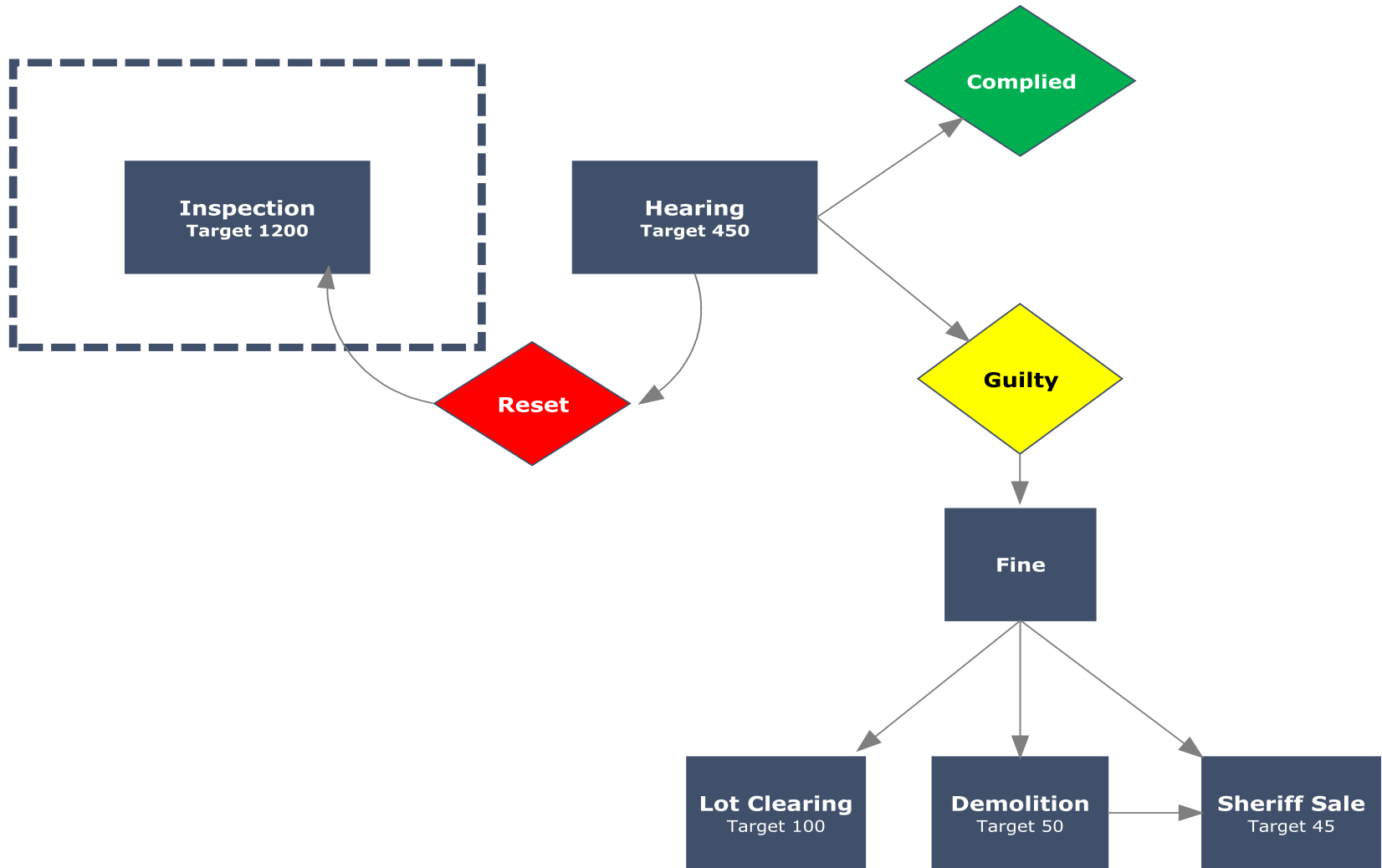

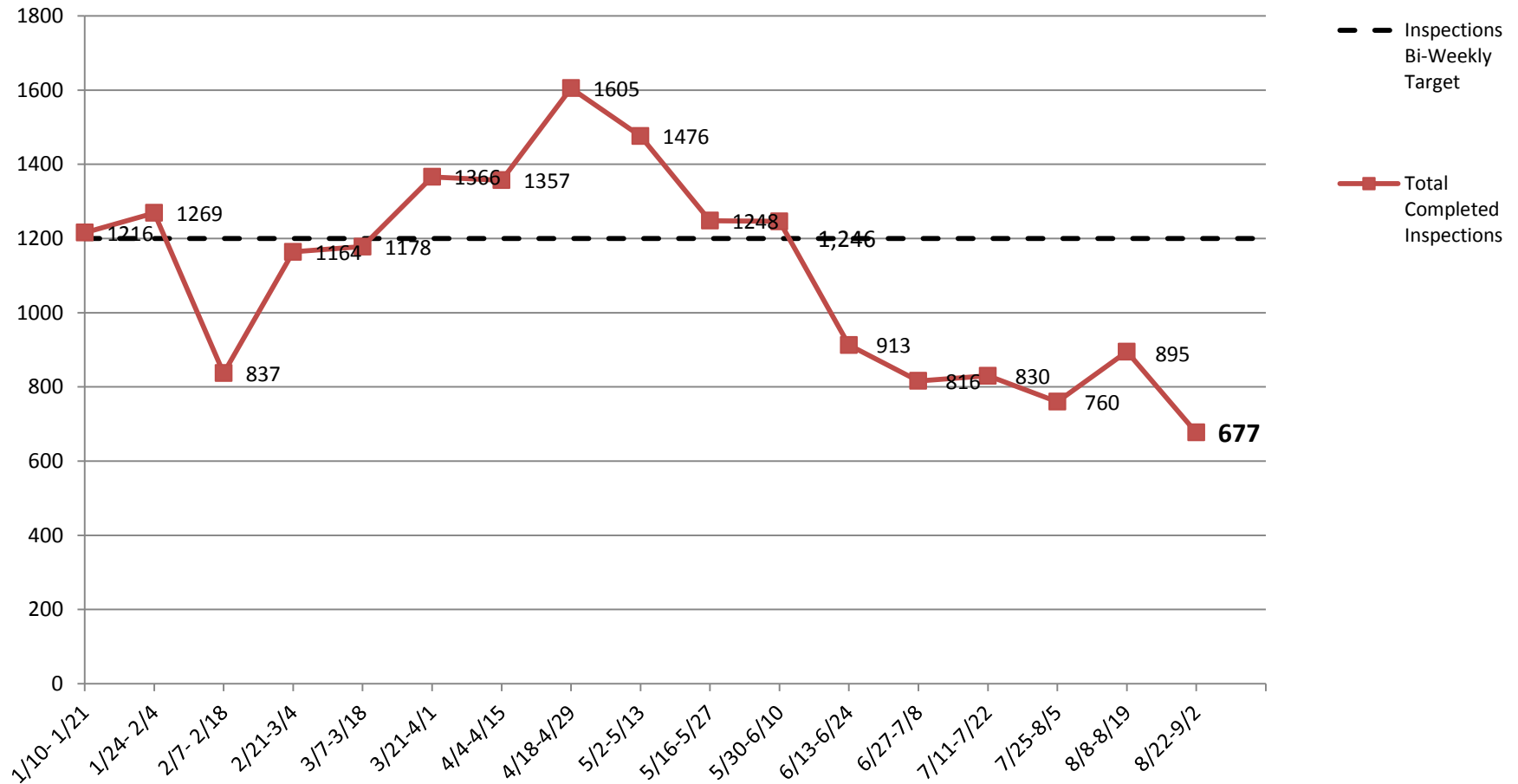

Code Enforcement Process Map

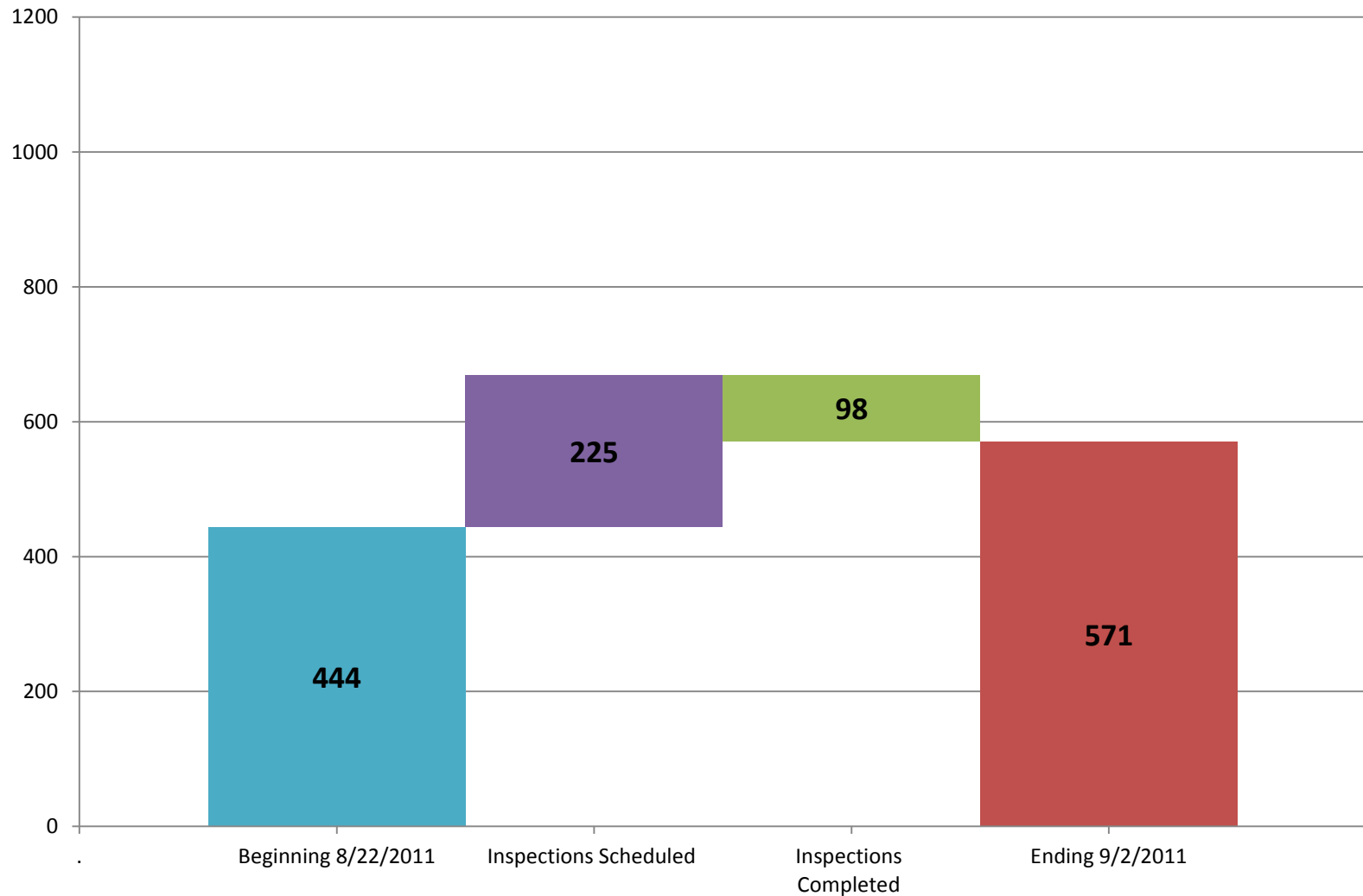

Total Code Enforcement Inspections Exceed Annual Goal, Fall Below Bi-Weekly Target



