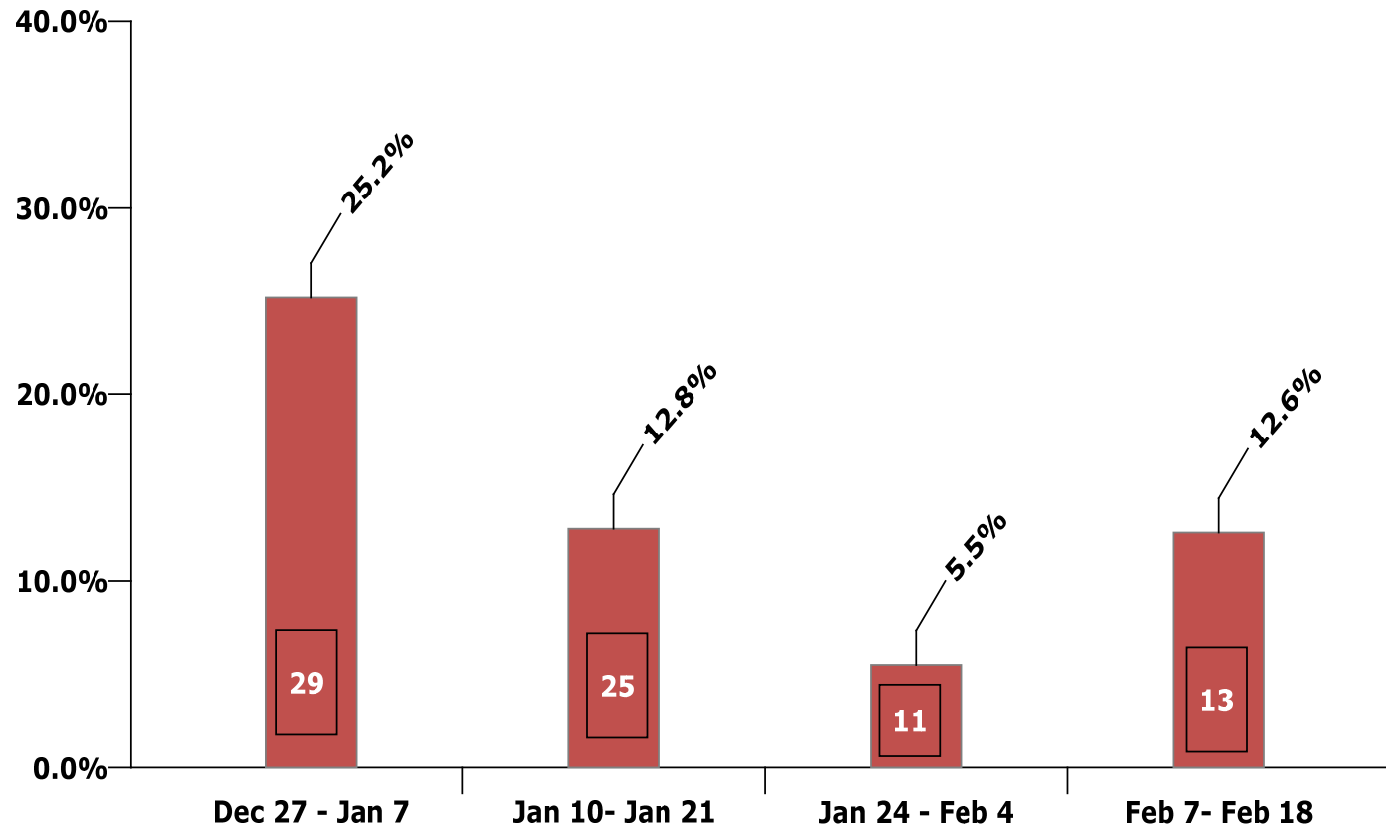
Compliance % Hearings



Guilty % Hearings



