Project Background

- Residents designed a vision for a revitalized Dwyer Canal and ways to reduce flooding and beautify the neighborhood
- Residents approached NORA with this vision in 2008, and NORA applied for and was awarded a \$15 million FEMA hazard mitigation grant to fund the project
- NORA, the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, and the Department of Public Works are working together to coordinate the design and construction of the Pontilly Neighborhood Stormwater Network