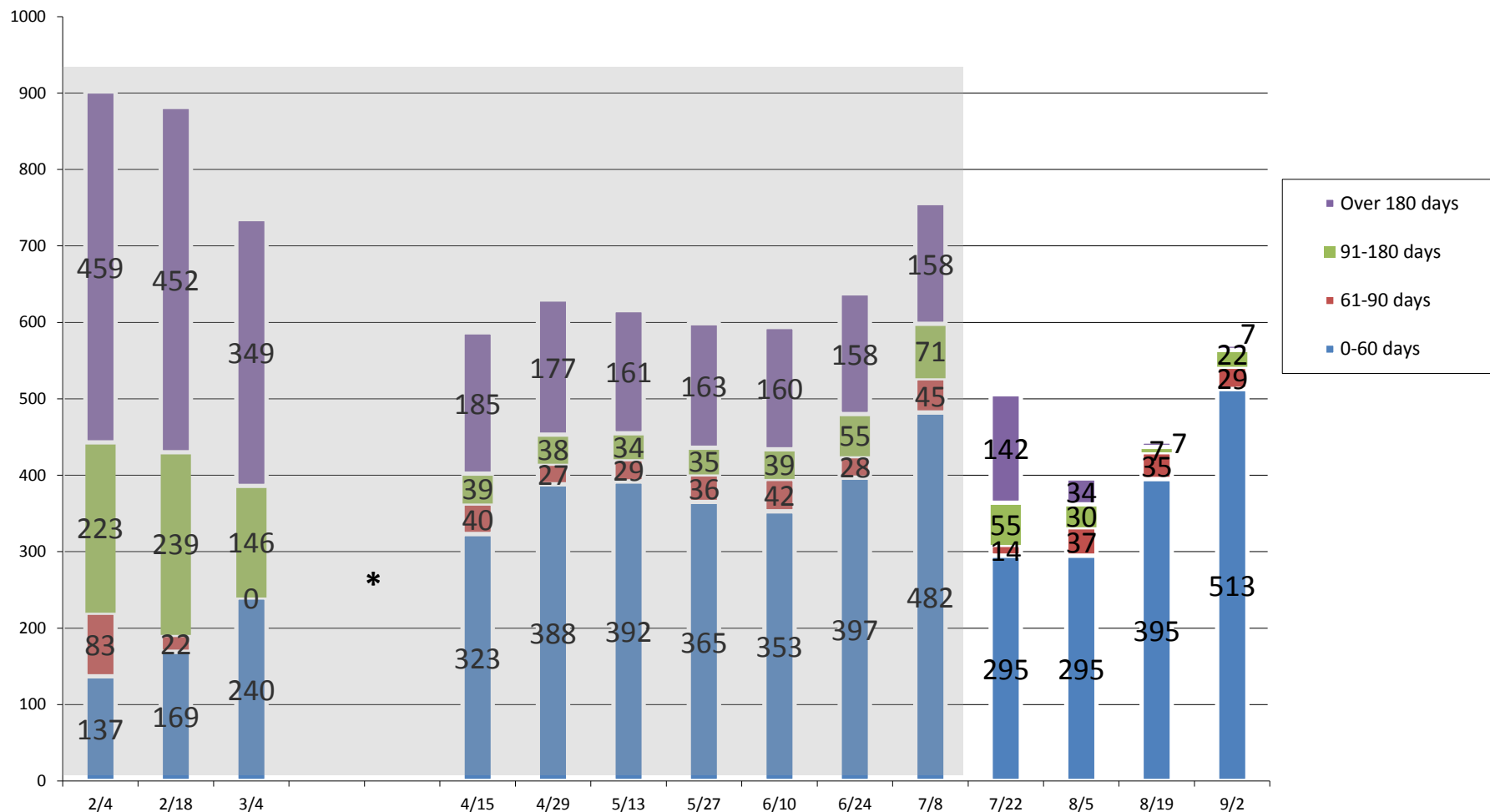
Inspections Backlog August 22- September 2, 2011