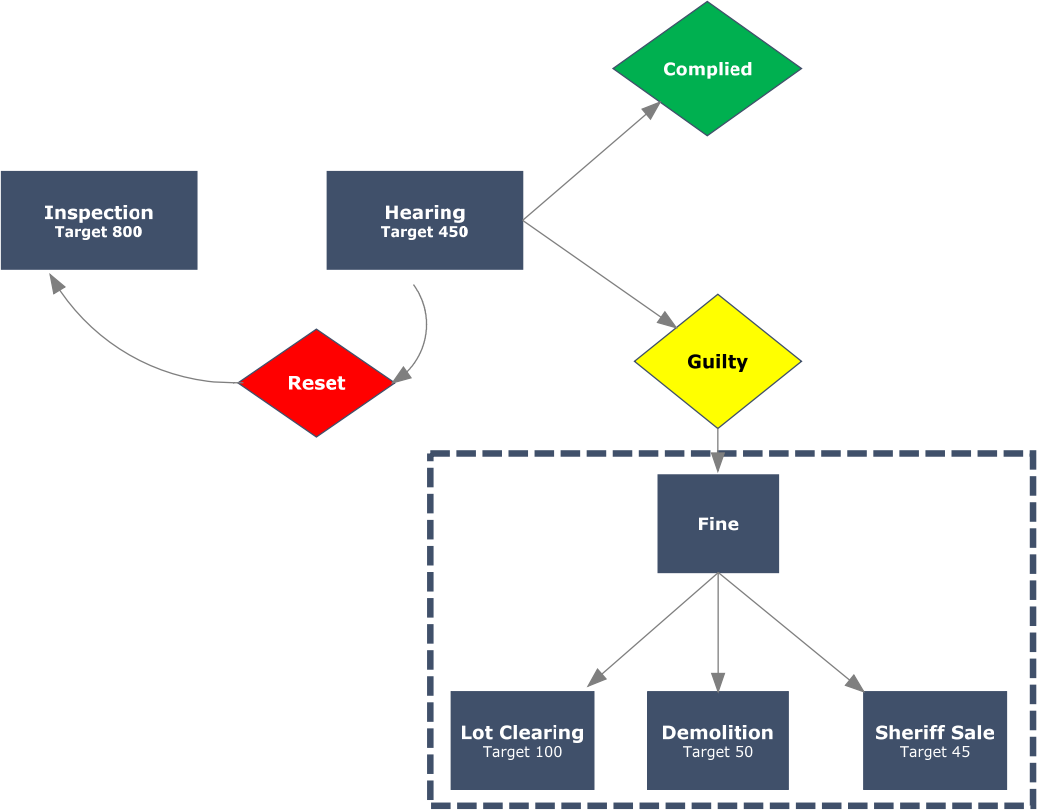
“Undesirable”* Resets as a Percent of