Ambulatory/ Outpatient Medical Care	One unit is one visit based upon the American Medical Association (AMA) Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) coding.
LOCAL PHARMACY Assistance Program (LPAP)	One unit is based upon the dollar cost of medications from the approved formulary for uninsured clients.
EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES	One unit is based upon 15-minute intervals for the following encounters: • Pre-test counseling without test • Pre-test counseling with test • HIV negative (-) Post-test counseling • Indeterminate Post-test counseling • HIV+ Post-test counseling • Post-test Follow-Up (for HIV positive results only) • Health Literacy
Emergency Financial Assistance	<ul> <li>One unit is based upon the dollar cost for the following:</li> <li>Provision of a critically needed item ((e.g. fan, air conditioner, heater, refrigerator, microwave oven, bedding, ID card, coat) not to exceed \$100 per item with a \$300 maximum per client per year)).</li> <li>Provision of an essential utility (not to exceed \$500 per client per grant year) including, but not limited to electricity, gas, water/sewerage, heating oil and basic telephone service.</li> <li>Provision of medication needs unable to be addressed through LPAP, HIA, or LDAP. Medication coverage includes medications listed on the Ryan White Part A Formulary not to exceed the monthly medication cap of \$3,000 per client</li> </ul>
Food Bank/Home Delivered Meals	One unit is based upon: • One (1) nutritious home delivered meal • One (1) ten lb. bag of food
HEALTH EDUCATION AND RISK REDUCTION SERVICES	One unit is based upon 15-minute intervals for the following encounters: • Individual counseling session • Group counseling session
HEALTH INSURANCE Assistance	One unit is based upon the dollar cost of the following: • Medical, dental, vision and/or medication co-payment • Medical and/or medication deductible • Medical premium
HOME HEALTH CARE	One unit is based upon the American Medical Association (AMA) Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) coding or dollar cost for medical equipment/medical supplies
HOUSING ASSISTANCE	One unit is based upon the dollar cost of the following: •Short-term rental assistance (not to exceed two months per client, per year) •Discharge/transition plan

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LEGAL SERVICES	<ul> <li>One unit is based upon 15-minute intervals for the following encounters:</li> <li>Legal Assessment</li> <li>Documents related to personal and estate planning, such as Wills, Living Wills, or Powers of Attorney</li> <li>Simple succession matters</li> <li>Matters of discrimination, including housing and employment</li> <li>Provision of notarial services</li> <li>Assistance with debtor problems related to HIV status</li> <li>Public benefits, including insurance and employee benefits</li> <li>Privacy issues</li> </ul>

MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICES	One unit is based upon the dollar cost of the following: • Bus tokens for medical appointments • Taxi fare for medical appointments • Approved mileage rate for medical appointments
Mental Health	One unit is based upon the American Medical Association (AMA) Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) coding.

ORAL HEALTH CARE	One unit is based upon the American Medical Association (AMA) Current Dental Terminology (CDT) coding.
PSYCHOSOCIAL SUPPORT SERVICES	One unit is based upon 15 minute intervals for the following encounters: • Support counseling • Assessment • Re-assessment • Individual counseling session • Group counseling session • Adherence counseling session