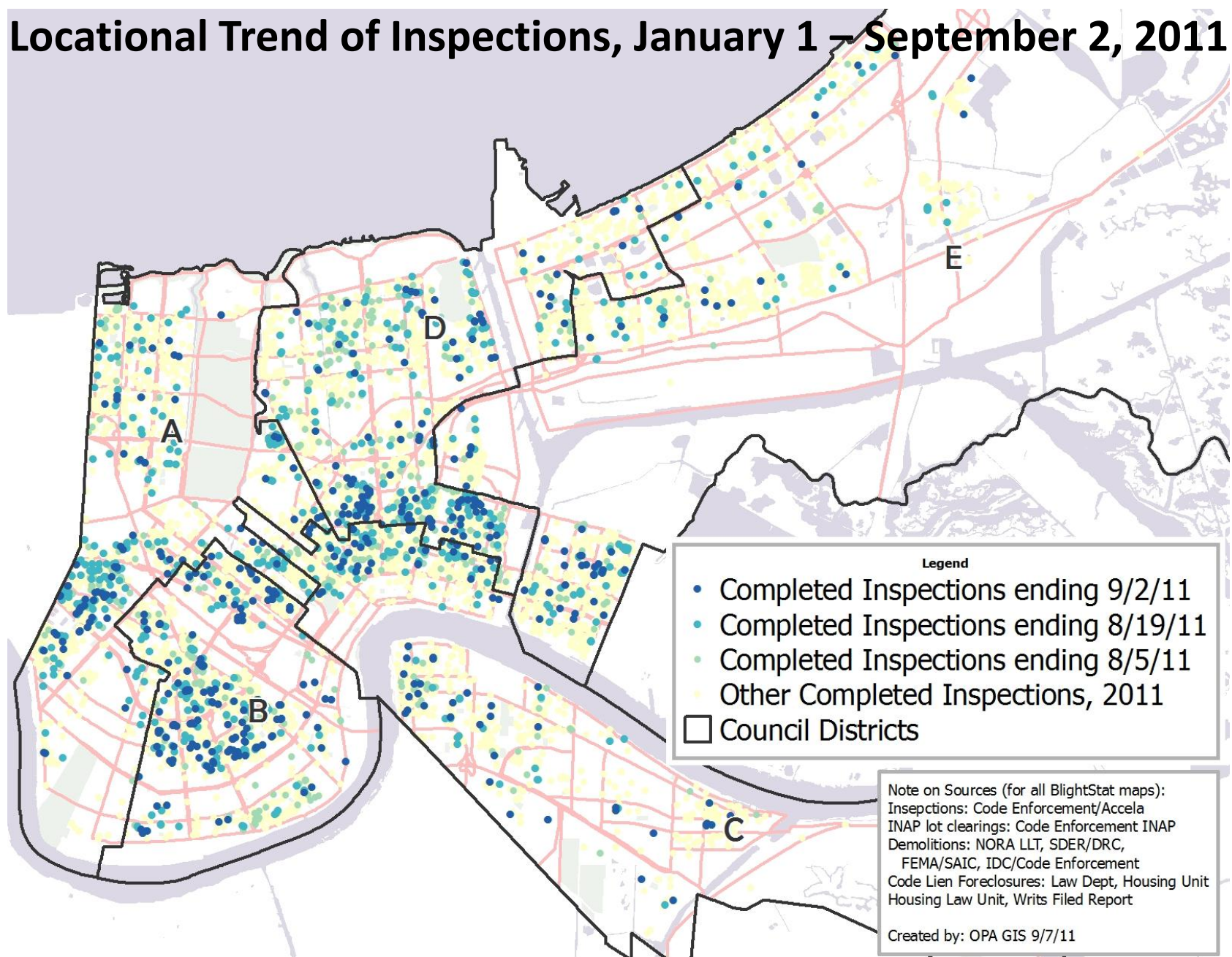
Age of Inspections Backlog



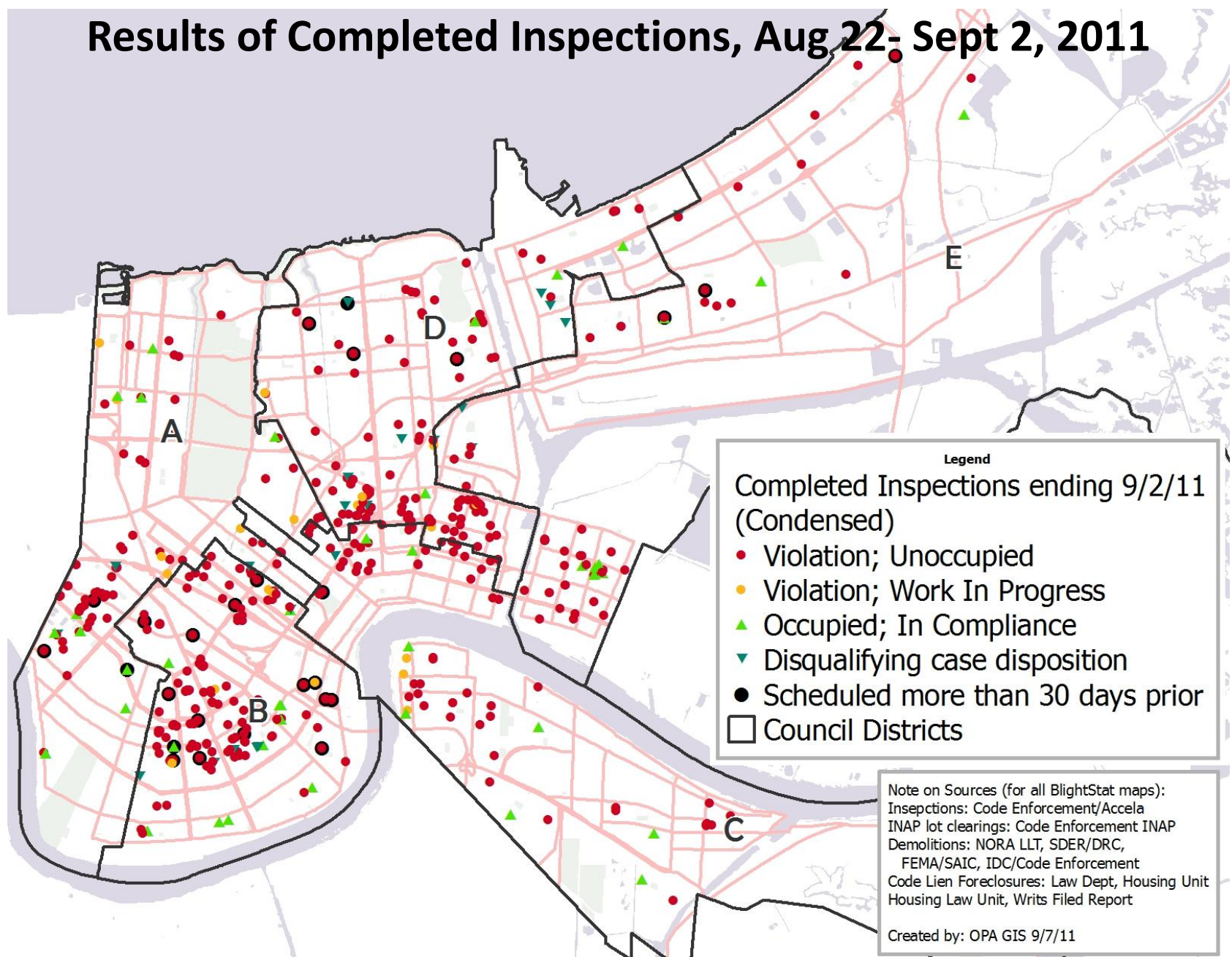

Locational Trend of Inspections, January 1 – September 2, 2011

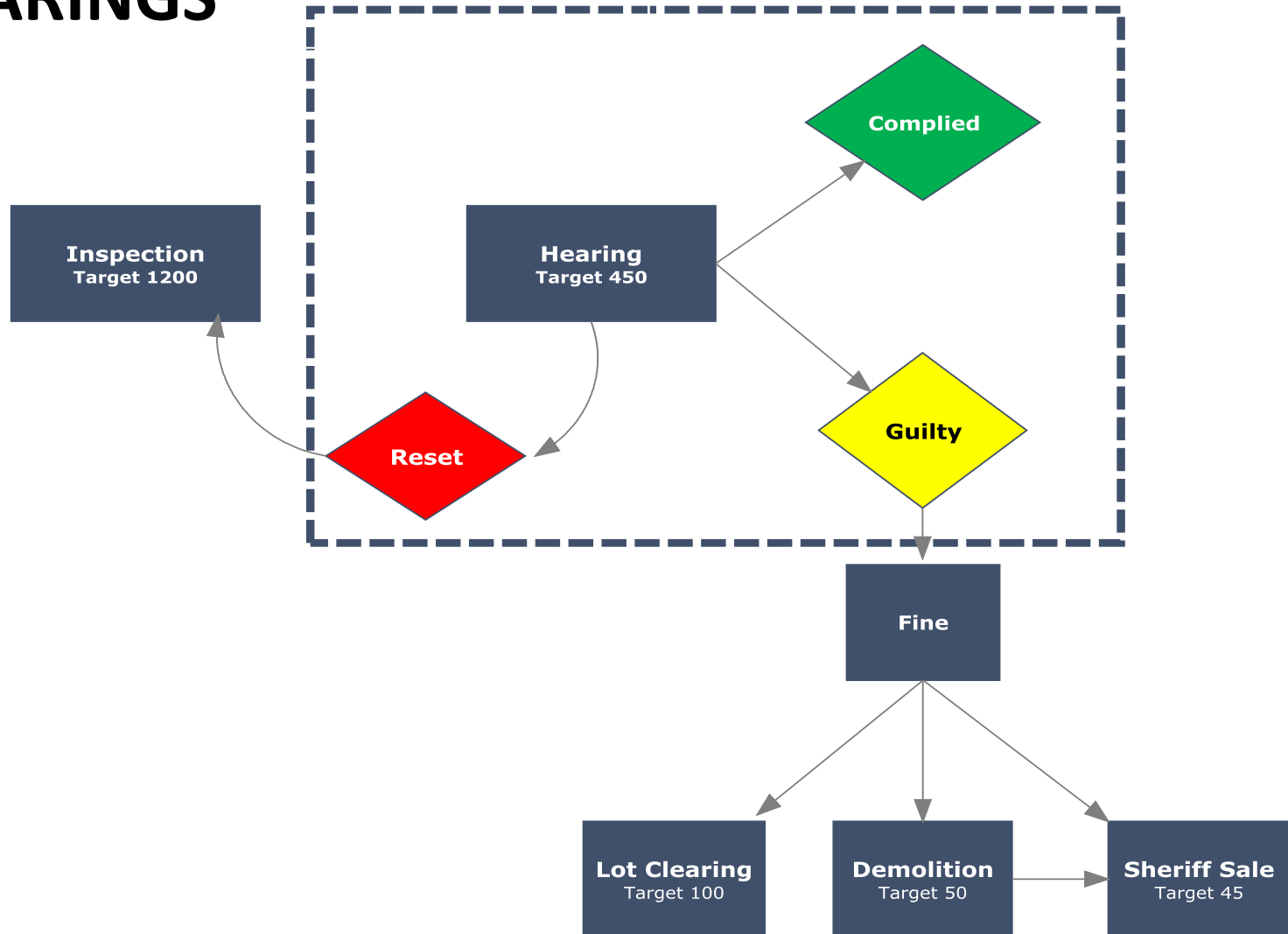


Results of Completed Inspections, Aug 22- Sept 2, 2011