Hearing Results



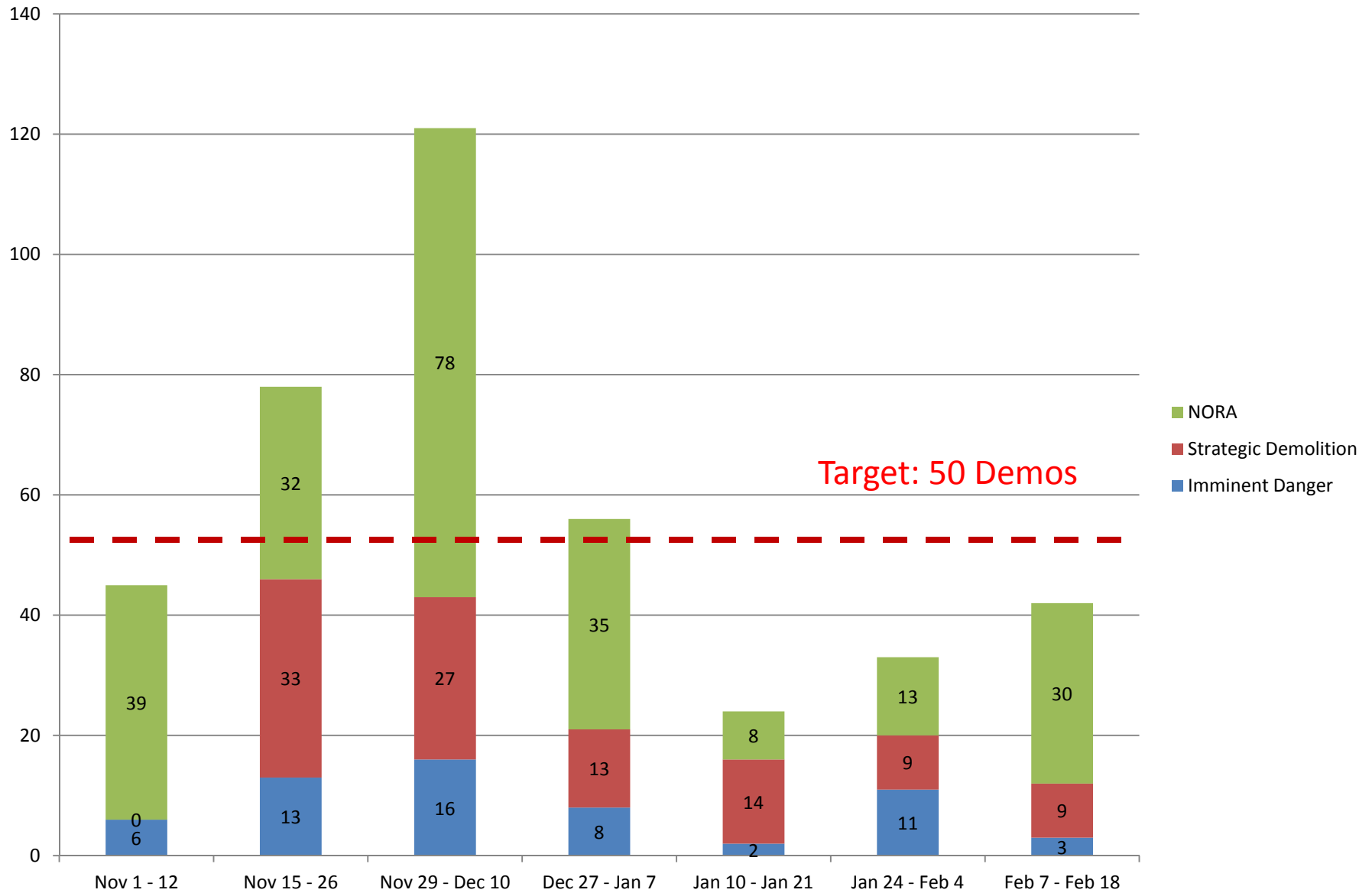

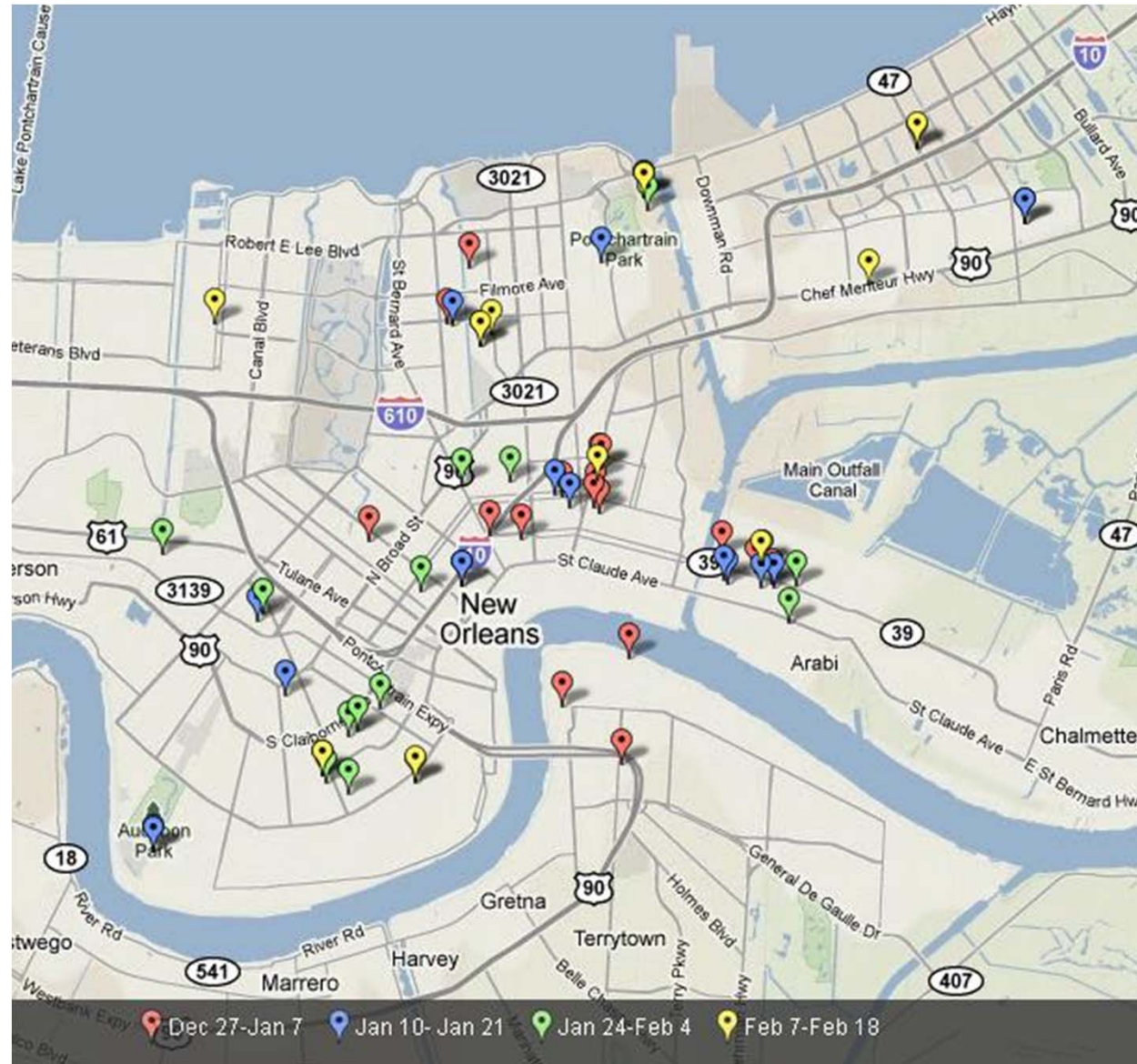

