



(bi-weekly targets)



Total Inspections by Type Feb 21- March 4, 2011












Total Code Enforcement Hearings


Total Hearings by Type Feb 21- March 4, 2011



Trends in Percentages of Compliance Outcomes





Trends in Percentages of Undesirable Resets









- FEMA has notified all residents that starting on May 1, 2011, they will have to pay rent for living in trailers.











Code Lien Foreclosures and Scheduled Sheriff Sales