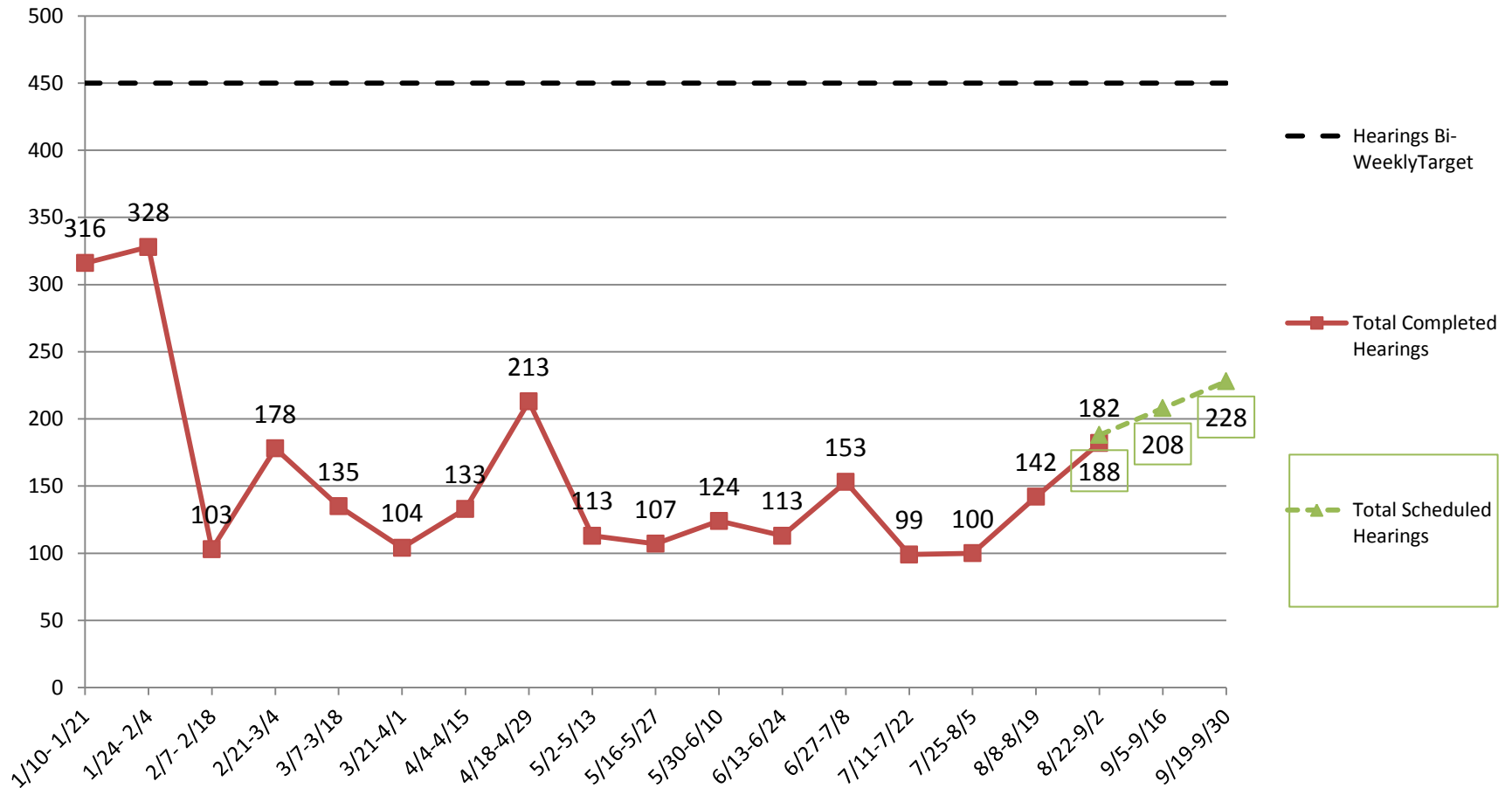


Code Enforcement Process Map

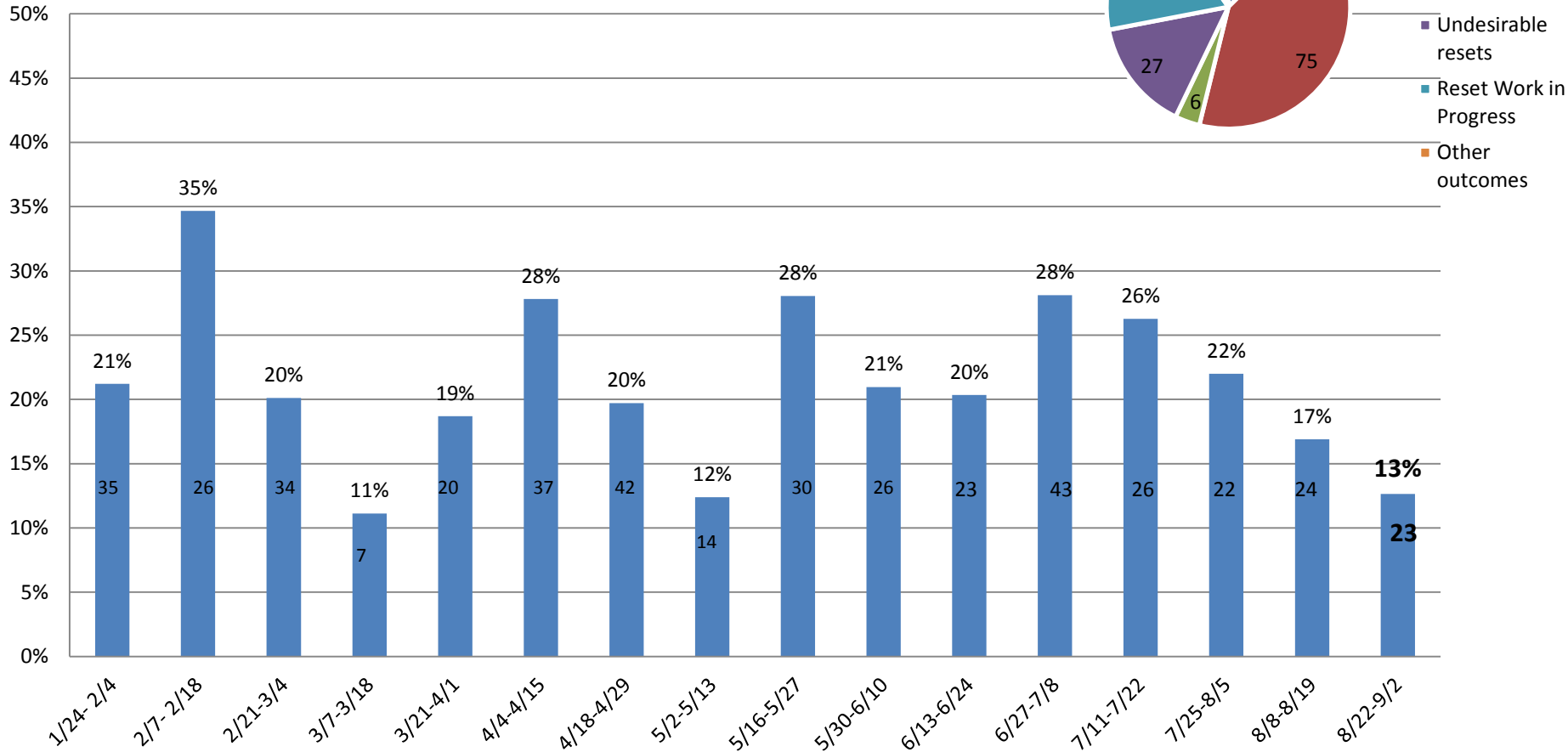

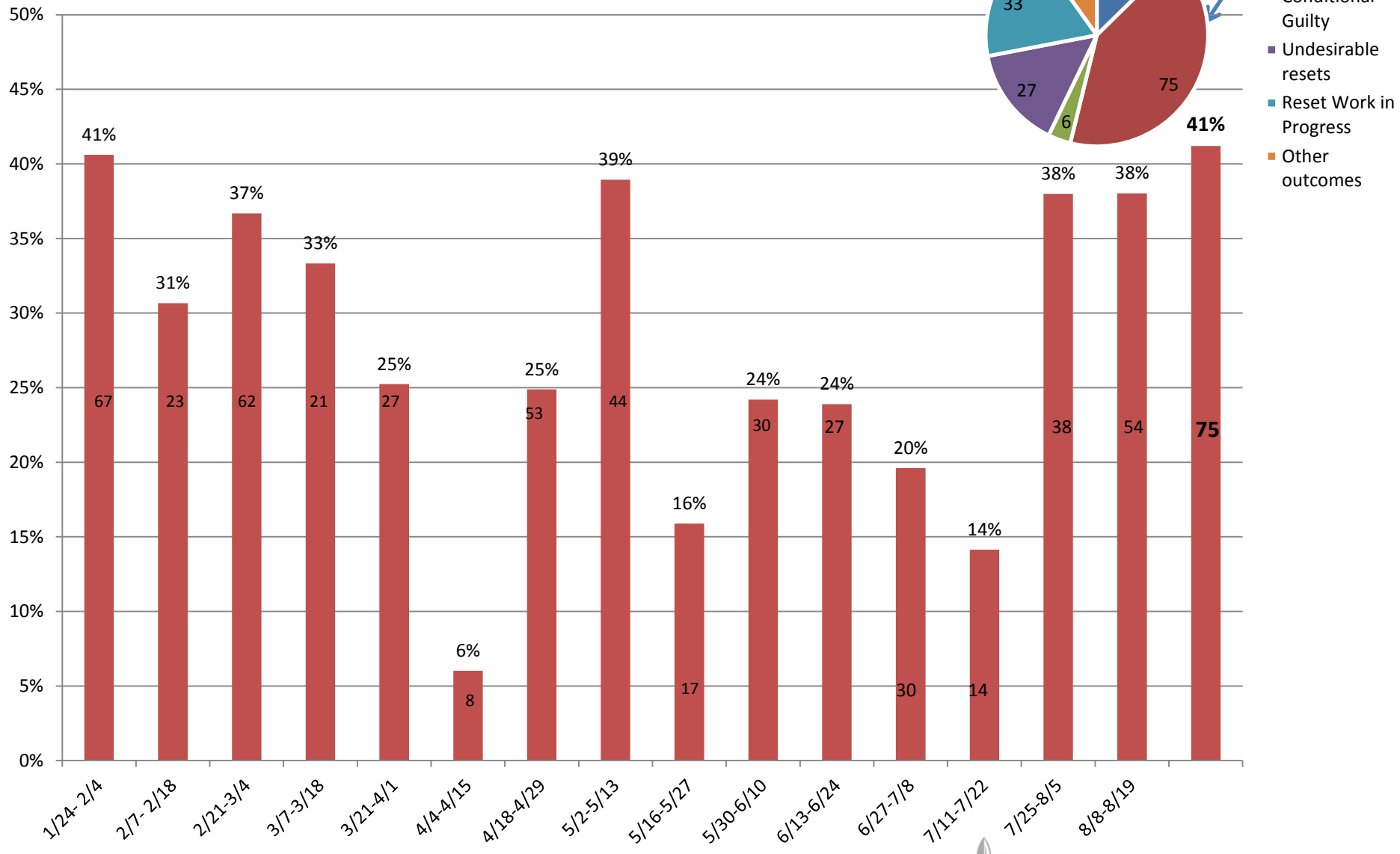

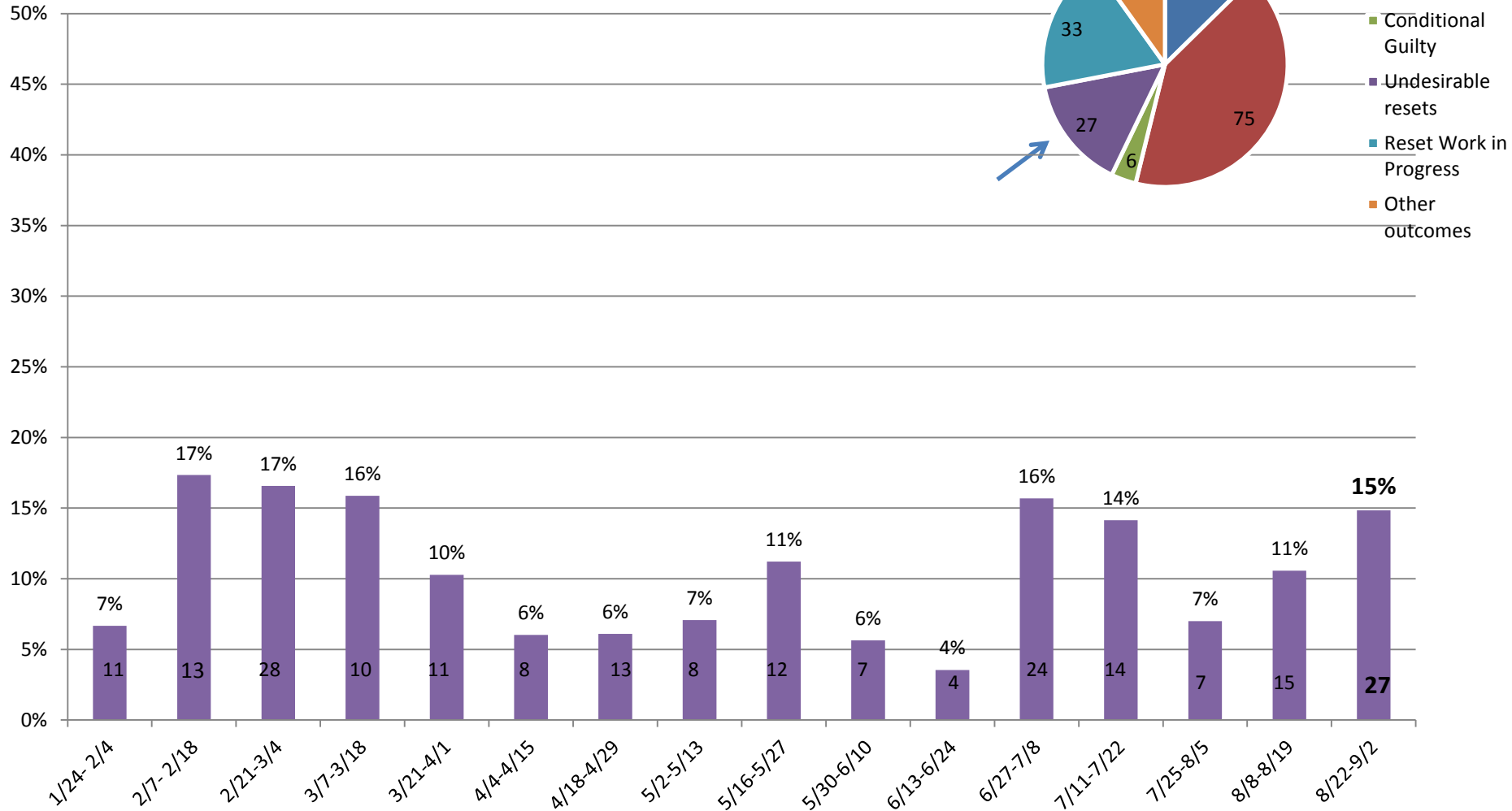

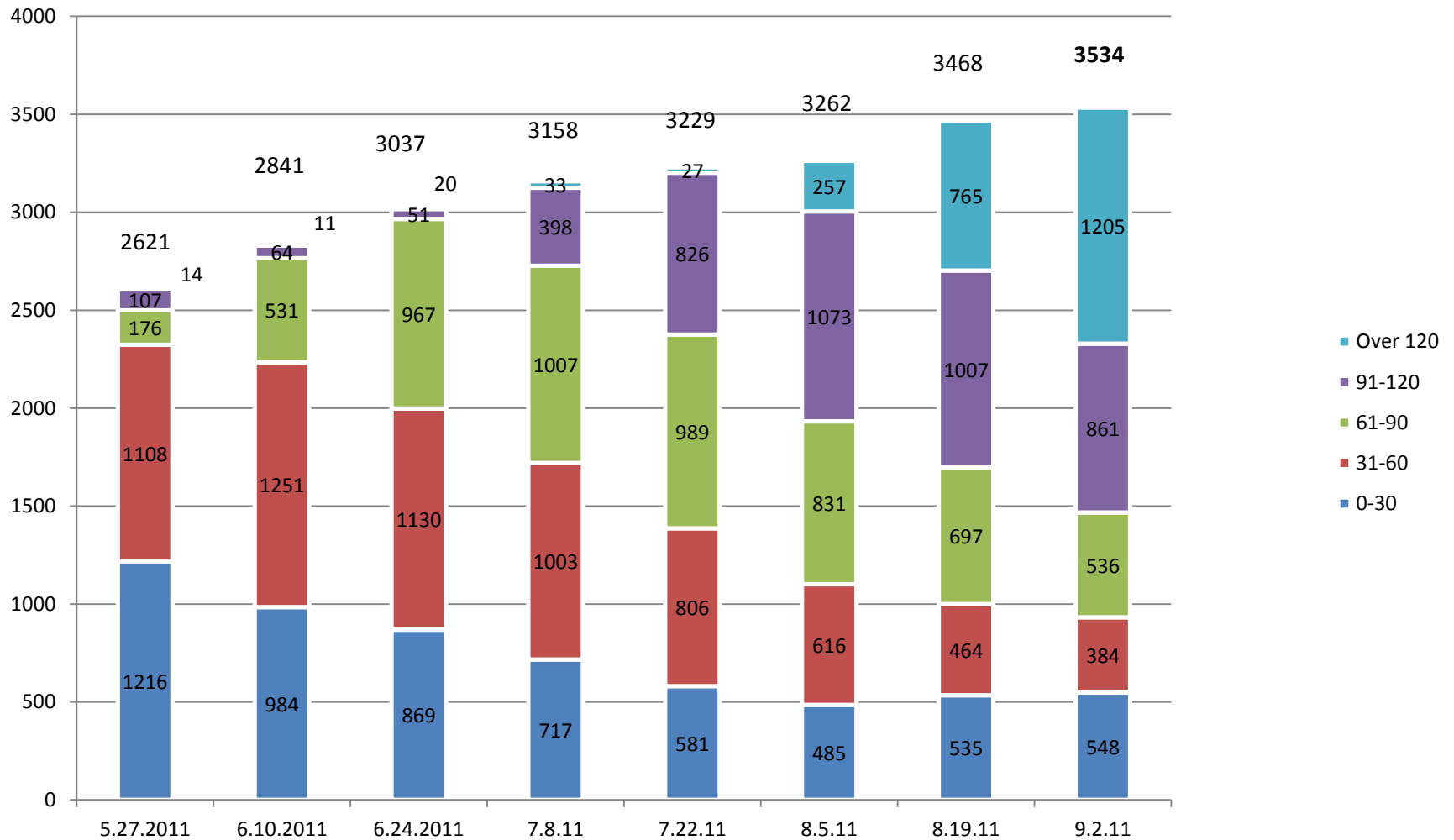

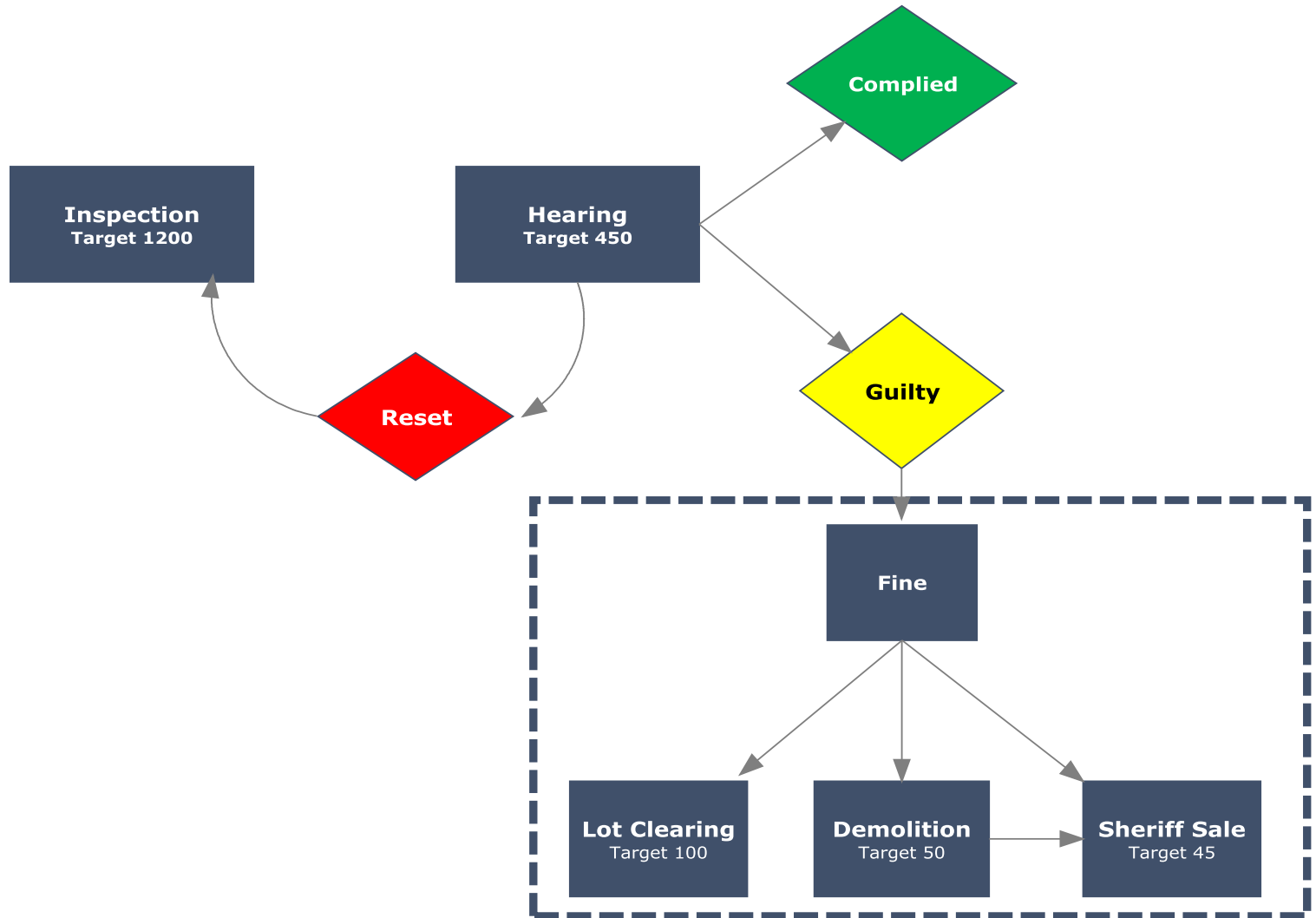