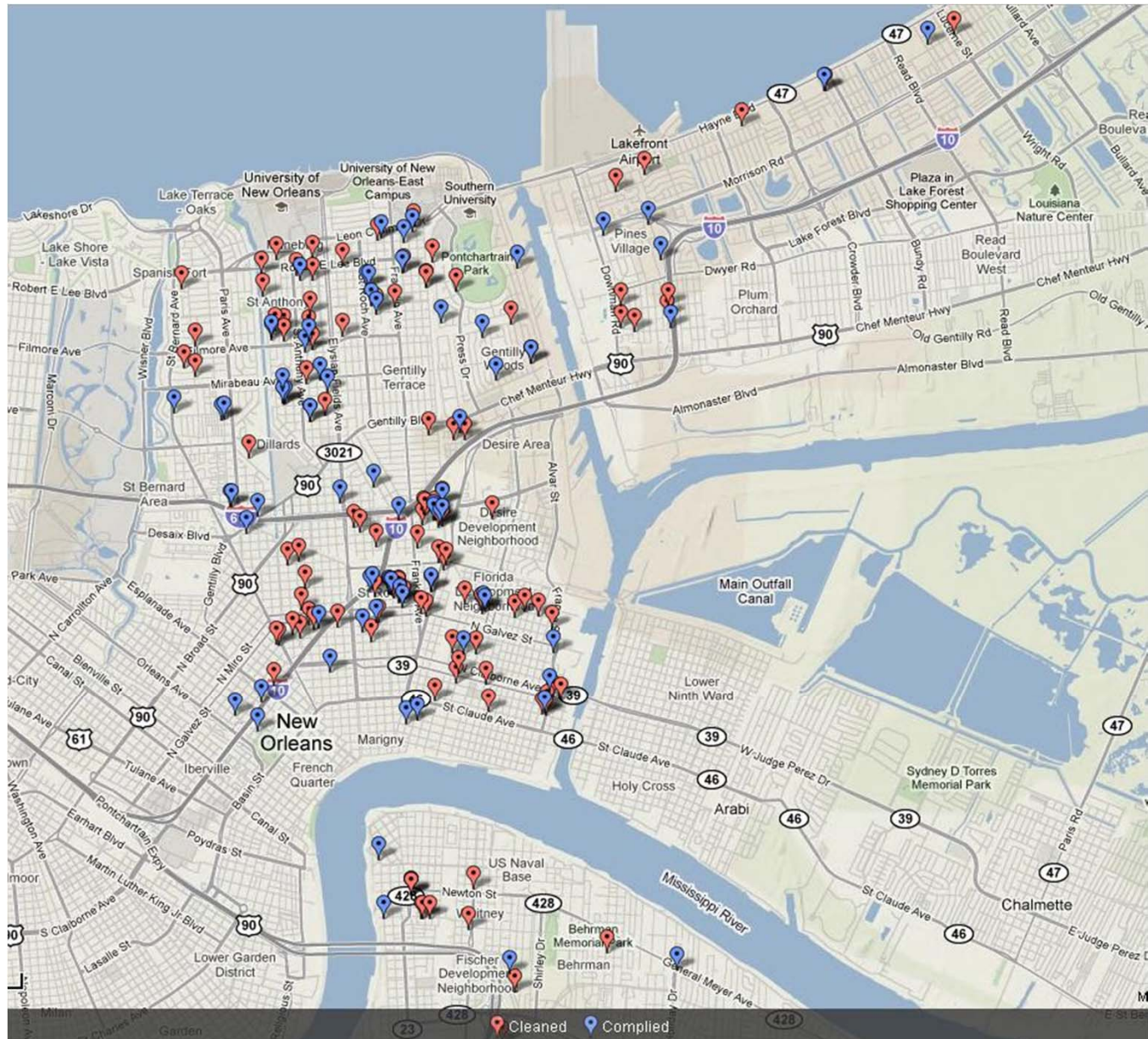

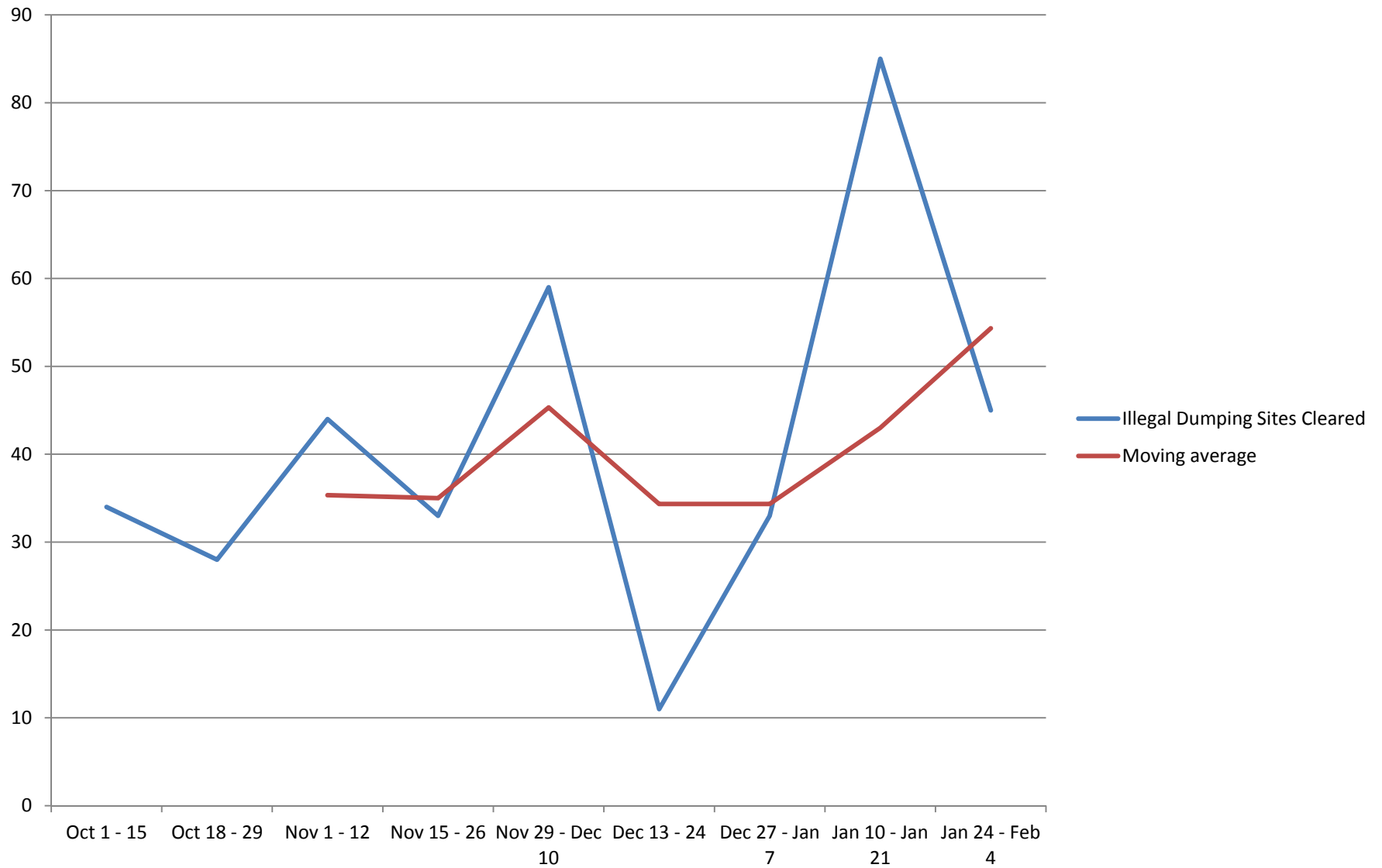

Lot Clearing and Voluntary Compliance

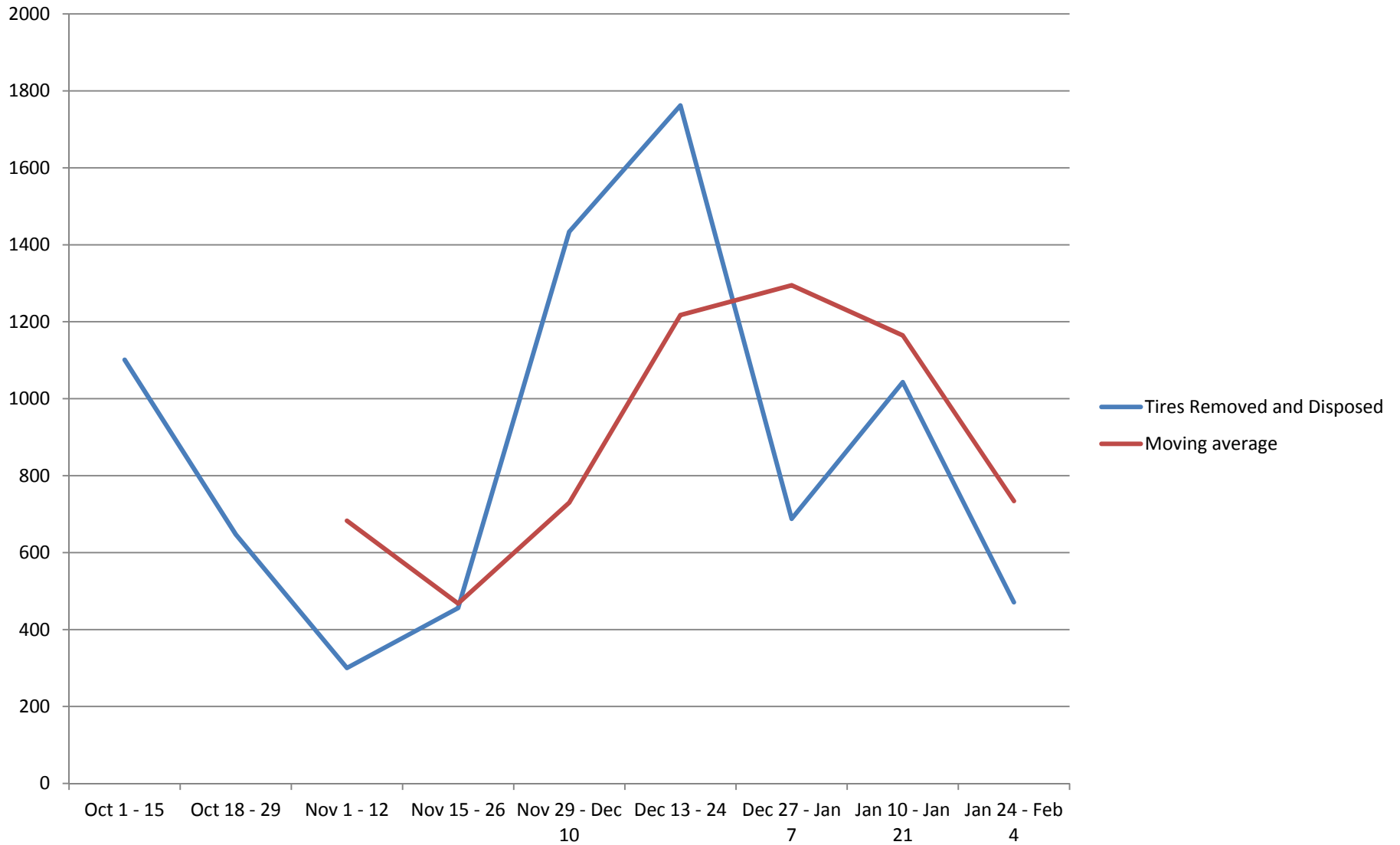