Unscheduled Hearings Backlog: Aging Report

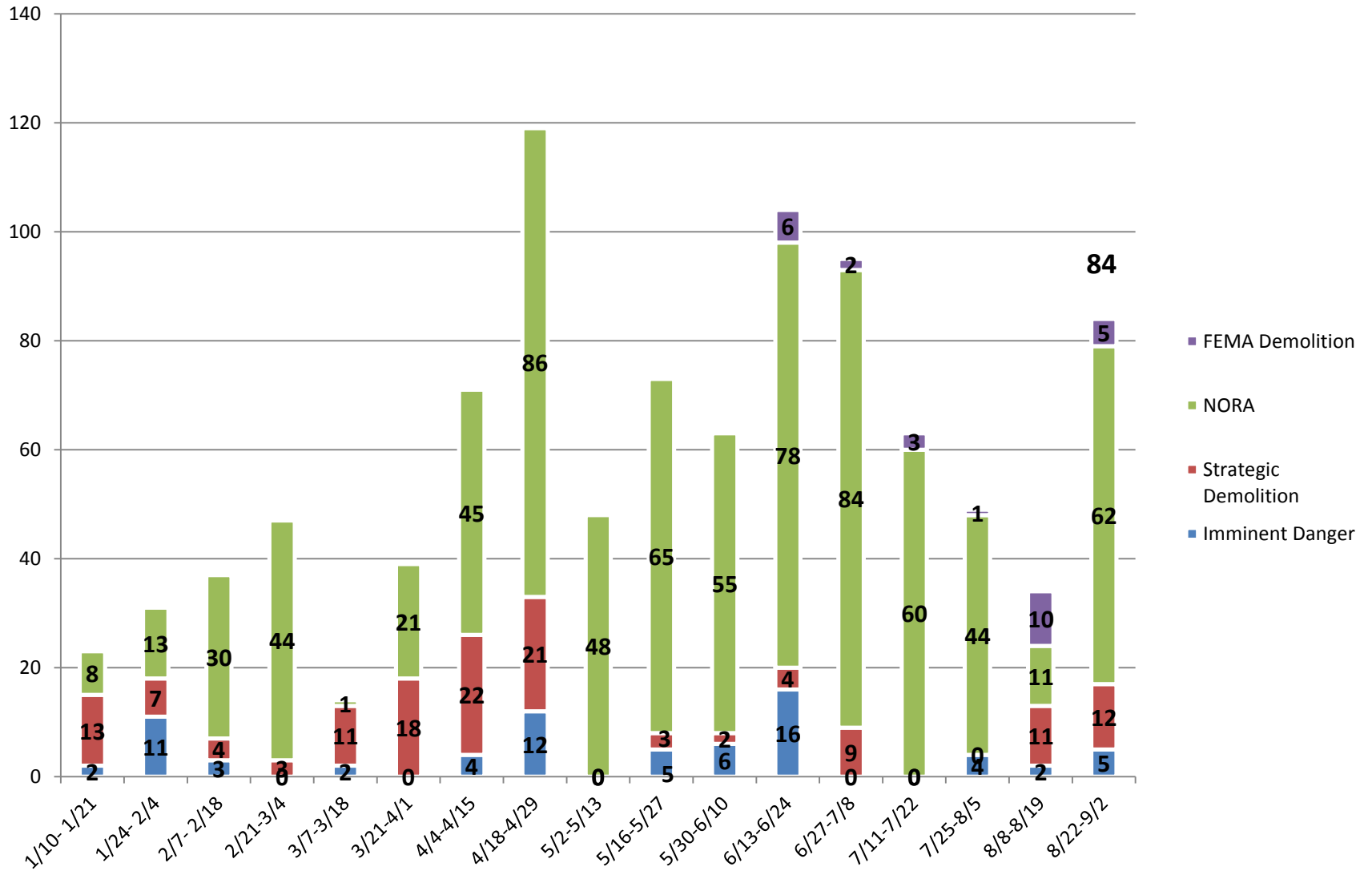


Code Enforcement Process Map

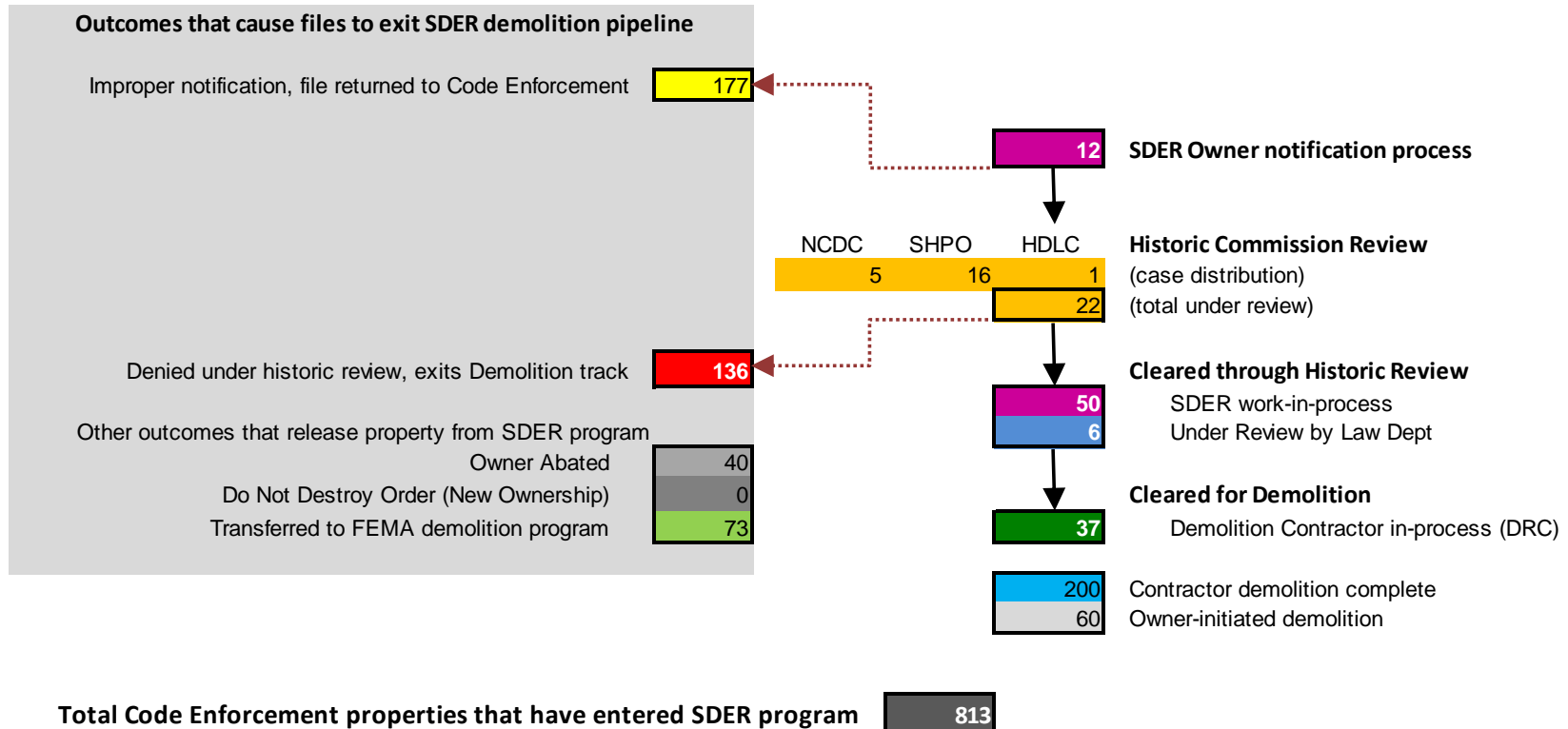

Strategic Demolition Process and Outcomes

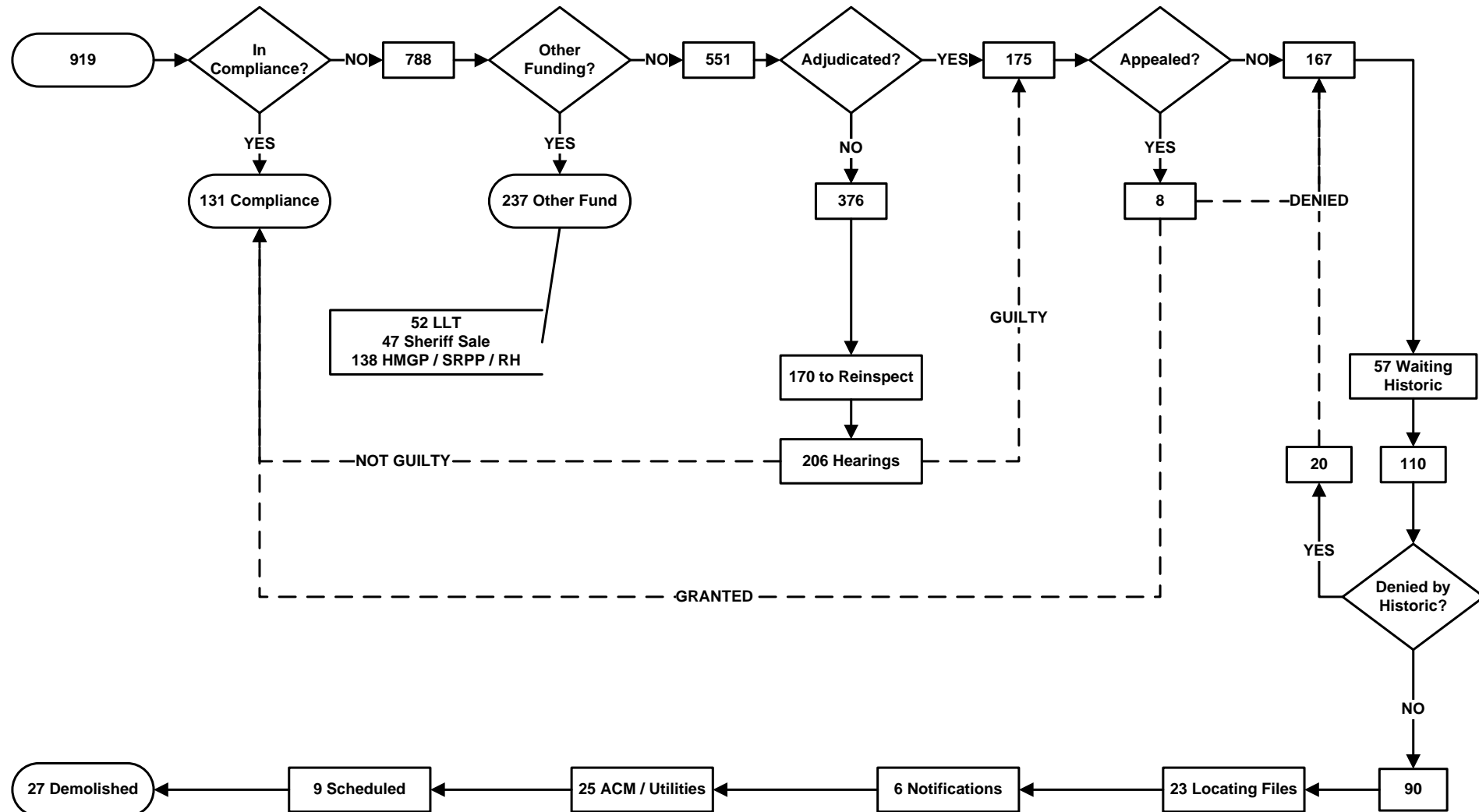