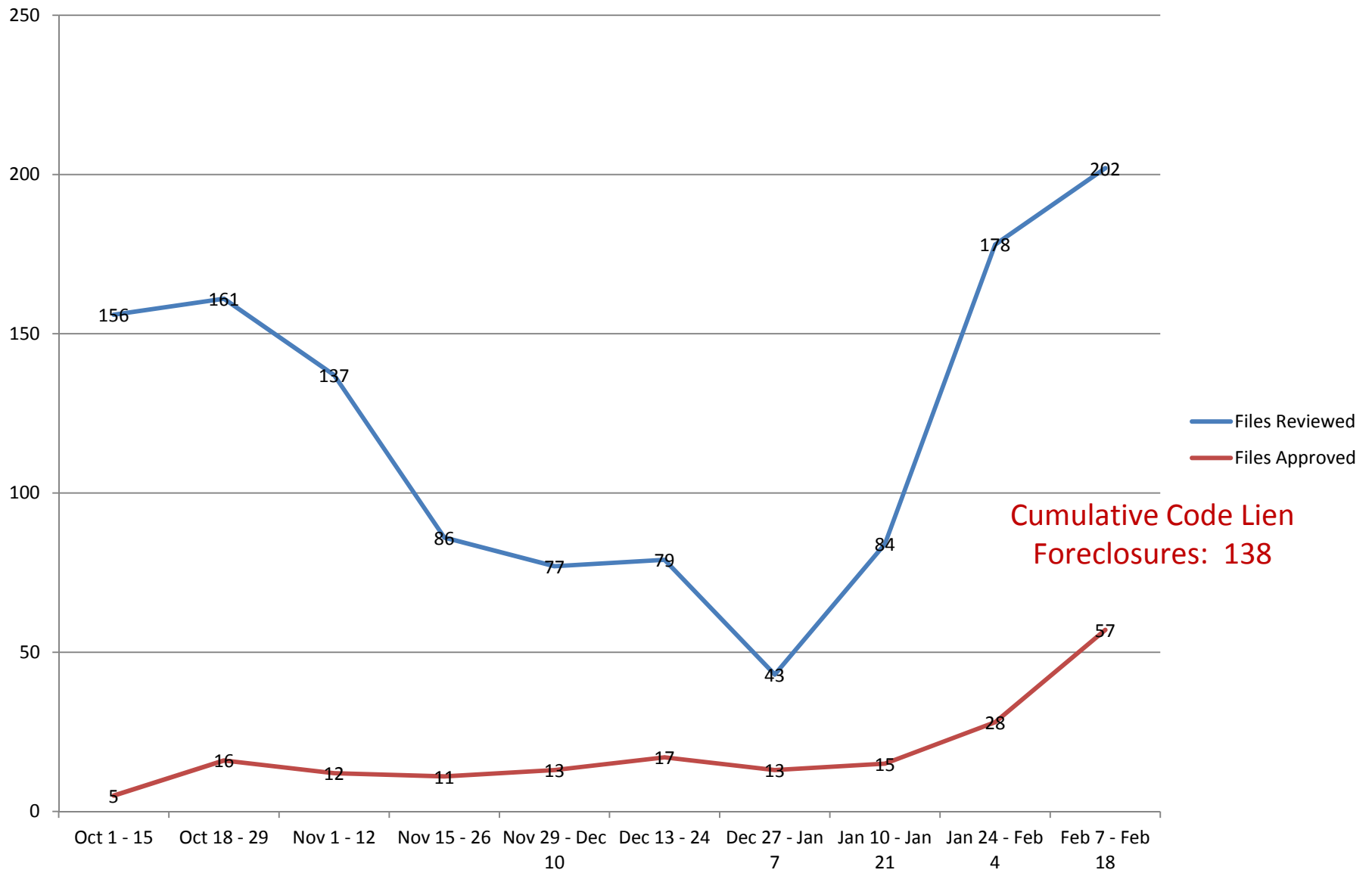
Illegal Dumping Sites Cleared



Tires Removed and Disposed



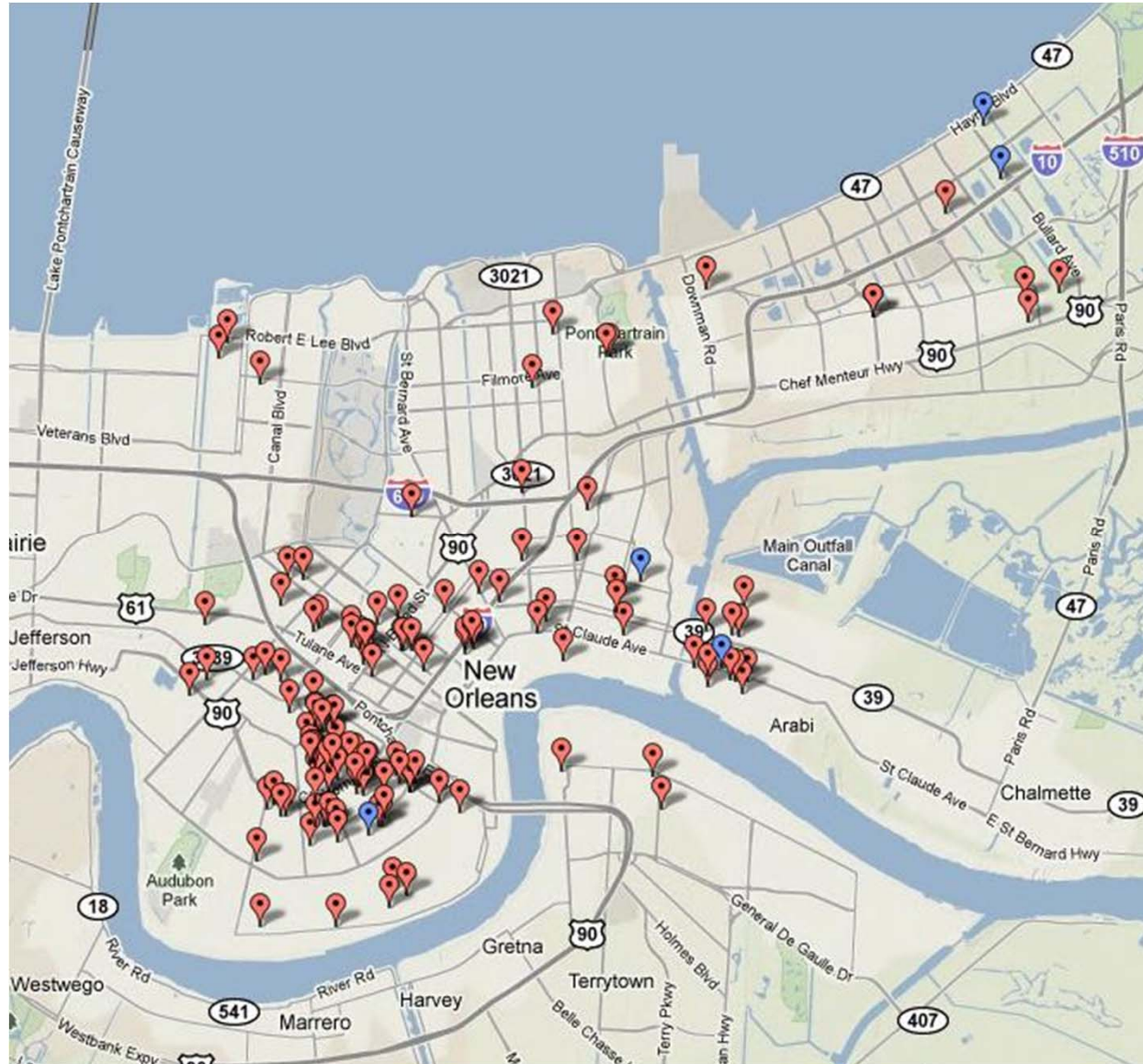