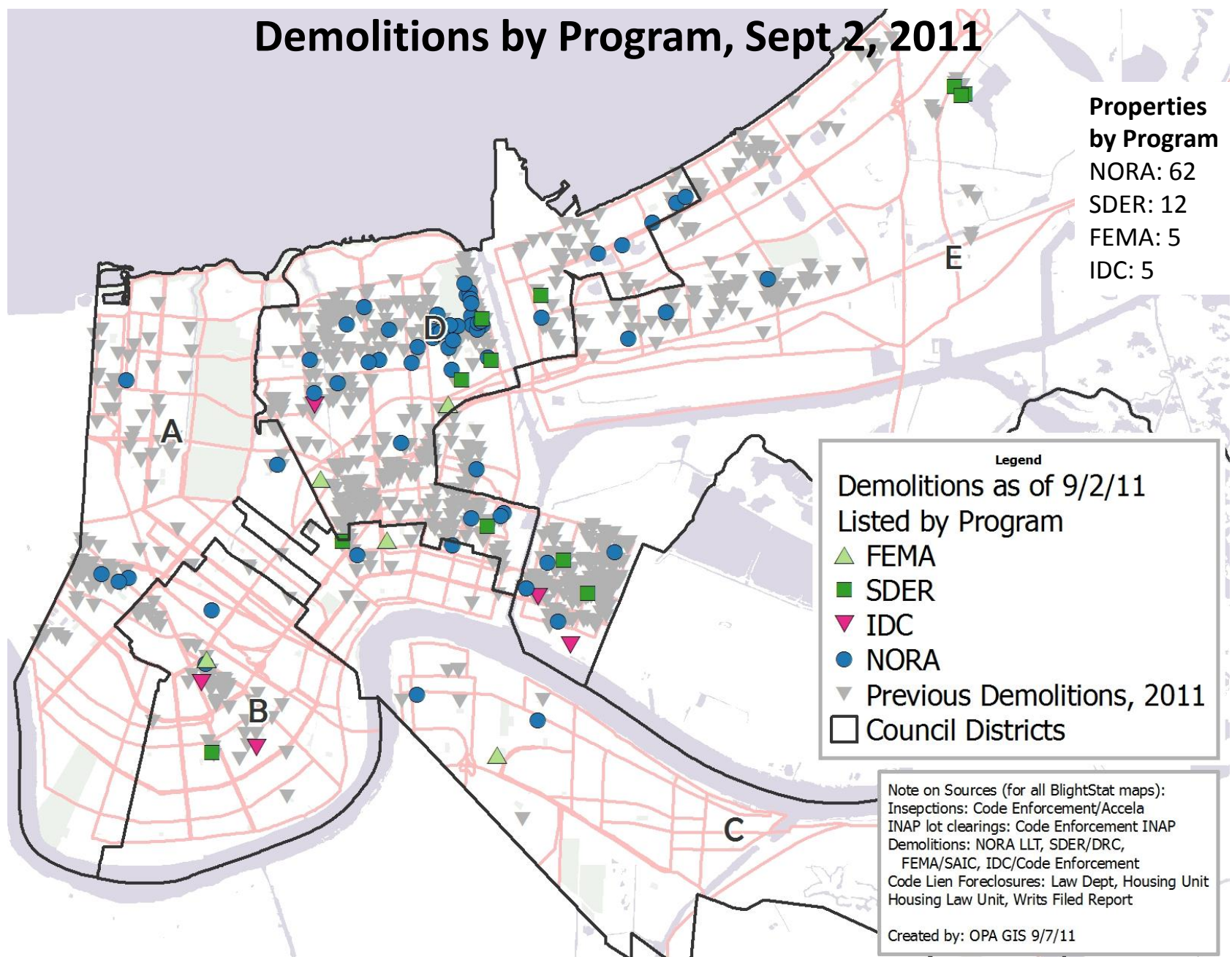

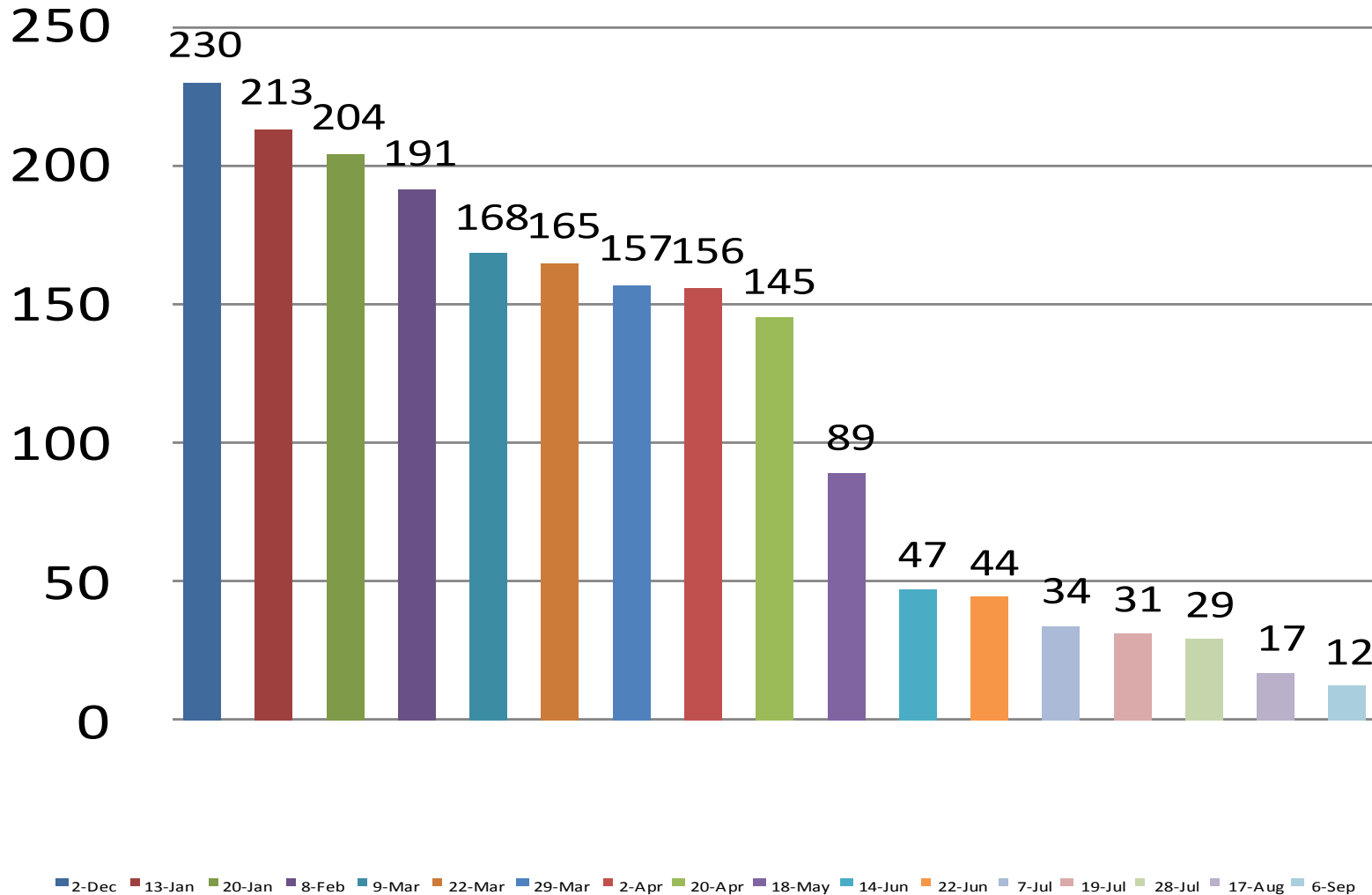

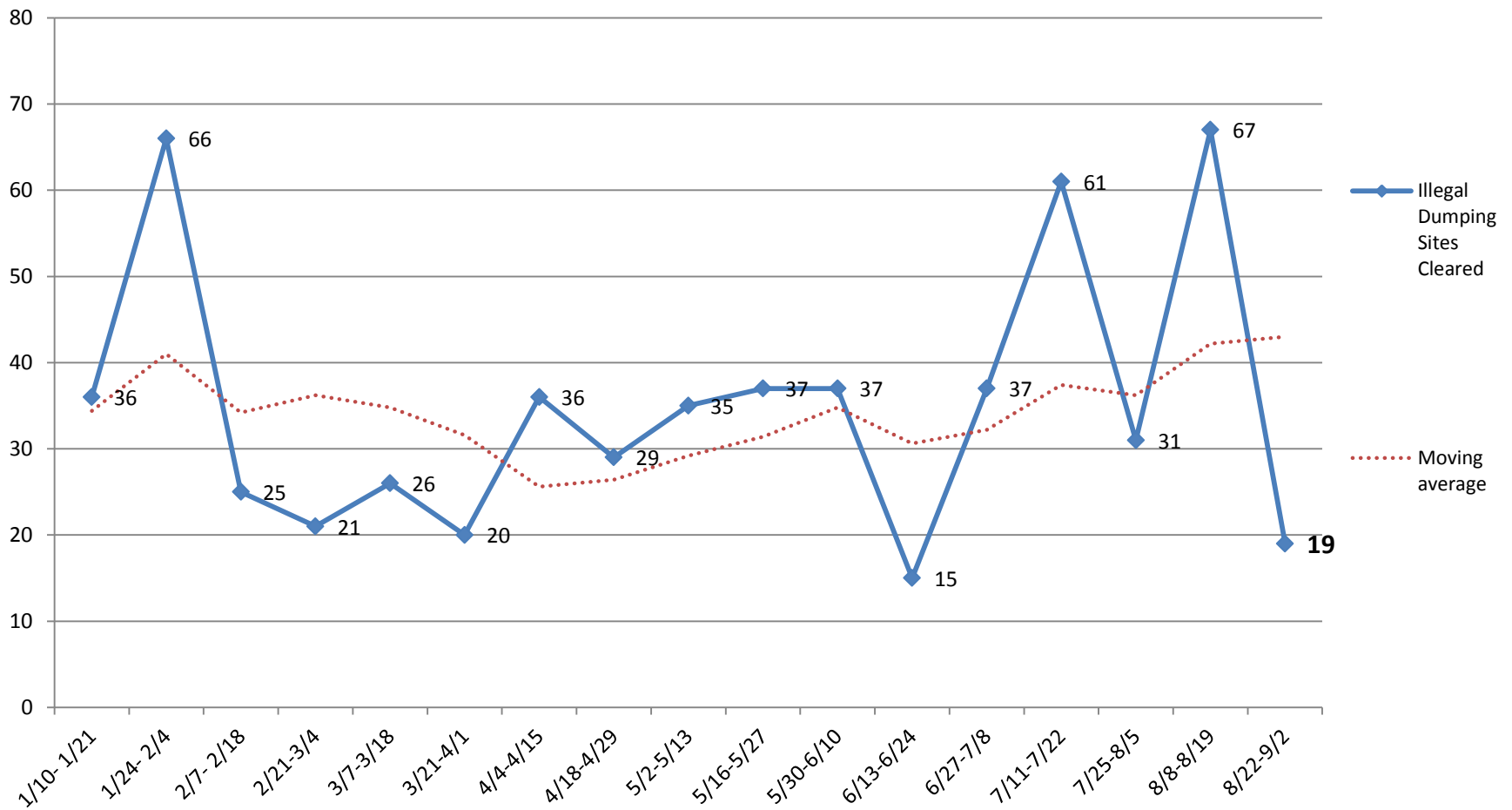

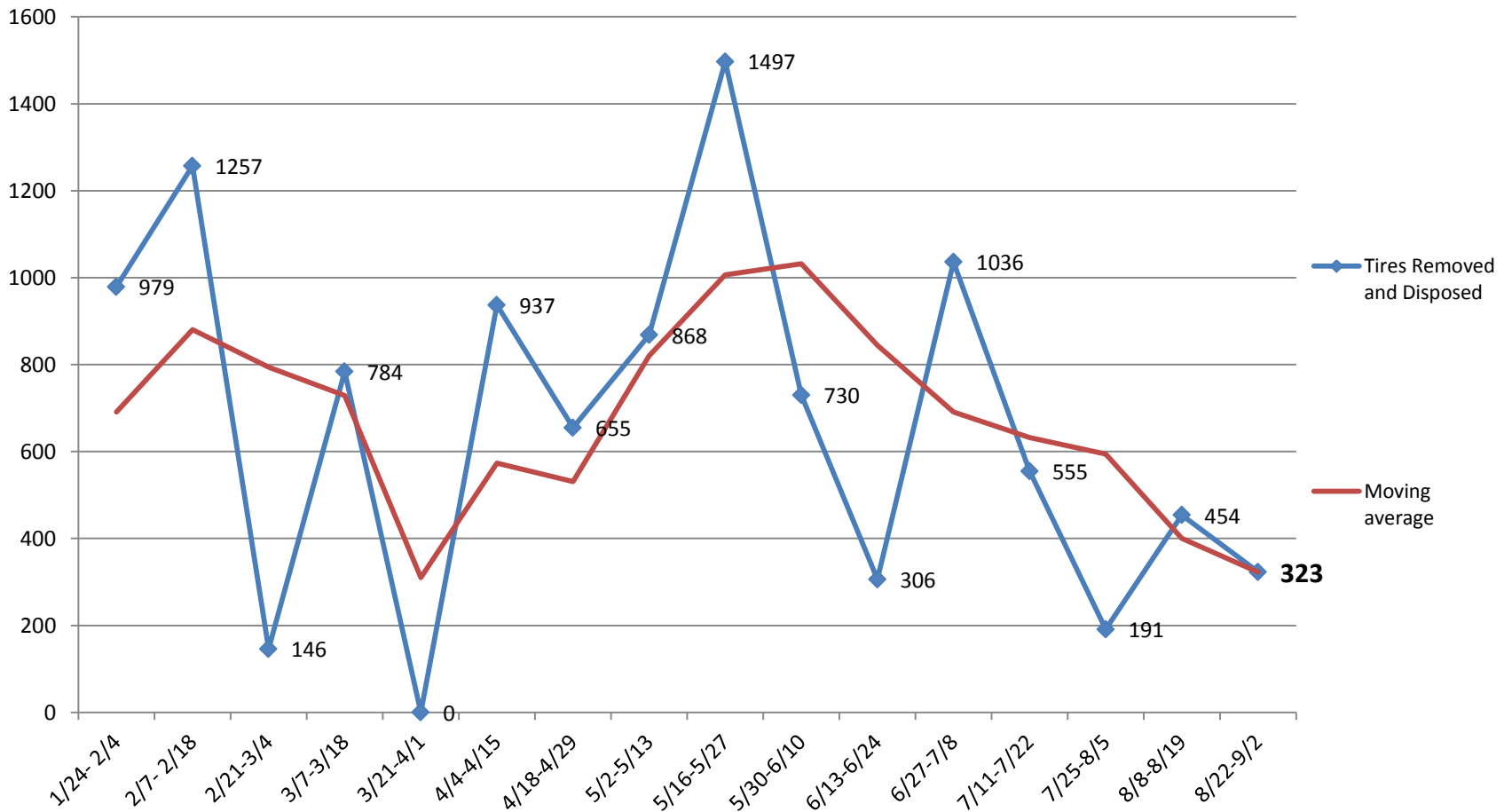
FEMA Trailers Remaining



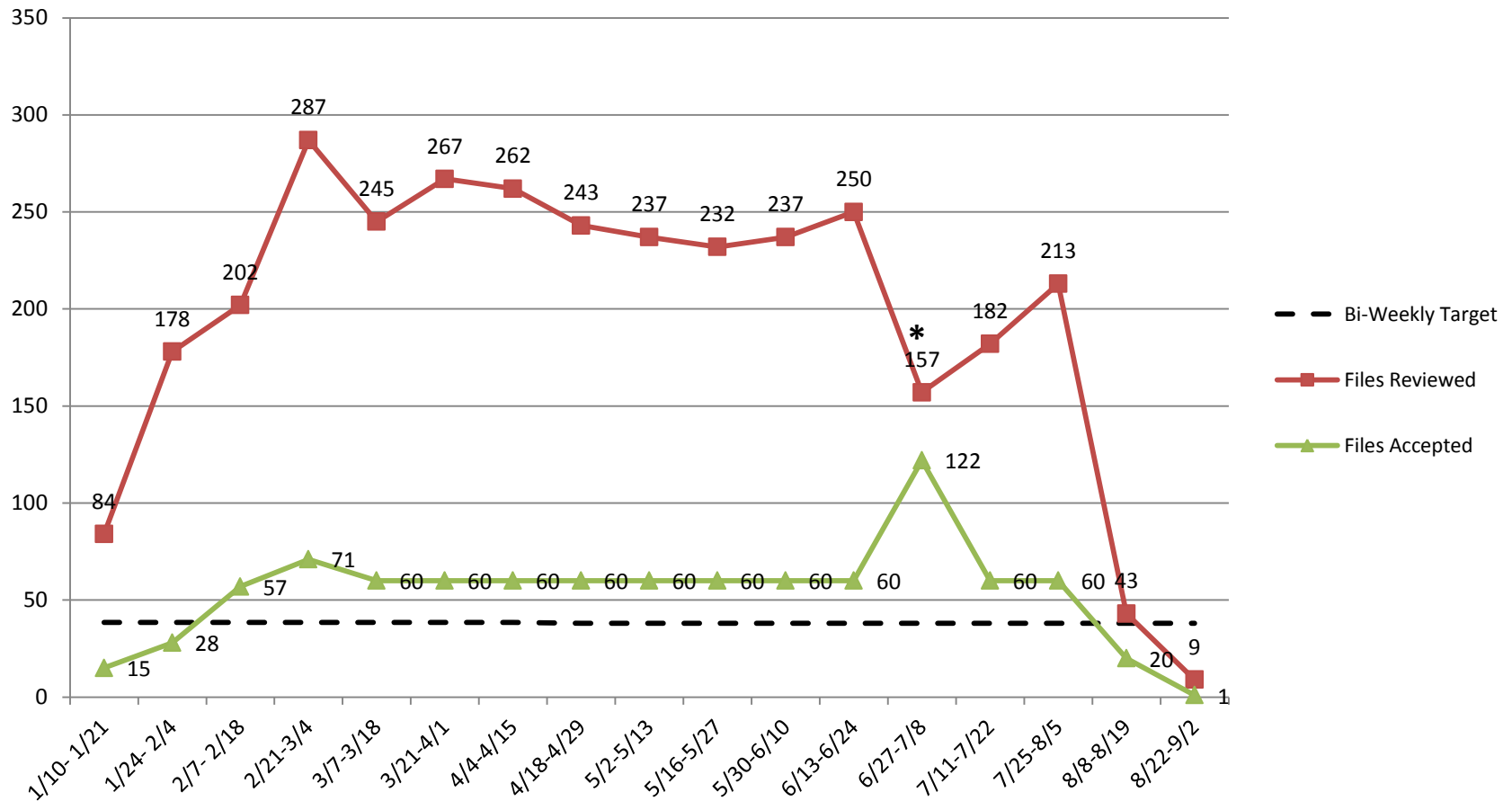
Trend in Illegal Dumping Sites Cleared



Trend of Tires Removed and Disposed



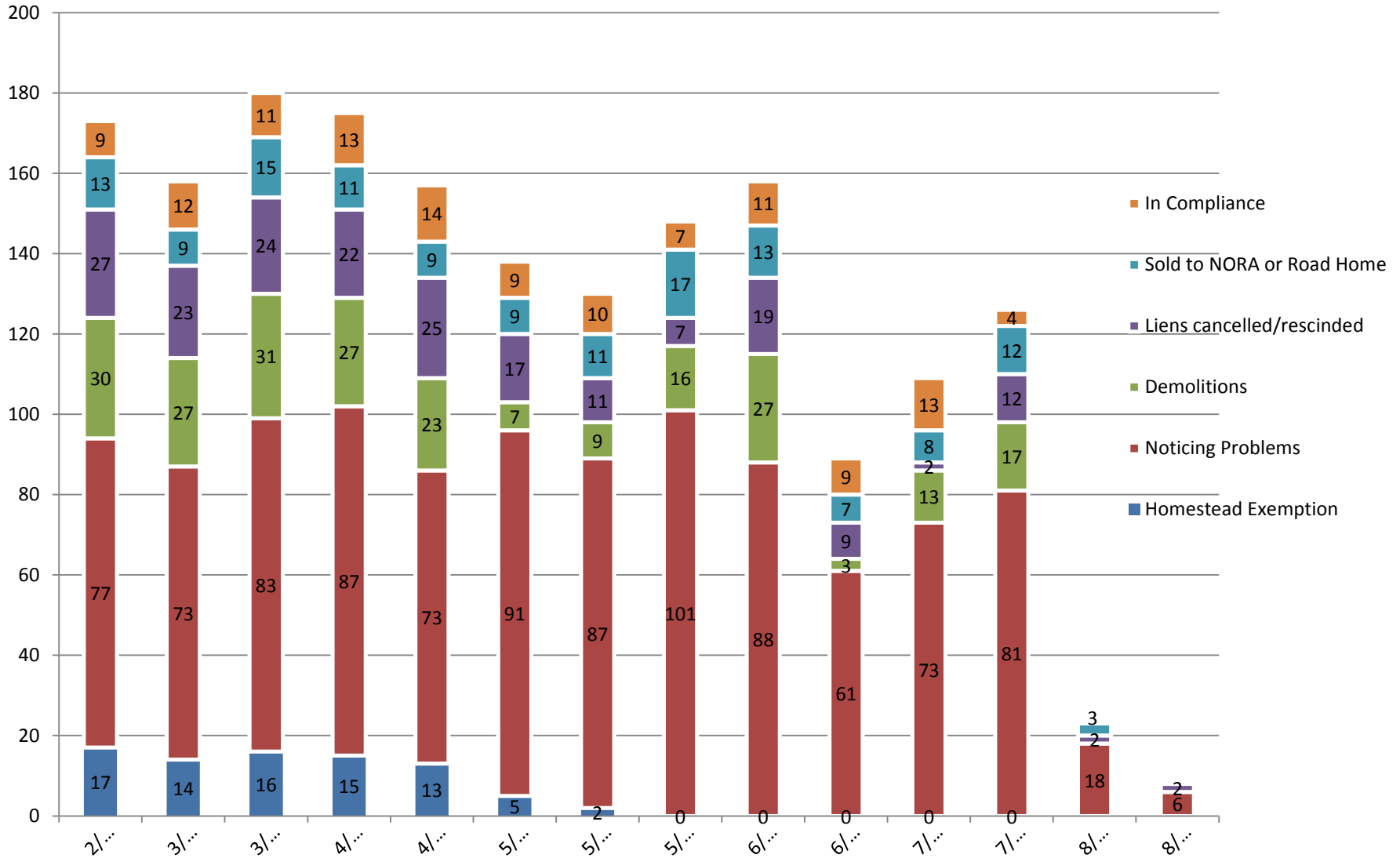
Sheriff's Sales Files Reviewed and Accepted Exceed Annual Goal



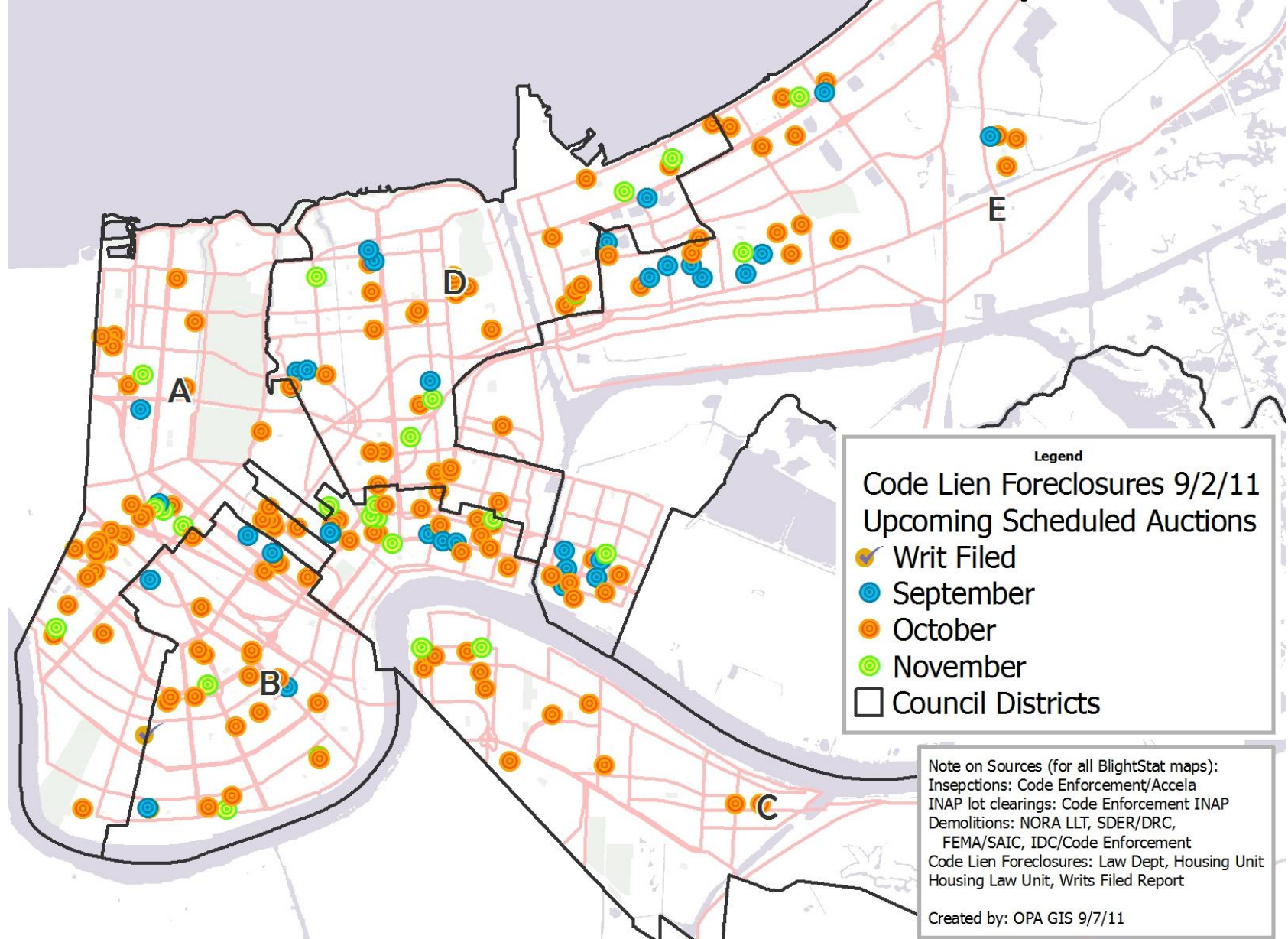

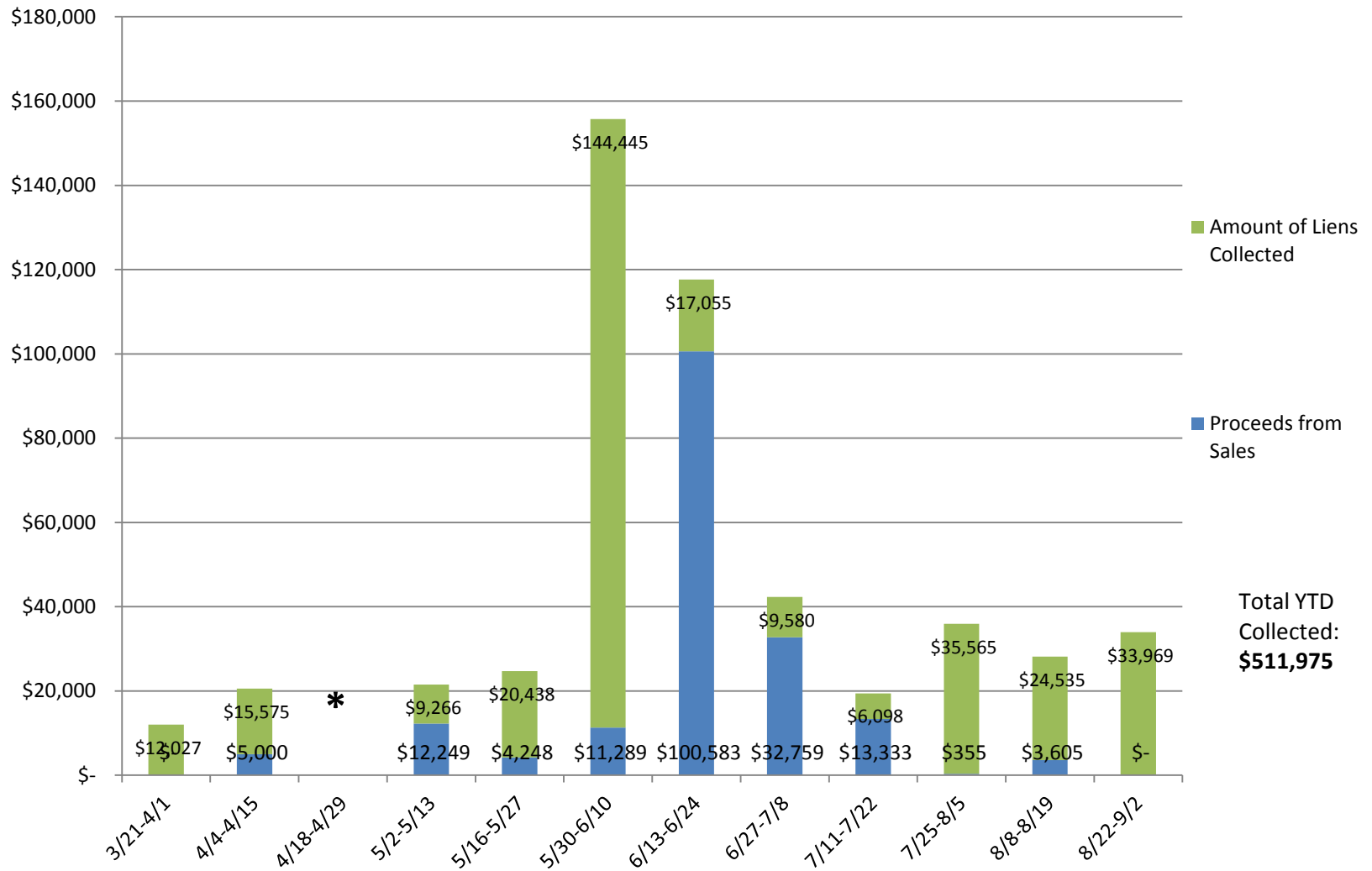
Reasons for Rejecting Sheriff's Sales Files