Sheriff Sale Files Reviewed and Accepted



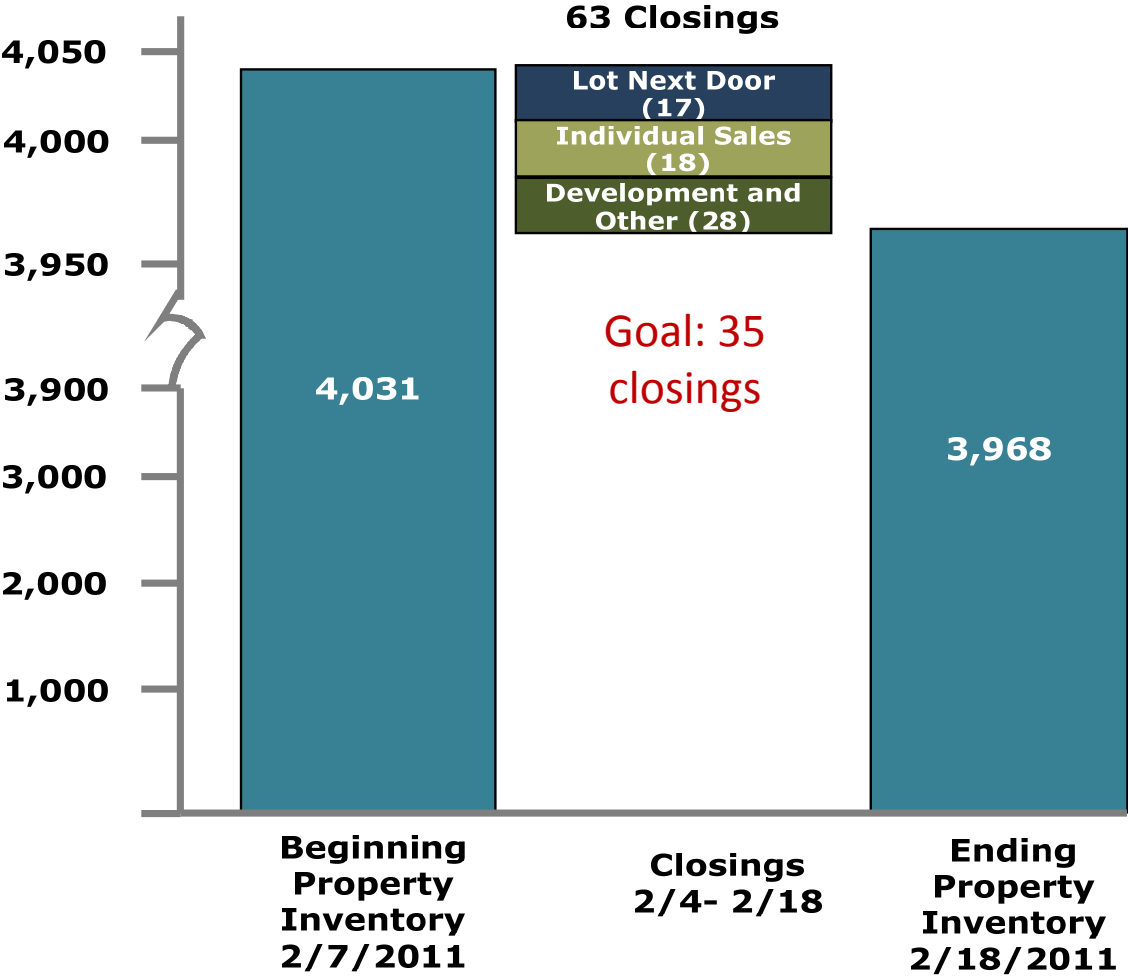