Code Lien Foreclosures Scheduled Auctions, Sept 2, 2011

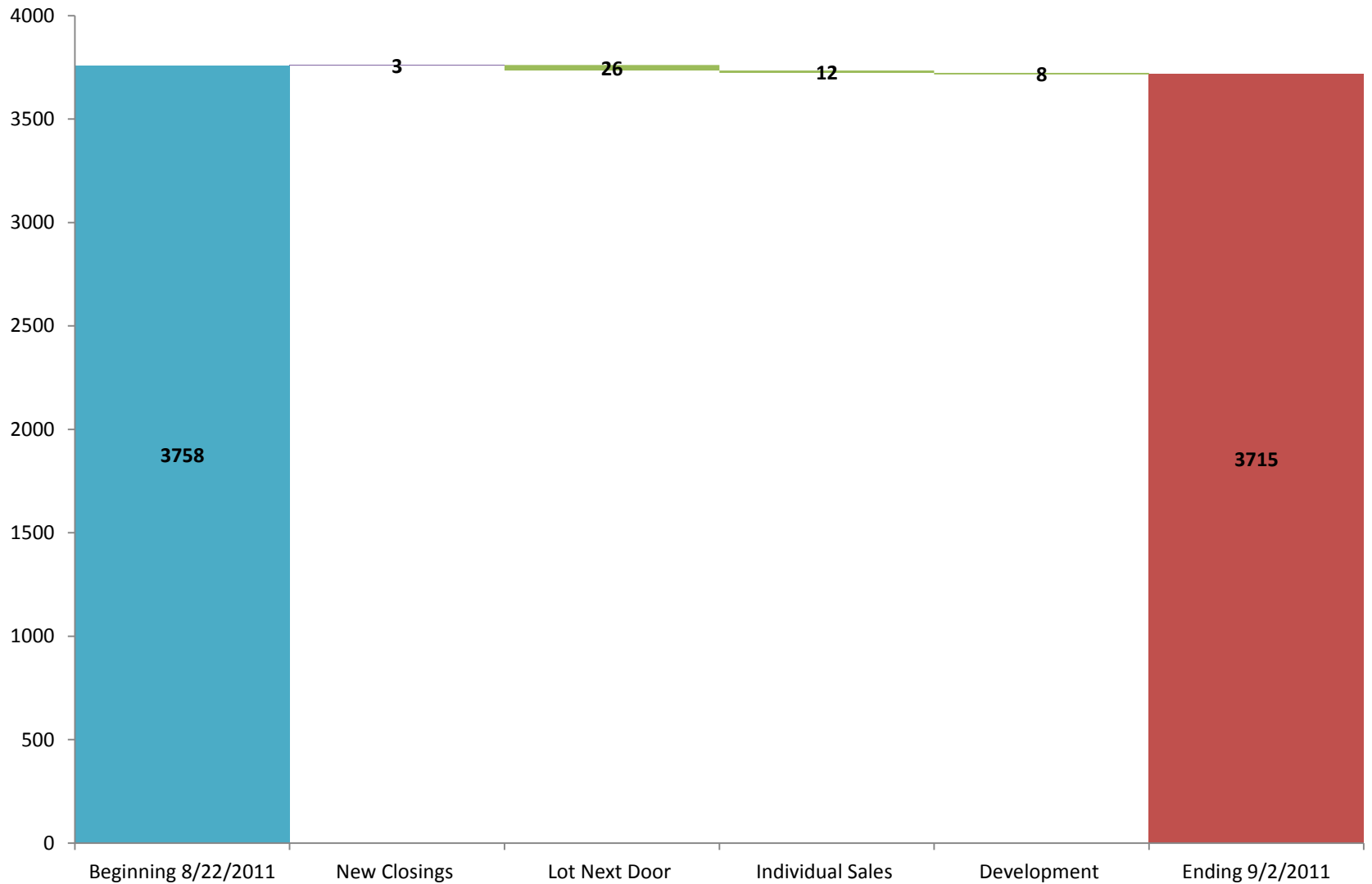


Lien Foreclosures as of September 2, 2011

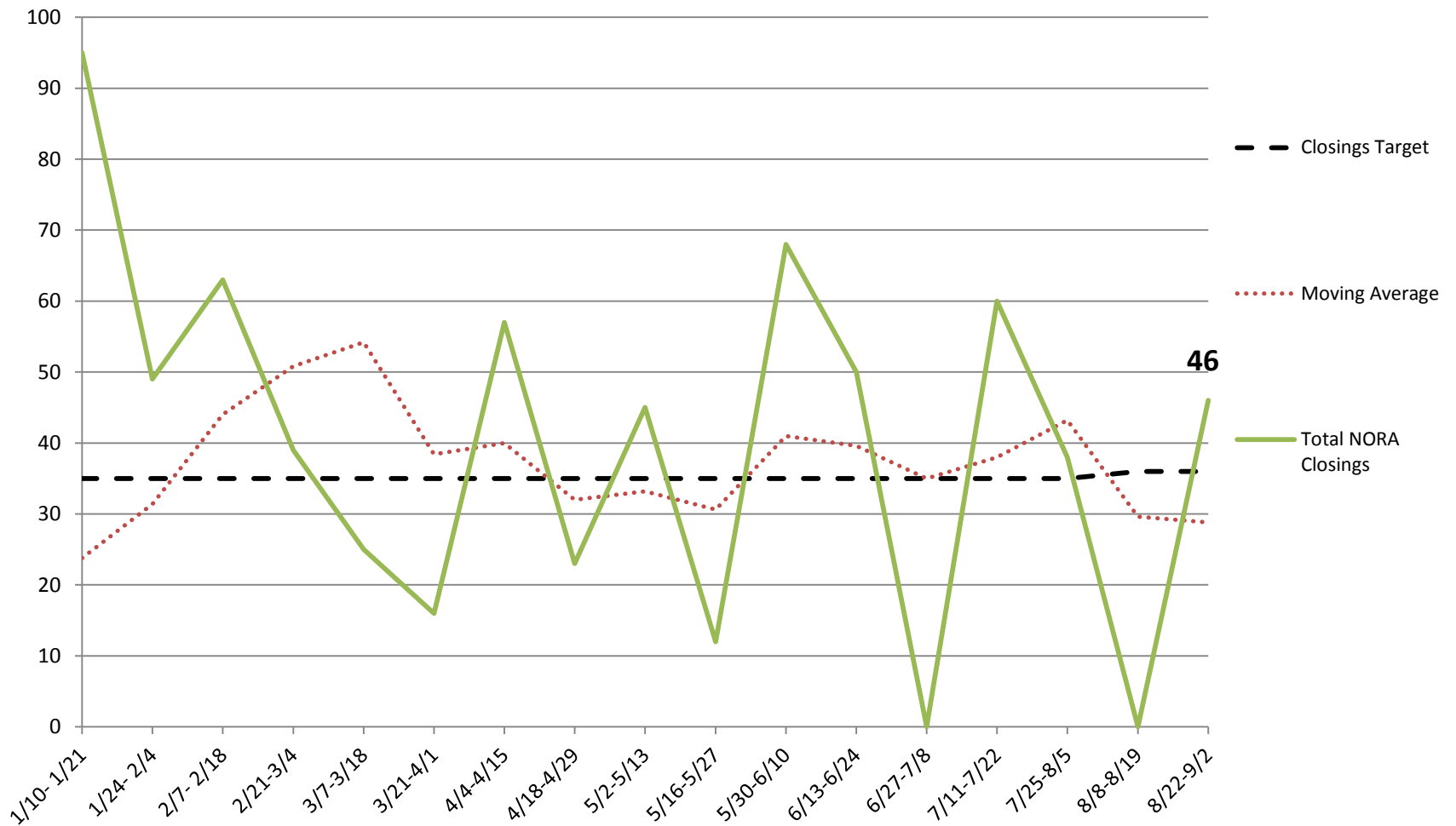

NORA Inventory Backlog Reductions

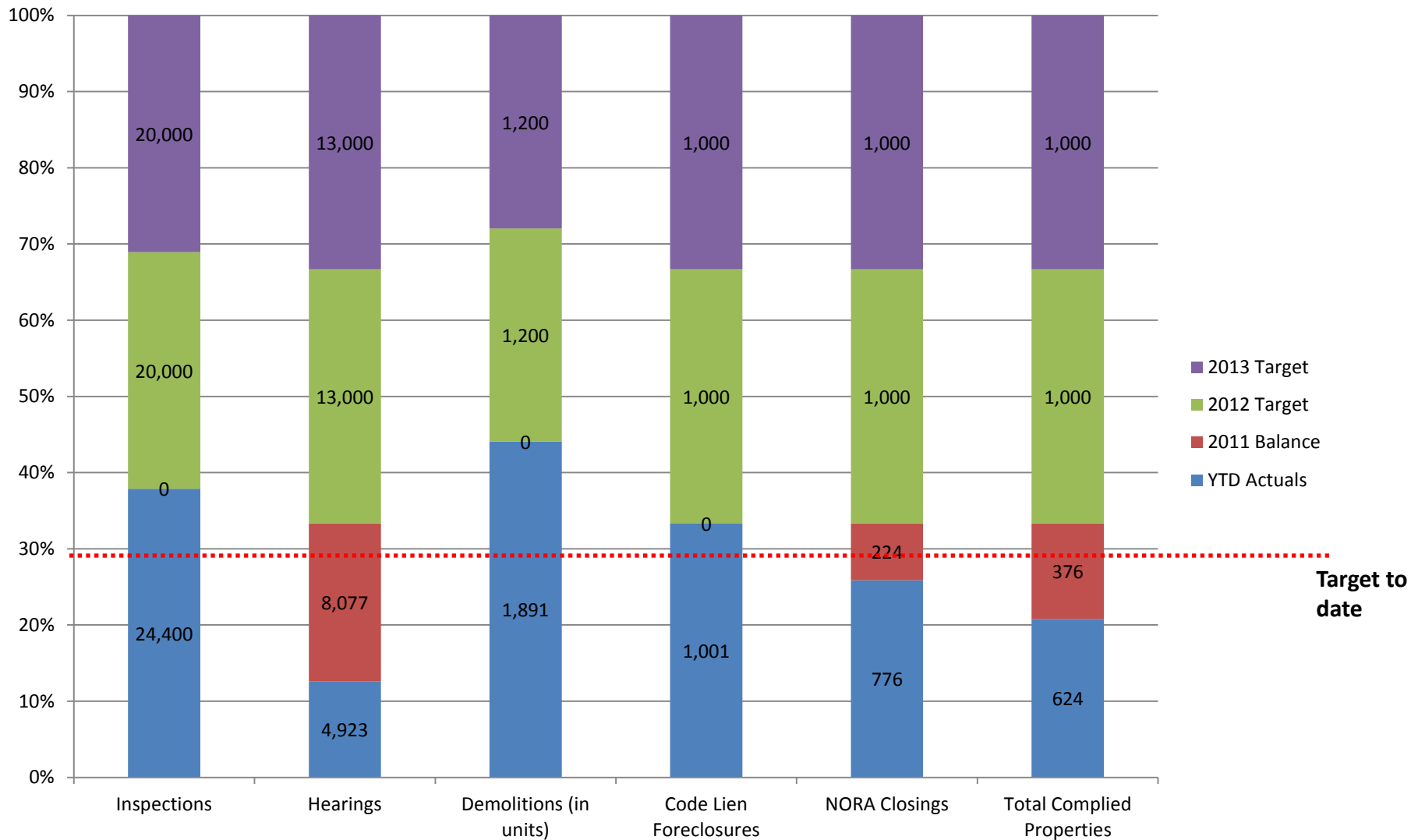


NORA Total Closings Above Target
